EXPORT PRICE INDEX IN GEORGIA

SEPTEMBER 2021

The Export Price Index (XPI) increased by 2.2 percent **compared to the previous month**. There was a 2.5 percent increase in the prices for manufactured products.

Compared to September 2020 the XPI increased by 13.7 percent. In the mentioned period prices decreased for products from mining and quarrying by 20.9 percent. Along with this, the prices for manufactured products increased by 18.7 percent, while for products from water supply, sewerage, waste management and remediation services by 3.8 percent.

The following table shows the XPI for September 2021, compared to the same month of the previous year, as well as the contributions of subgroups that had a major effect on the index:

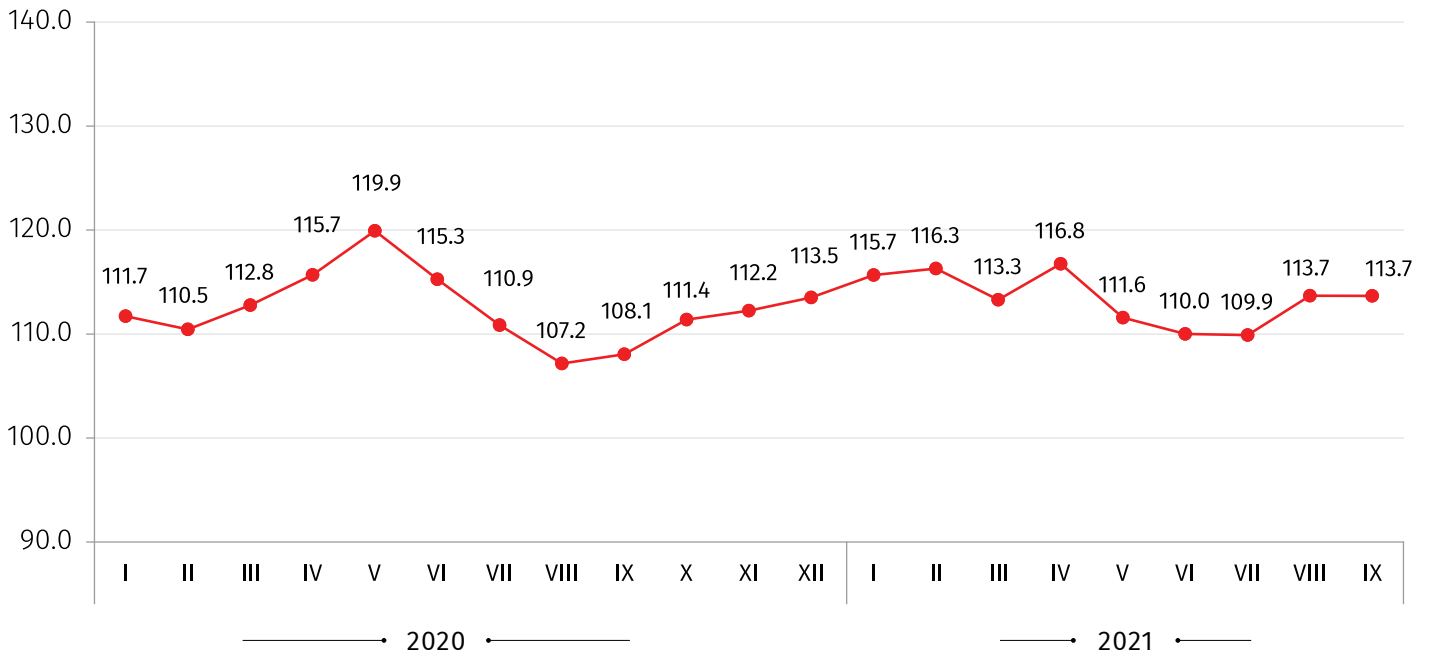
