

### SURVEY RESULTS FOR LIVESTOCK SLAUGHTERHOUSES, ELEVATORS AND COLD STORAGE FACILITIES (III QUARTER, 2021)

(SLAUGHTERHOUSES)

The total number of active livestock and poultry slaughterhouses in Georgia in the III quarter of 2021 were 108, of which 20.4 percent were located in Kvemo Kartli region, 17.6 percent in Kakheti region, 13.0 percent in Shida Kartli region, 13.0 percent in Imereti region, 11.1 percent in Samegrelo-Zemo Svaneti region and remained 25.0 percent in other regions:

According to the survey, 81.3 thousand head of livestock were slaughtered in slaughterhouses in the III quarter of 2021, of which 36.0 percent were cattle, 38.7 percent - pigs and 10.3 percent - sheep and goats. The share of other livestock (excluding poultry) slaughtered is 15.0 percent. In addition, the number of poultry slaughtered in slaughterhouses during the reporting period amounted to 2 691.0 thousand.

In total 9 563.7 tons of meet (i.e. slaughtered weight, including poultry meat) was produced by slaughterhouses during the III quarter of 2021, of which 33.4 percent is beef, 41.7 percent – poultry, 23.4 percent – pork, 1.3 percent – sheep and goat meat, while the share of other meet is not significant.

The service was provided to 9.5 thousand persons, 31.2 percent of which were households. Average monthly number of persons employed in slaughterhouses equaled 976 persons.

The average prices of the slaughter services were: 30.4 GEL per cattle, 12.2 GEL per sheep or goat and 26.6 GEL per pig.



COLD STORAGE FACILITIES

In the III quarter of 2021 the number of active cold storage facilities in Georgia was 157 and most of them were located in Shida Kartli region (57.3 percent). Active cold storage facilities were also located in Kakheti region (14.6 percent), Tbilisi (8.3 percent), Kvemo Kartli region (5.7percent), Adjara AR (5.1 percent), Samegrelo-Zemo Svaneti region (3.8 percent), Imereti region (2.5 percent), Mtskheta-Mtianeti region (1.3 percent) and Guria region (1.3 percent):

## ACTIVE COLD STORAGE FACILITIES IN GEORGIA BY REGIONS, III QUARTER, 2021





In the III quarter of 2021, the service was provided to 364 customers. The number of producers and resellers, from whom the products was purchased, amounted to 252 persons. Average monthly number of persons employed in cold storage facilities were 1 404.

In total 62.2 thousand tons of products were stored in cold storage facilities during the III quarter of 2021, of which 51.2 percent was chicken meat (including frozen meat), 30.5 percent – fruit and vegetable, 9.6 percent – meat and meat products (including semi-finished products, excluded chicken meat), 5.3 percent – fish, while remaining products had a small share:

## PRODUCTS STORED IN COLD STORAGE FACILITIES, III QUARTER, 2021



In the III quarter of 2021, the share of own production in the total volume of products stored in cold storage facilities was 11.9 percent, while the share of products purchased for further realization was 12.4 percent and the share of products stored as services was 75.7 percent. The service fee at the same period amounted to 6.5 million GEL.

In the III quarter of 2021, the total cost of products (12.1 thousand tones) sold by cold storage facilities amounted 62.9 million GEL, of which the share of imported products was 31.8 percent, share of own production was 40.0 percent and the share of products (local) purchased for resale

was 28.2 percent. Herewith, 84.8 percent of own production sold by cold storage facilities was chicken meat. Significant share of imported products was Chicken meat (including frozen) (42.8 percent), fish (25.1 percent) and meat and meat products (including semi-finished products) (23.0 percent).

In the III quarter of 2021, the value of products sold by cold storage facilities on the foreign market amounted to 5.5 million GEL, which consists 8.7 percent of the total value of products sold in the same period. Mostly fish products, chicken meat, fruits and vegetables were sold on the foreign markets.

According to the survey results, the average daily load per storage (out of total storage capacity in percent) was 63.6 percent in July, 60.6 percent in August and 53.6 percent in September.





**ELEVETORS** 

The total number of active elevators in Georgia in the III quarter of 2021 were 50 and most of them were located in Kakheti region (48.0 percent) while 22.0 percent of active elevators were located in Kvemo Kartli region, 14.0 percent in Samegrelo-Zemo Svaneti region, 8.0 percent in Shida Kartli, 4.0 percent in Tbilisi, 2.0 percent in Imereti and 2.0 percent in Guria region:

### ACTIVE ELEVATORS IN GEORGIA BY REGIONS, III QUARTER, 2021



In the III quarter of 2021, the service was provided to 20 customers. The number of producers and resellers, from whom the product were purchased, was 140 persons, while the average monthly number of persons employed in cold storage facilities equaled 732.

In total 106.3 thousand tons of products were stored in elevators during the III quarter of 2021, 83.0 percent of which was wheat. The share of products purchased by the elevators for resale in the total amount of products stored in the elevators was 89.9 percent at the same period.

Total amount of products sold by the elevators during the III quarter of 2021 amounted 70.4 thousand tones (total cost - 69.5 million GEL), 75.0 percent of which was own production.

The biggest share among own production had wheat flour, which consist 80.5 percent of total own production sold by the elevators at the same period.

According to survey results, average daily load per storage (out of total capacity of storages in percent) amounted to 40.2 percent in July, 39.8 percent in August and 36.6 percent in September.
