
INDICATORS OF THE LABOUR FORCE

(EMPLOYMENT AND UNEMPLOYMENT)

III QUARTER, 2021 YEAR

In the III quarter of 2021, the unemployment rate in Georgia increased by 2.5 percentage points compared to the corresponding period of the previous year and equaled 19.5 percent.

The chart below presents the unemployment rate by quarters of 2018-2021 years.



In the III quarter of 2021, labour force (economically active population) constituted 52.8 percent of the working age population (population aged 15 and older), which is 2.5 percentage points more than that was to the corresponding period of the previous year, while the employment rate increased by 0.7 percentage points and equaled to 42.5 percent. The Labour force participation rate (economic activity rate) in urban settlements increased by 2.2 percentage points, while in rural settlements that increased by 2.8 percentage points. The employment rate increased in urban settlements by 0.8 percentage points and by 0.7 percentage points in rural settlements.

The chart below presents the labour force participation rate (economic activity rate) and employment rates by quarters of 2018-2021 years.



In the III quarter of 2021, the share of hired employees was 67.3 percent among employed persons that increased by 0.7 percentage points compared to the corresponding period of the previous year.

The chart below presents the distribution of employed by status in employment for 2018-2021 years.



DISTRIBUTION OF EMPLOYED BY STATUS IN EMPLOYMENT





In the III quarter of 2021, the unemployment rate in urban settlements increased by 1.9 percentage points compared to the corresponding period of the previous year, while in rural settlements that increased by 3.5 percentage points.

The chart below presents the unemployment rate by urban-rural areas and quarters of 2018-2021 years.



Traditionally, the unemployment rate is higher for men than for women. In the III quarter of 2021, compared to the corresponding period of the previous year this indicator increased for women by 2.1 percentage points, while it increased by 2.9 percentage points for men.

The chart below presents the unemployment rate by sex and quarters of 2018-2021 years.



UNEMPLOYMENT RATE BY SEX



The labour force participation rate (activity rate) is higher for men than for women. In the III quarter of 2021 the indicator for women was 42.4 percent and for men – 64.7 percent. The labour force participation rate (activity rate) for women increased by 2.2 percentage points, while for men - 2.8 percentage points, compared to the corresponding period of the previous year.

The chart below presents the labour force participation rate (economic activity rate) by sex and quarters of 2018-2021 years.





In the III Quarter of 2021 the employment rate for women as well as for men increased by 1.0 and 0.4 percentage points, respectively compared to the corresponding period of the previous year.
