IMPORT PRICE INDEX IN GEORGIA

OCTOBER 2021

The Import Price Index (MPI) increased by 1.4 percent over the **previous month**, while compared to October 2020 the index increased by 21.6 percent.

Compared to October 2020 the prices were 20.7 percent higher for manufactured products. For products from mining and quarrying a price increase of 34.0 percent was registered, while for electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning prices decreased by 47.0 percent. With regard to water supply, sewerage, waste management and remediation services, the prices were 1.5 percent higher.

The following table shows the MPI for October 2021, compared to the same month of the previous year, as well as the contributions of subgroups that had a major effect on the index:


