IMPORT PRICE INDEX IN GEORGIA

NOVEMBER 2021

The Import Price Index (MPI) increased by 1.0 percent over the **previous month**, while compared to November 2020 the index increased by 19.2 percent.

Compared to November 2020 the prices were 16.6 percent higher for manufactured products. For products from mining and quarrying a price increase of 45.0 percent was registered, while for electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning prices decreased by 35.7 percent. With regard to water supply, sewerage, waste management and remediation services, the prices were 7.4 percent higher.

The following table shows the MPI for November 2021, compared to the same month of the previous year, as well as the contributions of subgroups that had a major effect on the index:

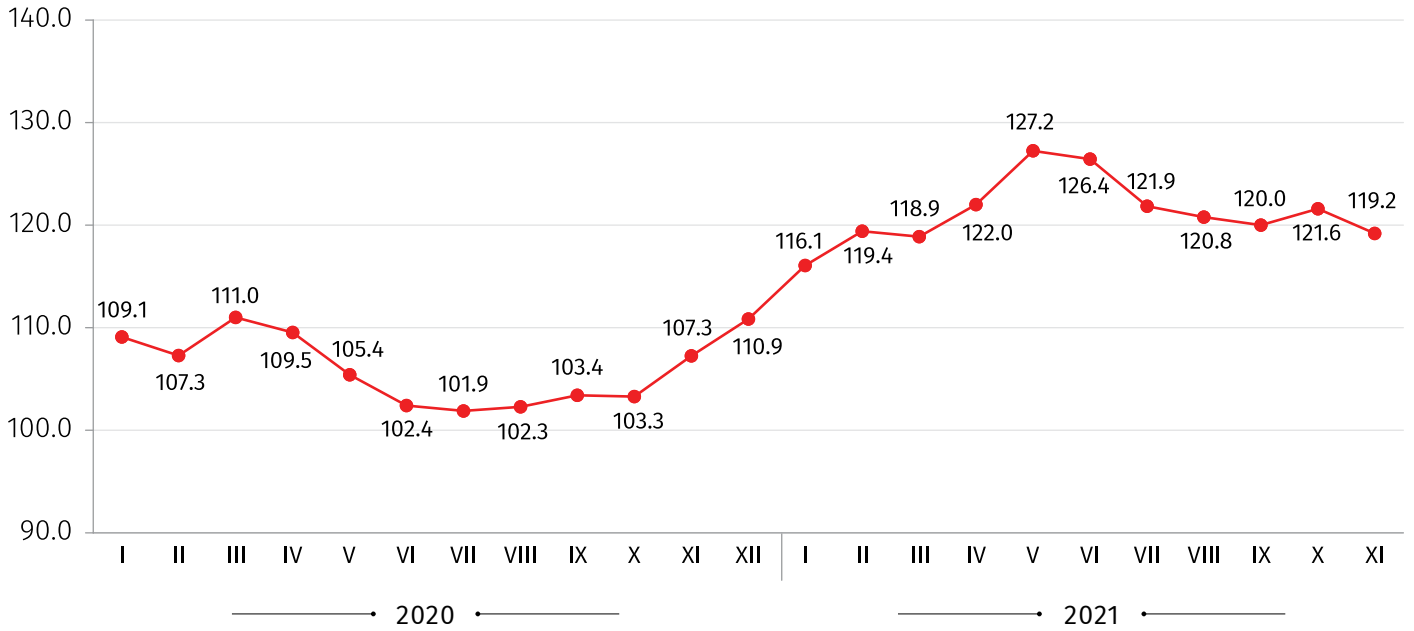
