AVERAGE MONTHLY NOMINAL EARNINGS OF EMPLOYEES

(IV QUARTER, 2021)

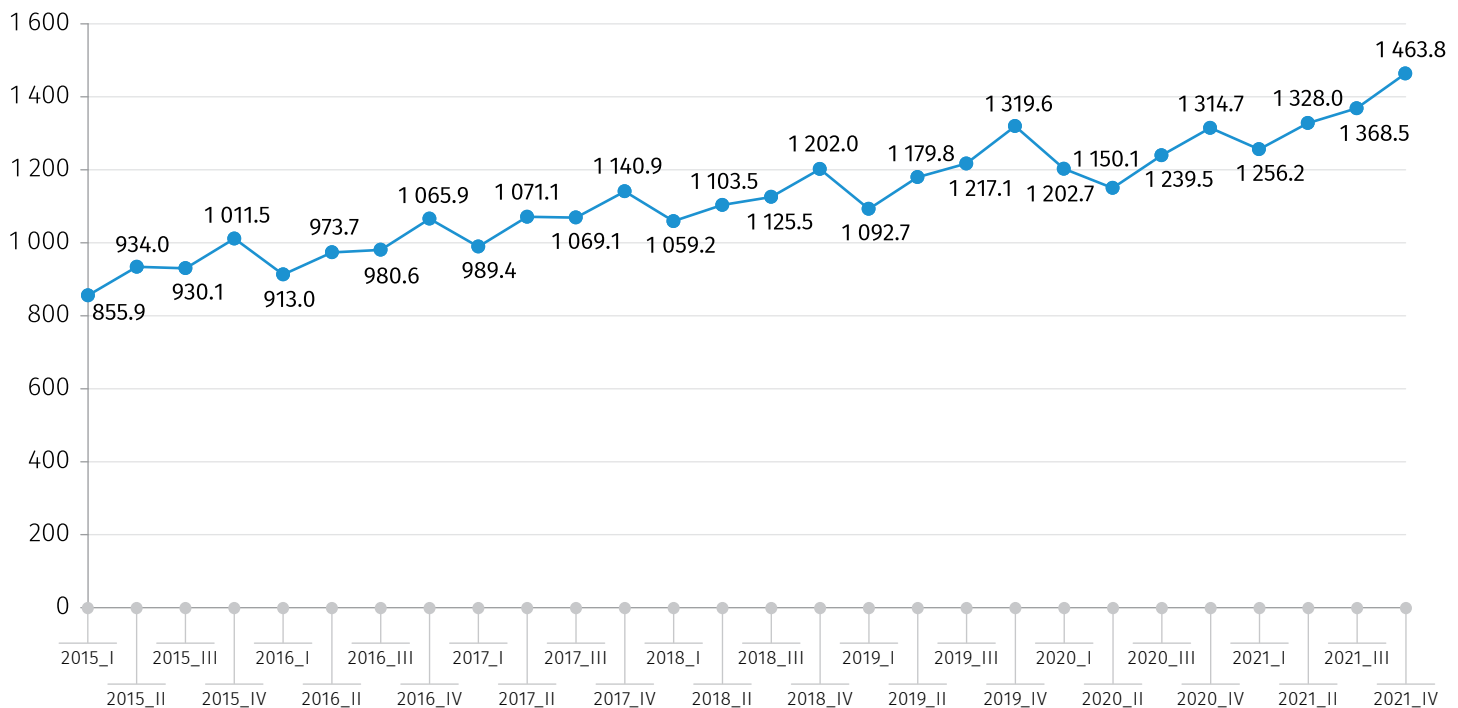
In the IV quarter of 2021, the average monthly nominal earnings in Georgia increased by 11.3 percent (149.1 Gel) compared to the same quarter of the previous year and amounted to 1 463.8 Gel.

The chart below presents the distribution of the average monthly earnings of employees in 2015-2021, by quarters.

According to the economic activity the highest monthly earnings were observed in the following fields:

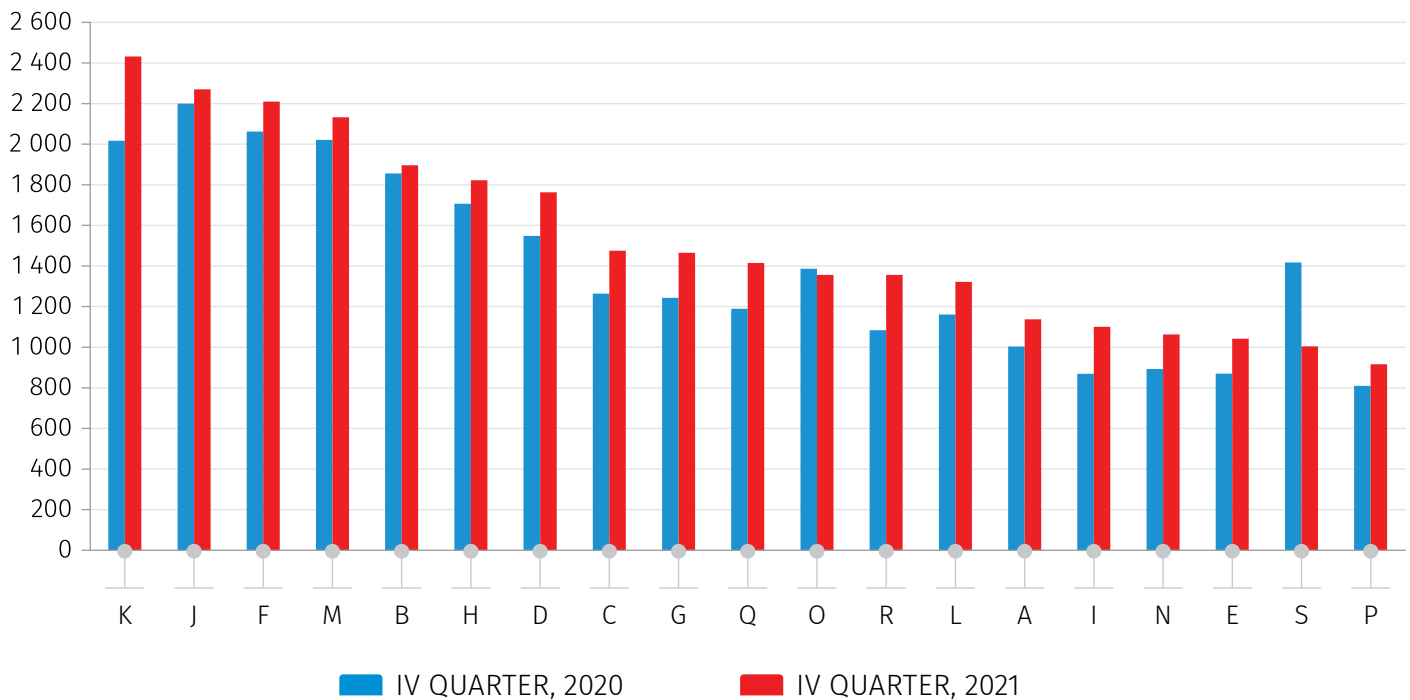
- Financial and insurance activities – 2 431.6 Gel (increased by 20.5 percent compared to the corresponding period of the previous year)
- Information and communication – 2 270.2 Gel (increased by 3.2 percent)
- Construction – 2 209.5 Gel (increased by 7.2 percent)
- Professional, scientific and technical activities – 2 133.0 Gel (increased by 5.5 percent)

The chart below presents the distribution of the average monthly earnings by economic activity in the IV quarter of 2020-2021.

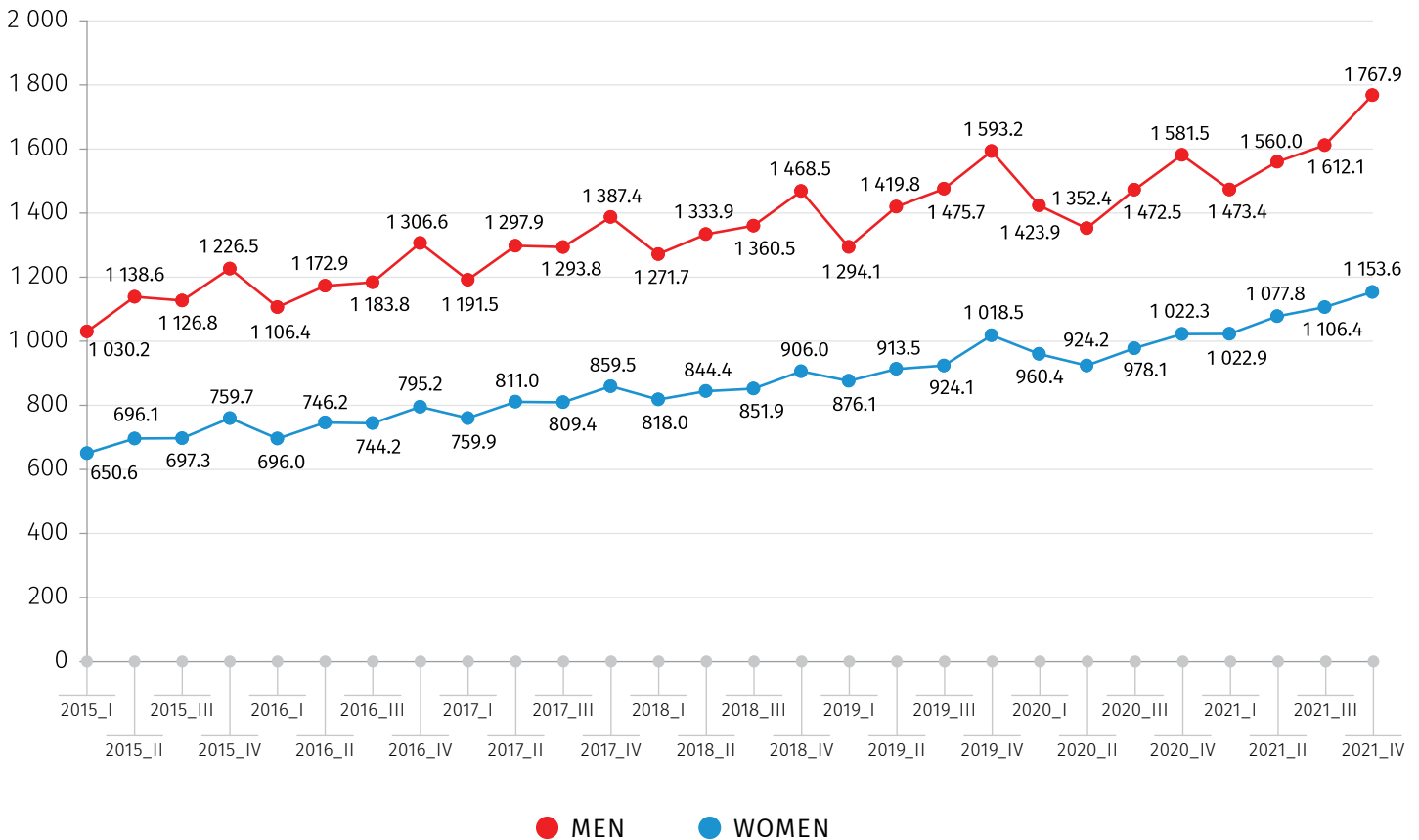
**AVERAGE MONTHLY EARNINGS BY ECONOMIC ACTIVITY

In the IV quarter of 2021, the average earnings equaled to 1 153.6 Gel for women, while 1 767.9 Gel for men. The annual growth of earnings amounted to 131.3 Gel (12.8%) for women and 186.4 Gel (11.8%) for men. In the majority of sectors of economy the average monthly earnings of men were higher compared to women.

The chart below presents the distribution of the average monthly earnings of employees by sex in 2015-2021, by quarters.

(GEL)



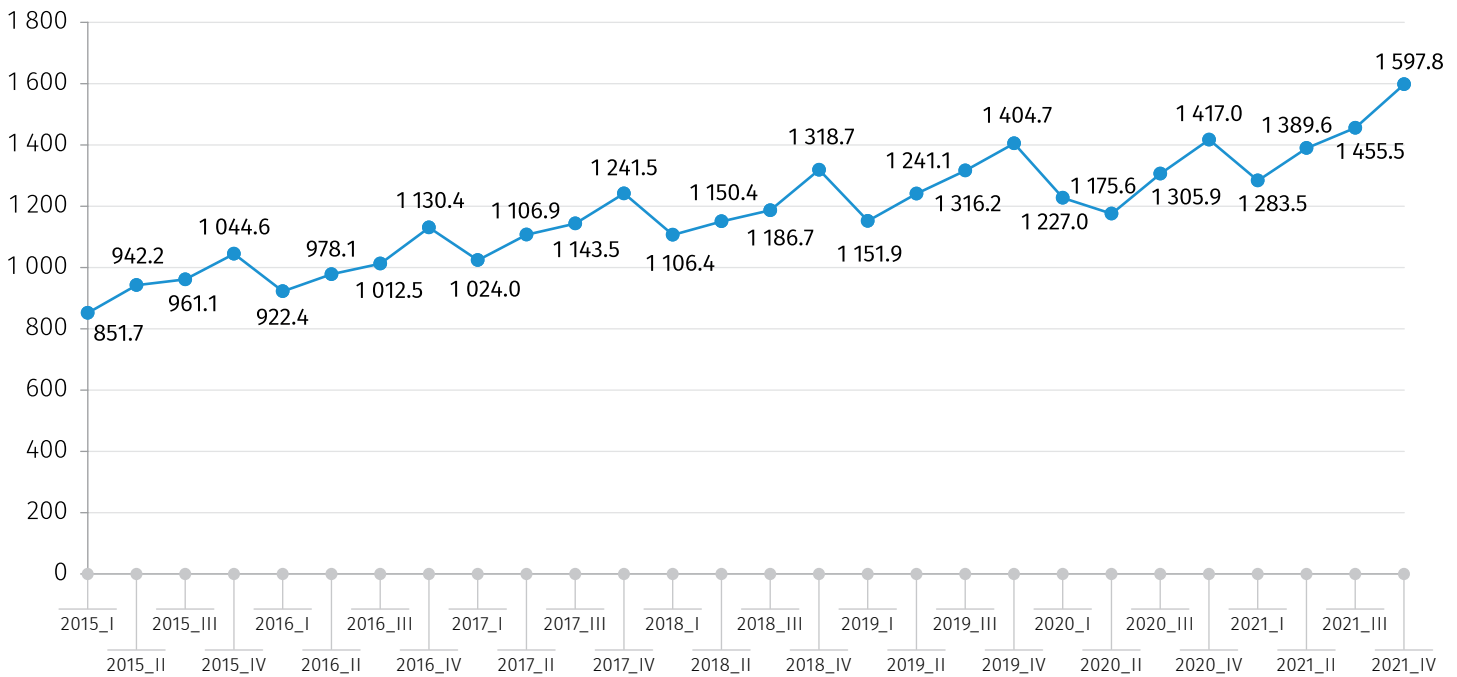
In the IV quarter of 2021, the average monthly earnings of hired employees in the business sector increased by 180.9 Gel (12.8%) and equaled to 1 597.8 Gel. According to the economic activity the highest monthly earnings were observed in Arts, entertainment and recreation (2 502.3 Gel, increased by 18.4 percent compared to the corresponding period of the previous year) and Professional, scientific and technical activities (2 394.2 Gel, increased by 3.2 percent).

The chart below presents the distribution of the average monthly earnings of employees in the business sector in 2015-2021, by quarters.

(GEL)**



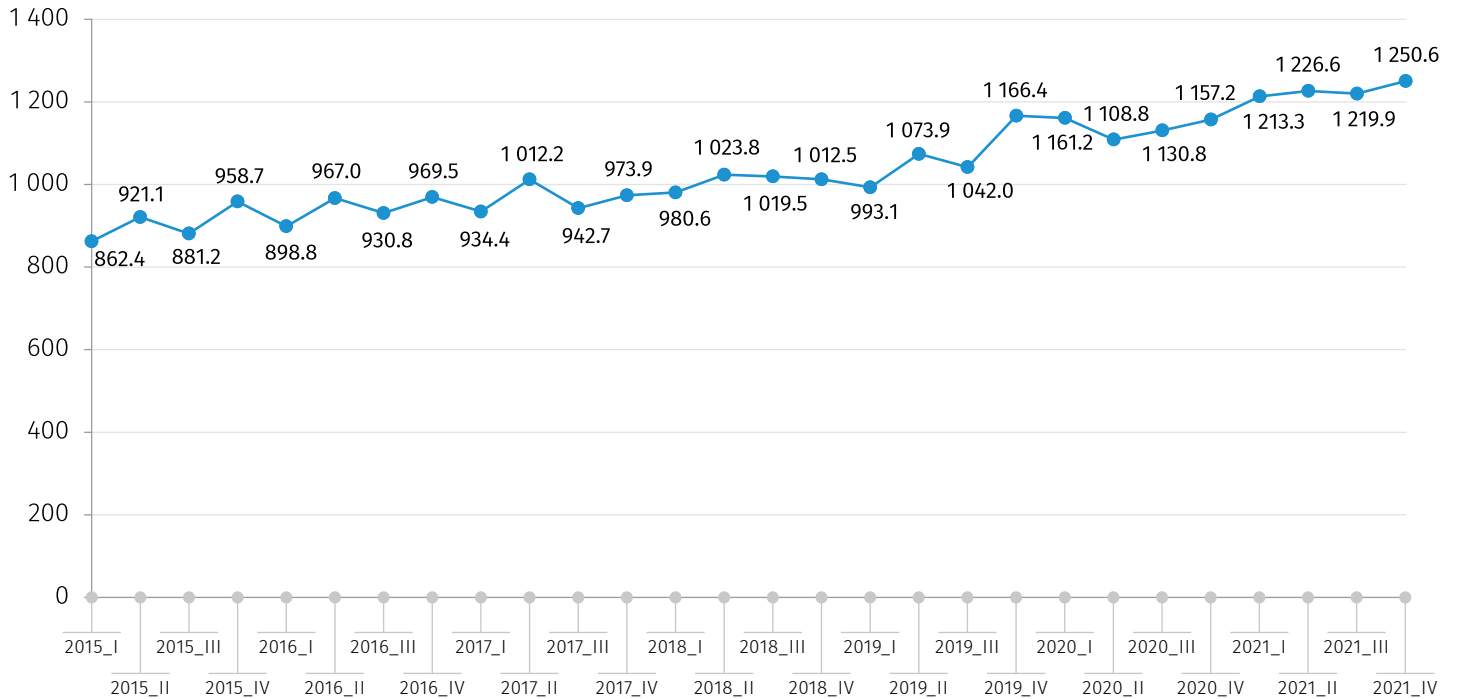
In the IV quarter of 2021, compared to the same quarter of the previous year, the average monthly earnings of hired employees in the non-business and financial sector increased by 93.4 Gel (8.1%) and amounted to 1 250.6 Gel. According to the economic activity the highest monthly earnings were observed in the Financial and insurance activities.
