IMPORT PRICE INDEX IN GEORGIA

FEBRUARY 2022

The Import Price Index (MPI) increased by 1.7 percent over the **previous month**, while compared to February 2021 the index growth amounted to 10.7 percent.

Compared to February 2021 the prices were 28.3 percent higher for products from mining and quarrying. For manufactured products a price increase of 9.1 percent was registered, while for electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning prices decreased by 10.4 percent. With regard to water supply, sewerage, waste management and remediation services, the prices were 5.7 percent lower.

The following table shows the MPI for February 2022, compared to the same month of the previous year, as well as the contributions of subgroups that had a major effect on the index:


