EXPORT PRICE INDEX IN GEORGIA

MARCH 2022

The Export Price Index (XPI) increased by 5.6 percent **compared to the previous month**. There was a 4.0 percent increase in the prices for manufactured products.

Compared to March 2021 the XPI increased by 32.7 percent. The prices for products from mining and quarrying increased by 5.4 percent, for manufactured products by 35.1 percent, for products from electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning by 30.7 percent and for water supply, sewerage, waste management and remediation services by 17.7 percent.

The following table shows the XPI for March 2022, compared to the same month of the previous year, as well as the contributions of subgroups that had a major effect on the index:

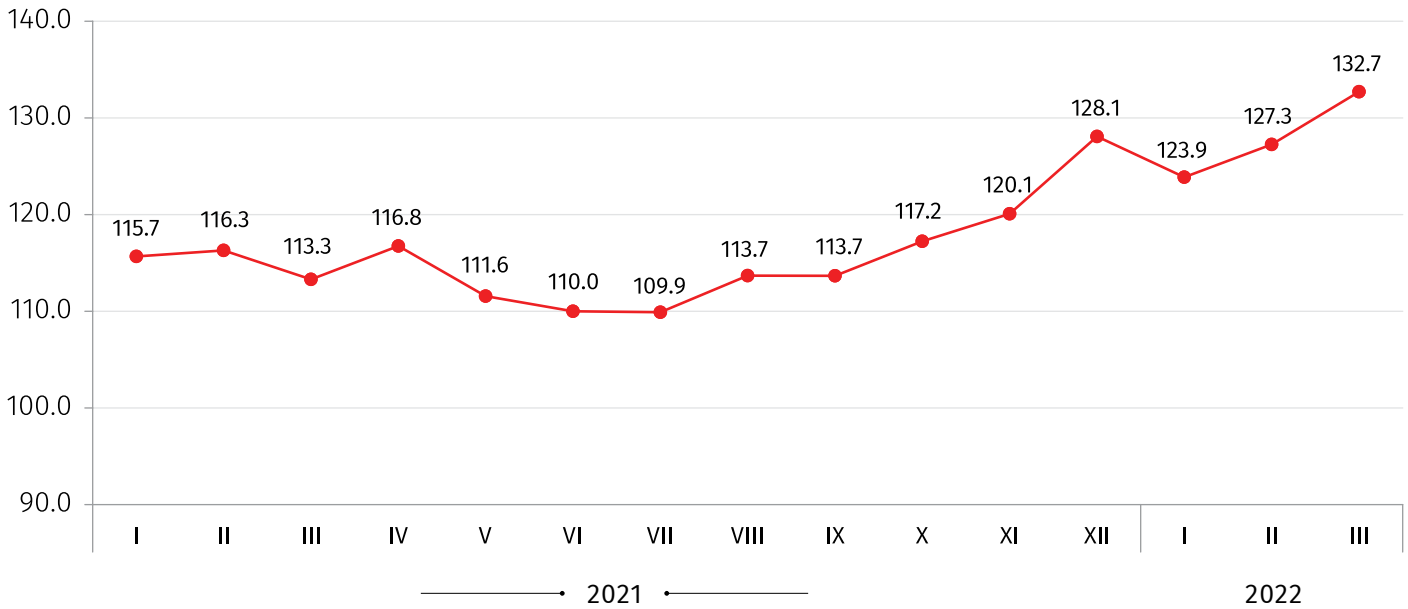
