IMPORT PRICE INDEX IN GEORGIA

SEPTEMBER 2022

The Import Price Index (MPI) increased by 0.4 percent over the **previous month**, while compared to September 2021 the index growth amounted to 0.6 percent.

Compared to September 2021 the prices were 9.1 percent lower for products from mining and quarrying. For manufactured products a price increase of 2.5 percent was registered, while for electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning prices decreased by 77.1 percent. With regard to water supply, sewerage, waste management and remediation services, the prices were 4.7 percent lower.

The following table shows the MPI for September 2022, compared to the same month of the previous year, as well as the contributions of subgroups that had a major effect on the index:

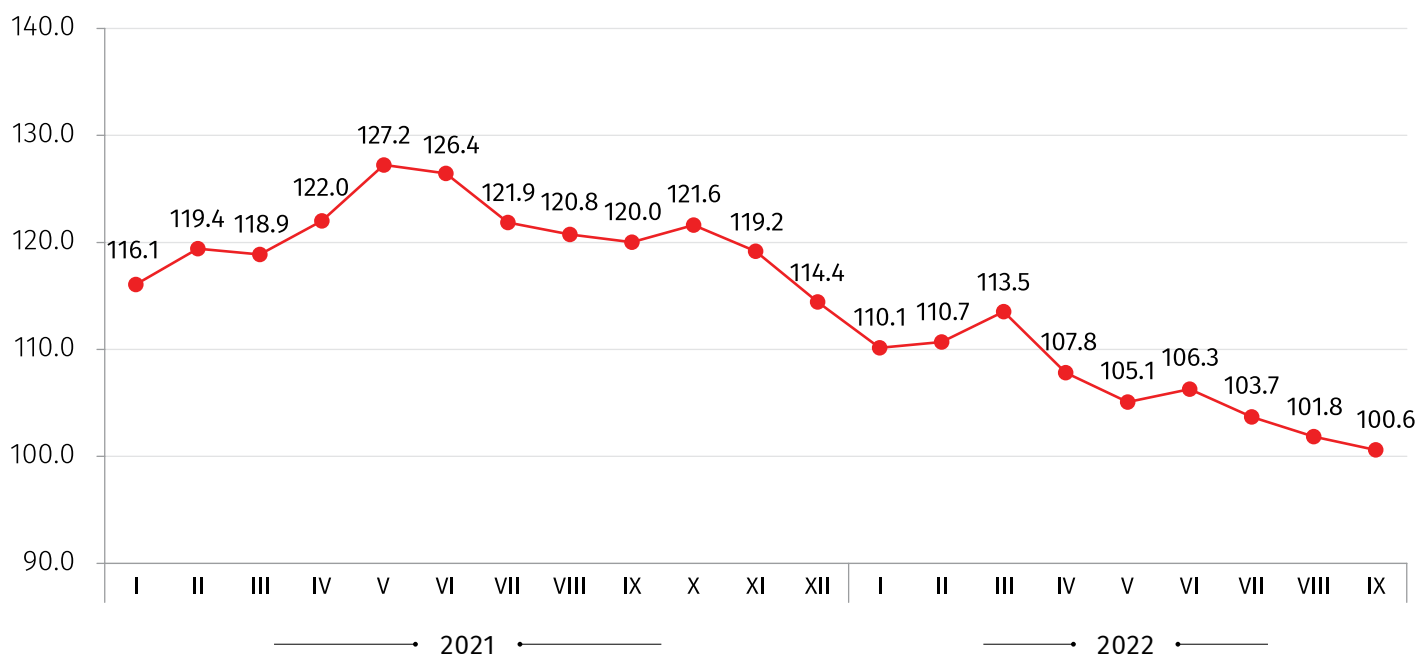
