**RESULTS OF SURVEY OF POSTAL AND COURIER
ACTIVITIES OF ENTERPRISES
(2021)**

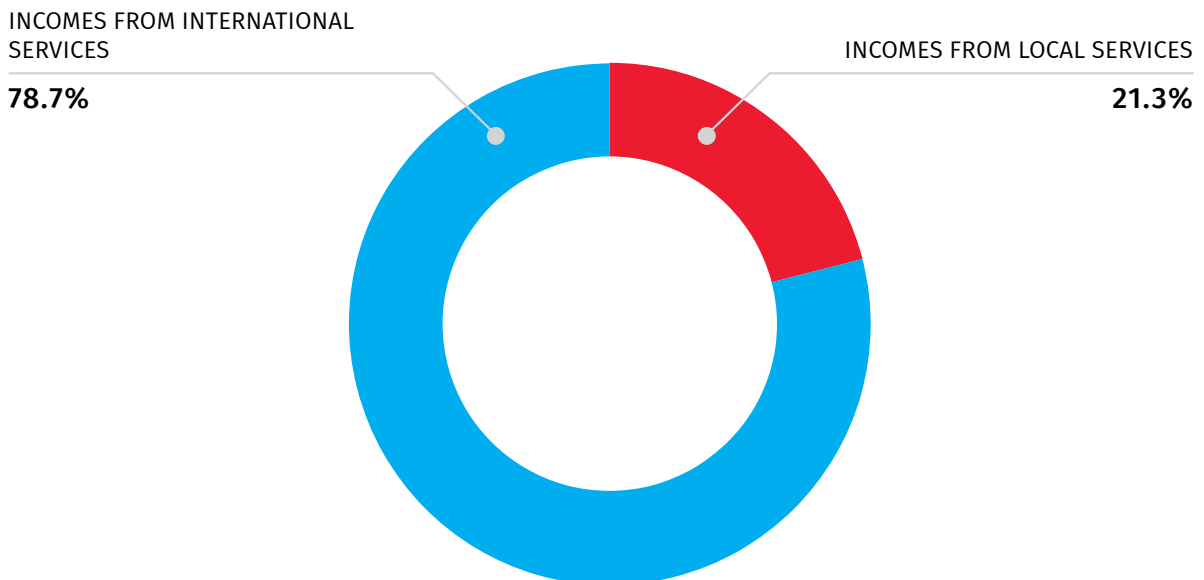
According to the survey results, incomes of enterprises engaged in postal and courier activities¹ amounted to 131.5 million GEL in 2021, of which, 73.3 percent comes from international postal and courier services, while 26.7 percent comes from local services.

65.3 percent of incomes of enterprises engaged in postal and courier activities belongs to the category of parcel delivery service, of which 78.7 percent comes from international services and 21.3 percent from local services.

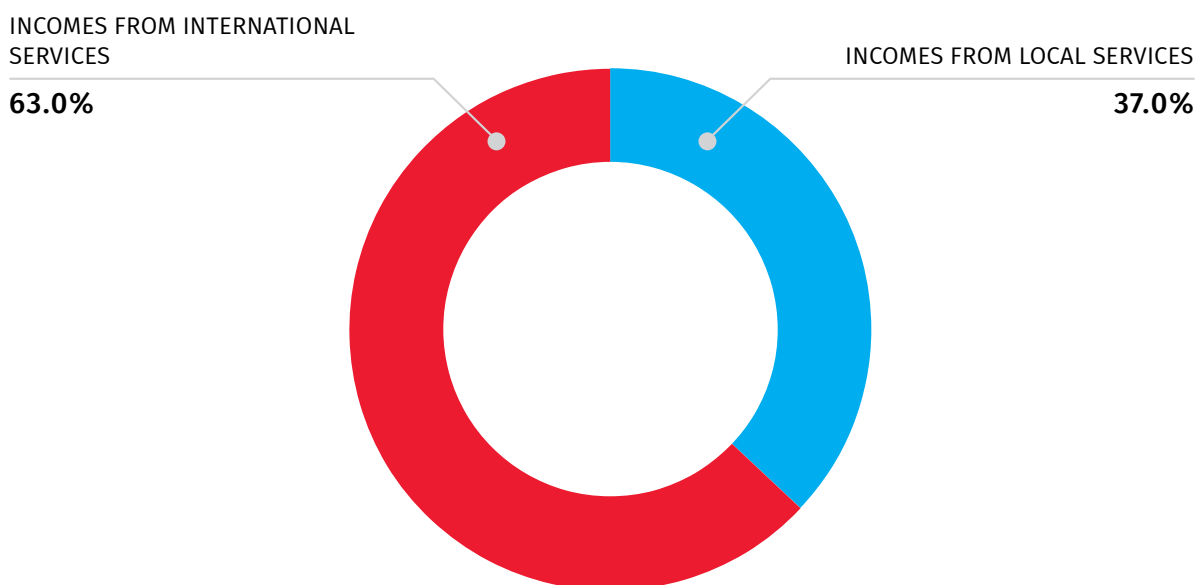

20.1 percent of income of enterprises engaged in postal and courier activities comes from written correspondence, of which 63.0 percent are international services, while 37.0 percent are local services.

5 475.5 thousand of correspondence and 4 935.3 thousand parcels were sent by enterprises engaged in postal and courier service during 2021.

In 2021, in the enterprises engaged in postal and courier activities the average annual number of employed was 4.0 thousand, including 1 197 couriers and postman.
