IMPORT PRICE INDEX IN GEORGIA

OCTOBER 2022

The Import Price Index (MPI) decreased by 0.3 percent over the **previous month**, while compared to October 2021 the index decrease amounted to 1.1 percent.

Compared to October 2021 the prices were 11.2 percent lower for products from mining and quarrying. For manufactured products a price decrease of 0.4 percent was registered, while for electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning prices increased by 122.4 percent. With regard to water supply, sewerage, waste management and remediation services, the prices were 5.4 percent higher.

The following table shows the MPI for October 2022, compared to the same month of the previous year, as well as the contributions of subgroups that had a major effect on the index:

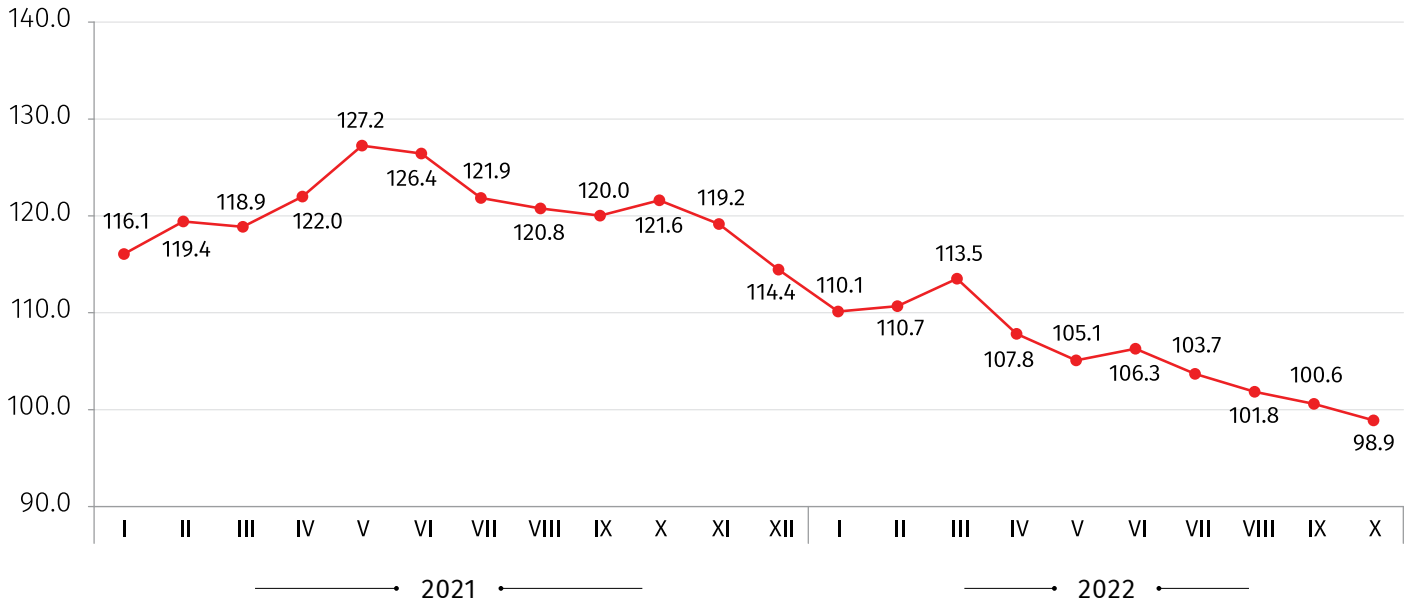
