(2022/2023 ACADEMIC YEAR)

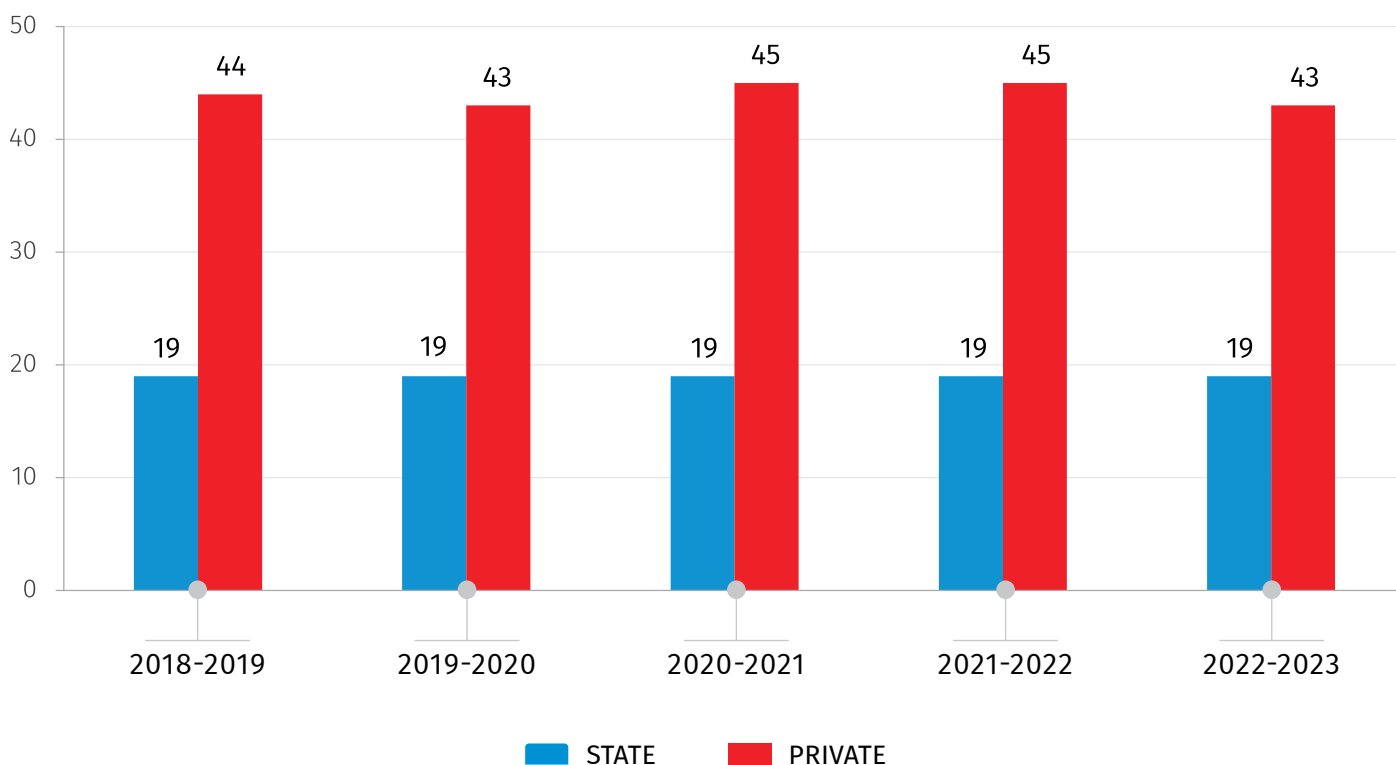
At the beginning of the 2022-2023 academic year, 62 higher education institutions were in Georgia, of which - 19 state and 43 private institutions. 64.5 percent of higher education institutions are located in Tbilisi.

(UNIT)



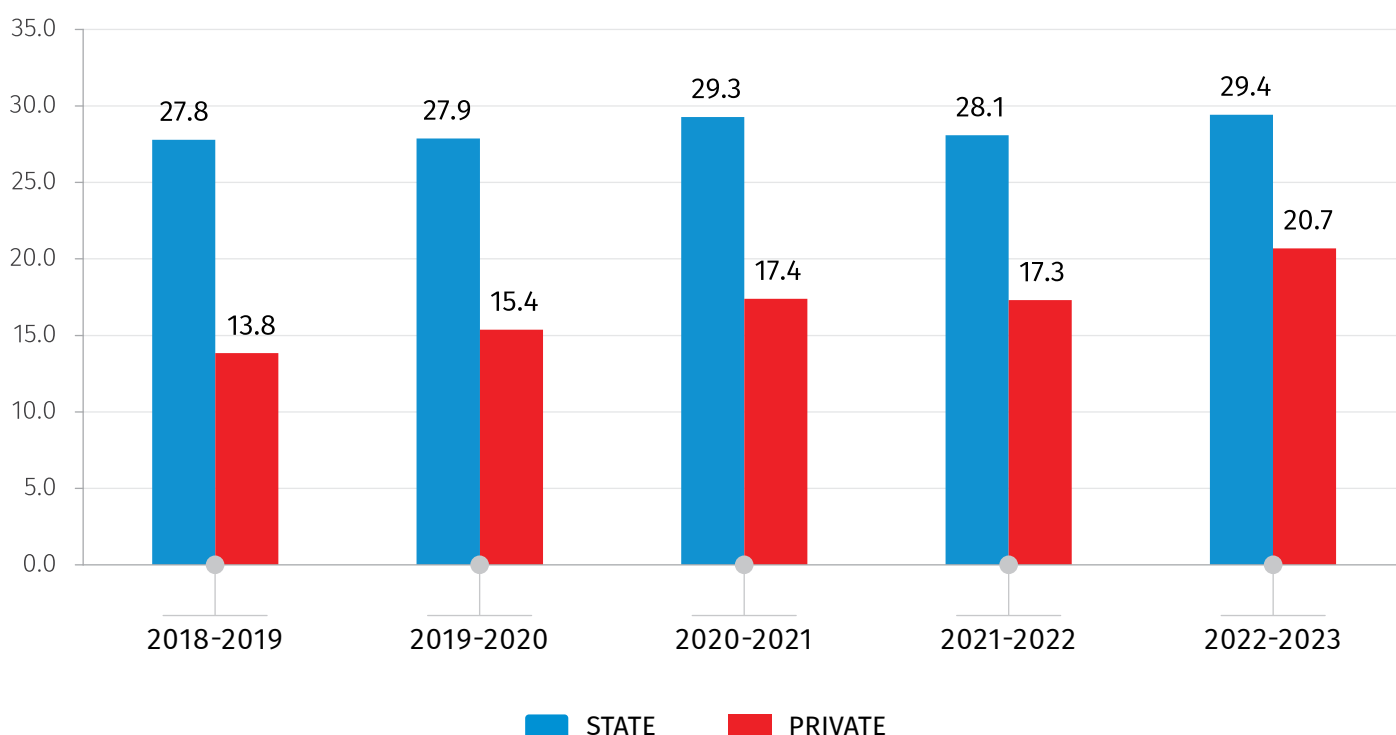
At the beginning of the 2022/2023 academic year, 50.1 thousand students were enrolled in Georgian higher education institutions, out of them 29.4 thousand in state universities and 20.7 thousand in private universities. Student admissions increased by 10.4 percent (4.7 thousand) compared to the same period of the previous year.

(THOUSANDS)**



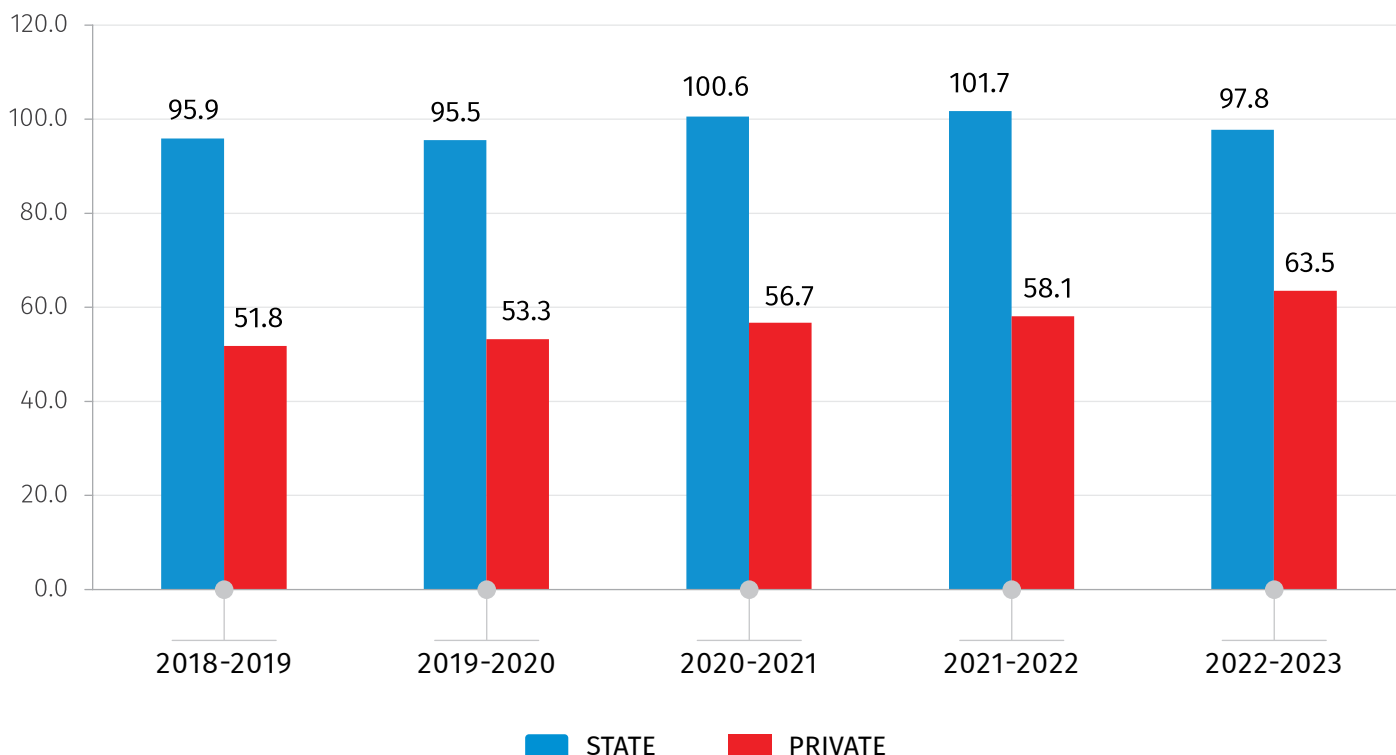
The number of students in Georgian higher education institutions amounted to 161.3 thousand, which is 0.9 percent more compared to the previous academic year. 60.6 percent of the total number of students study in state higher education institutions and 39.4 percent in private institutions. 52.0 percent of students are women and 48.0 percent are men.

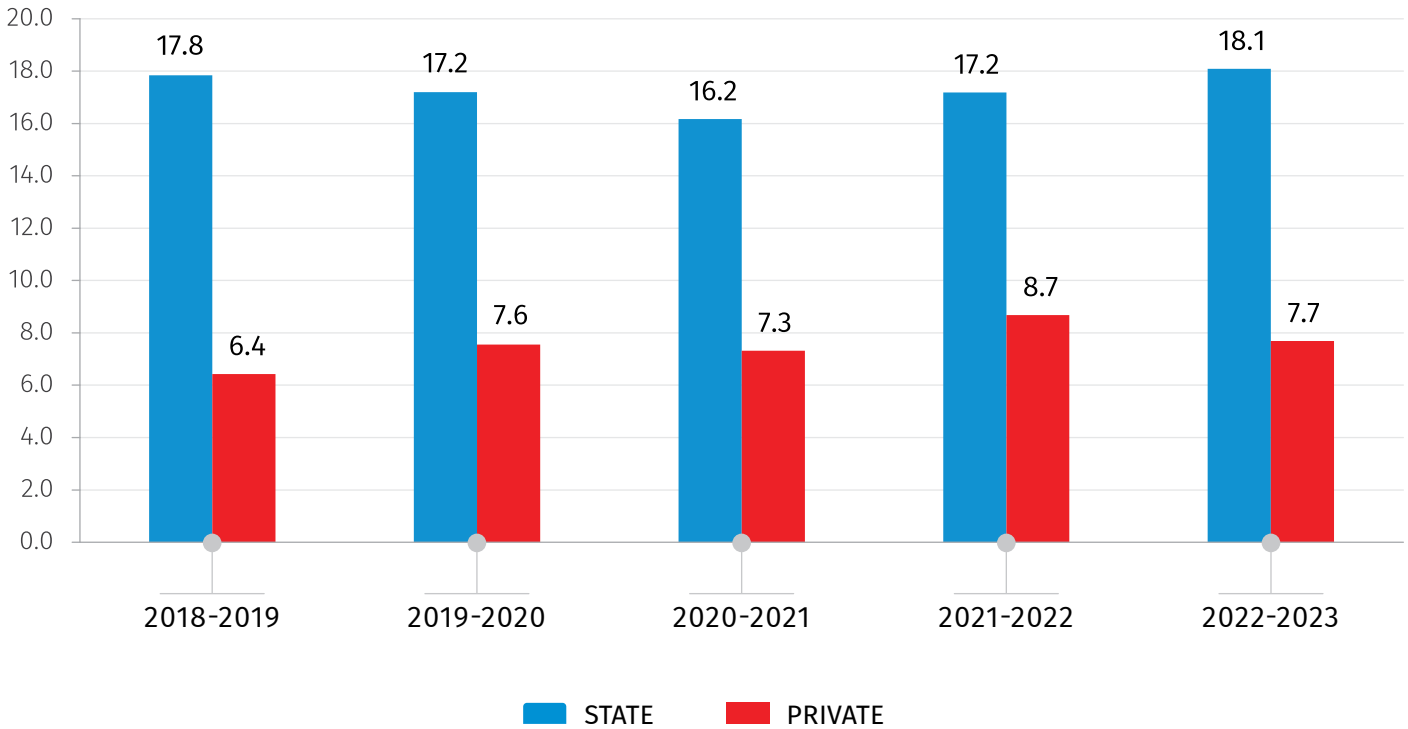
**NUMBER OF STUDENTS IN HIGHER EDUCATION INSTITUTIONS

In 2022, 25.8 thousand students graduated from higher education institutions, that is 0.3 percent less compared to the previous year. 59.4 percent of the graduates are women and 40.6 percent are men. The number of graduates in state higher education institutions is 2.4 times higher compared to the number of graduates in the private universities.

(THOUSANDS)**



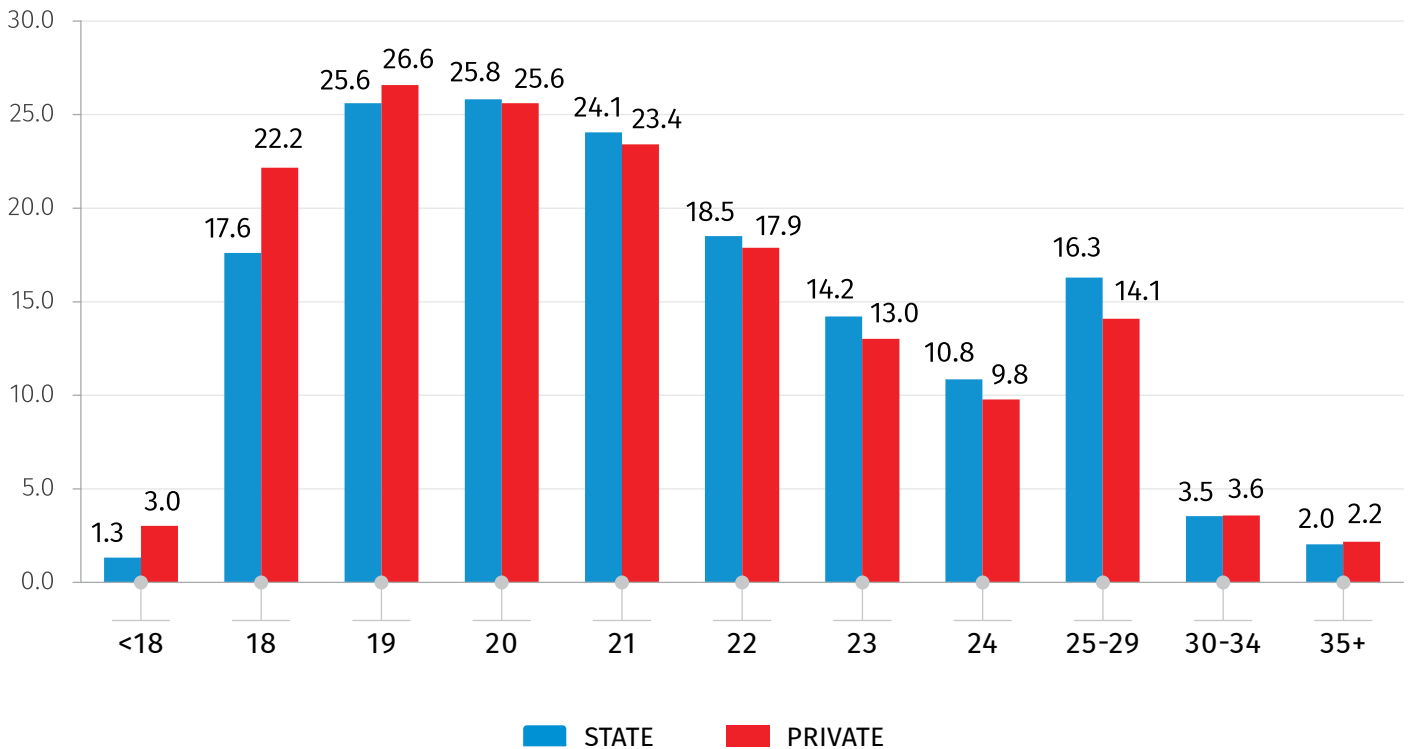
1.9 percent of students are under 18, 79.8 percent are between 18 and 23, and 18 percent are 24 and older.

At the beginning of 2022/2023 academic year, 723 students had been sent abroad for study, which is more by 239 students compared to the previous year. The number of students sent from public universities is 2.6 times higher than the number of students sent from private universities.

The number of foreign students in Georgian higher education institutions amounted to 25.1 thousand, which is 43.2 percent higher compared to the previous year.

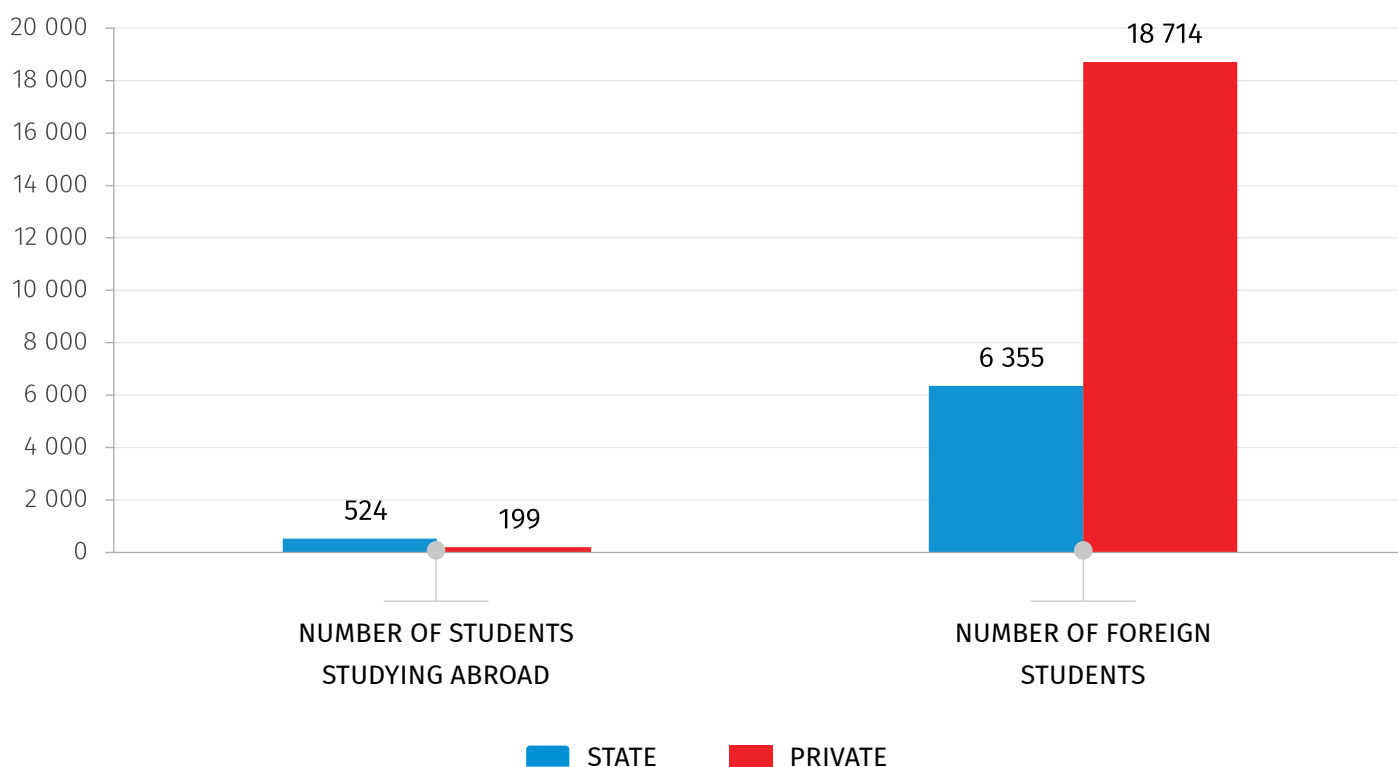
The chart below presents the number of students studying abroad and the number of foreign students in higher education institutions of Georgia in 2022/2023 academic year.

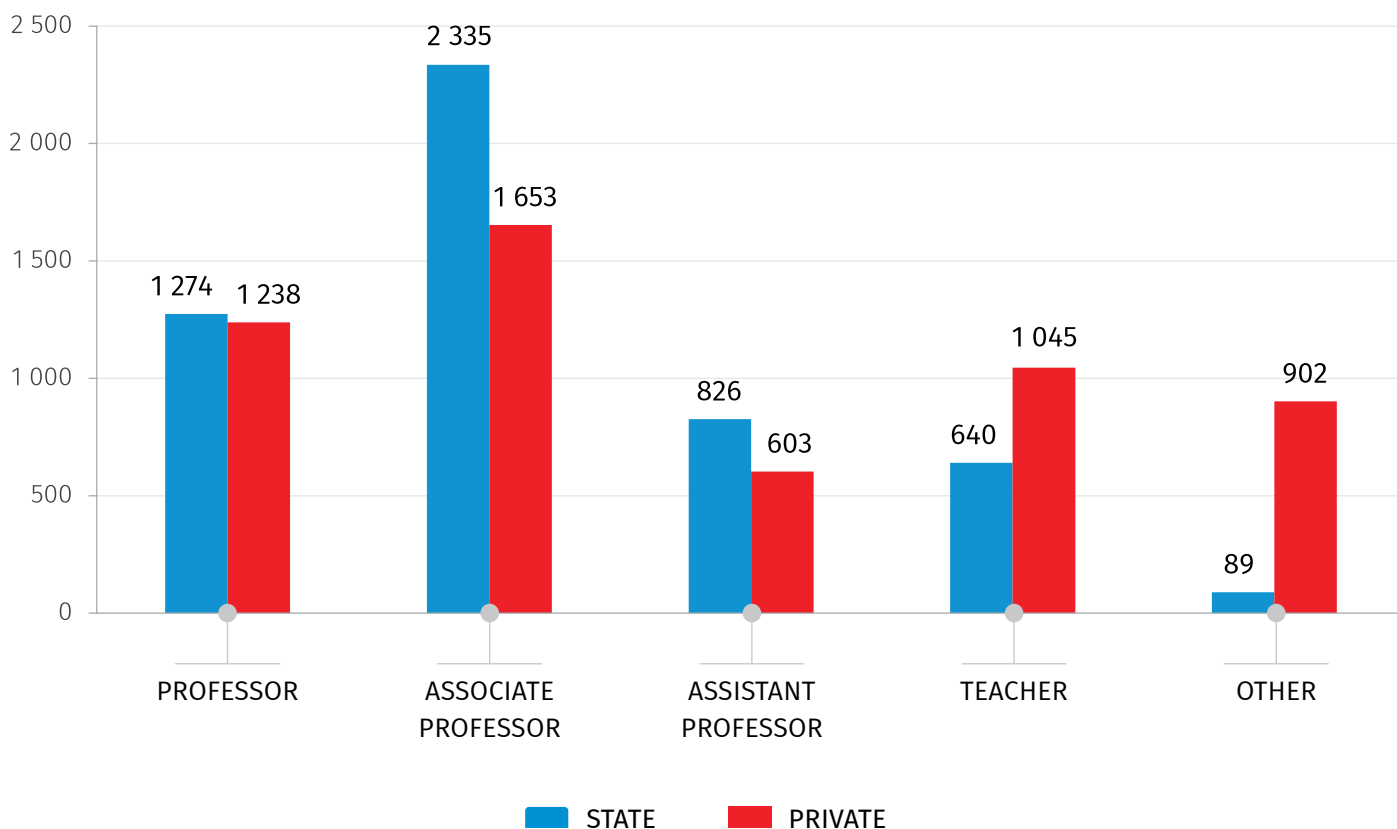

Number of professors in higher education institutions is 10.6 thousand, which is 1.2 percent more compared to the same indicator of the previous year.

In 2022, the number of doctoral students admitted at universities decreased by 10.7 percent compared to the previous year and amounted to 874. The number of doctoral students has decreased by 6.2 percent and amounts to 3 638.

In 2022, compared to 2021, an increase in the number of admissions to doctoral programs was recorded in the health and social security program.

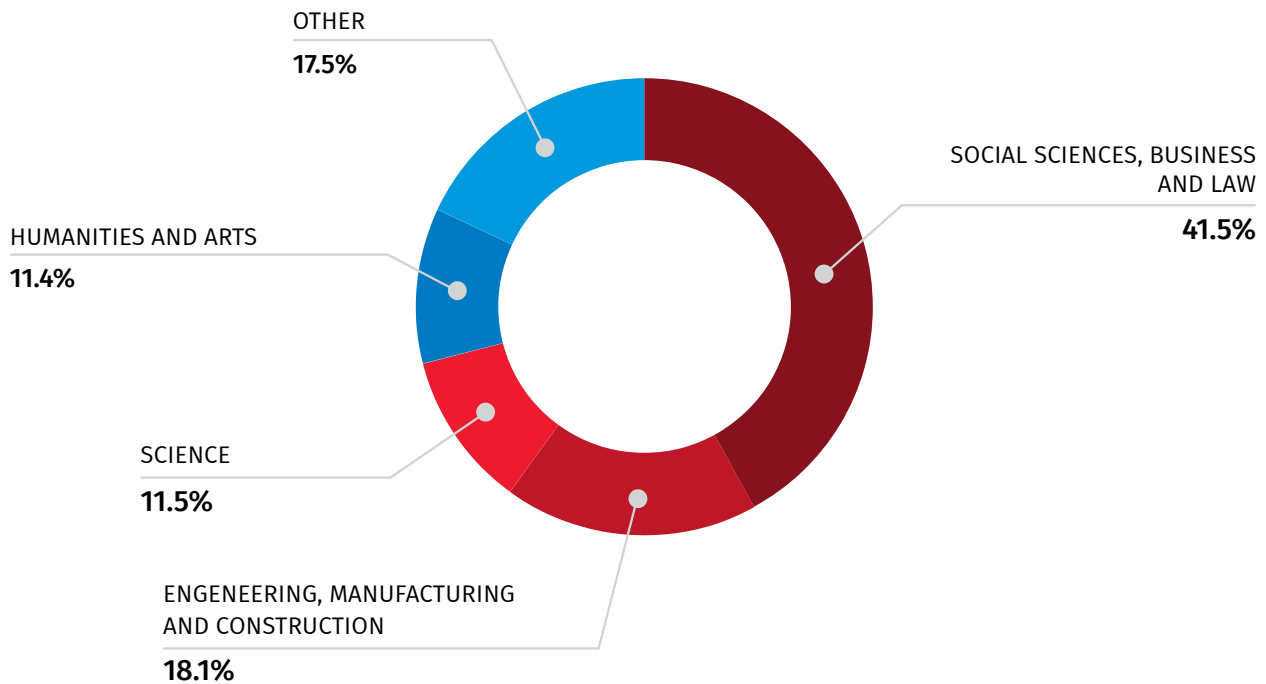
