DOMESTIC PRODUCER PRICE INDEX FOR INDUSTRIAL PRODUCTS IN GEORGIA

FEBRUARY 2023

In February 2023 the Domestic Producer Price Index for Industrial Products (DPPI) decreased by 0.1 percent compared to the **previous month**. In the mentioned period the prices for manufactured products decreased by 0.1 percent.

Compared to February 2022 the DPPI increased by 7.1 percent. The prices went up for products from mining and quarrying by 12.1 percent, for manufactured products by 8.6 percent. The prices for electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning decreased by 2.1 percent and the prices for water supply, sewerage, waste management and remediation services remained unchanged.

The following table shows the DPPI for February 2023, compared to the same month of the previous year, as well as the contributions of subgroups that had a major effect on the index:


