IMPORT PRICE INDEX IN GEORGIA
APRIL 2023

The Import Price Index (MPI) increased by 0.1 percent over the **previous month**, while compared to April 2022 the index decrease amounted to 14.0 percent.

Compared to April 2022 the prices were 15.4 percent lower for products from mining and quarrying. For manufactured products a price decrease of 14.0 percent was registered, while for electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning prices decreased by 88.8 percent. With regard to water supply, sewerage, waste management and remediation services, the prices were 3.3 percent lower.

The following table shows the MPI for April 2023, compared to the same month of the previous year, as well as the contributions of subgroups that had a major effect on the index:

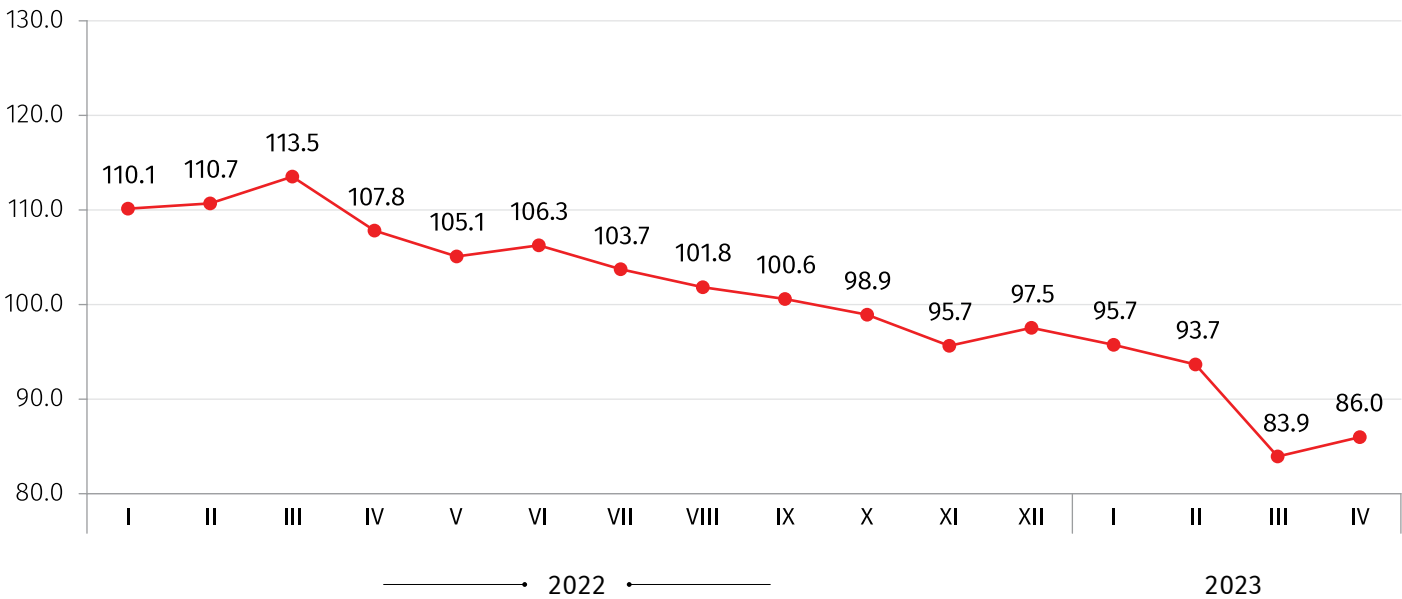
