IMPORT PRICE INDEX IN GEORGIA

JUNE 2023

The Import Price Index (MPI) increased by 0.5 percent over the **previous month**, while compared to June 2022 the index decrease amounted to 12.5 percent.

Compared to June 2022 the prices were 12.9 percent lower for products from mining and quarrying. For manufactured products a price decrease of 13.9 percent was registered, while for electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning prices increased by 13.0 percent. With regard to water supply, sewerage, waste management and remediation services, the prices were 11.0 percent lower.

The following table shows the MPI for June 2023, compared to the same month of the previous year, as well as the contributions of subgroups that had a major effect on the index:

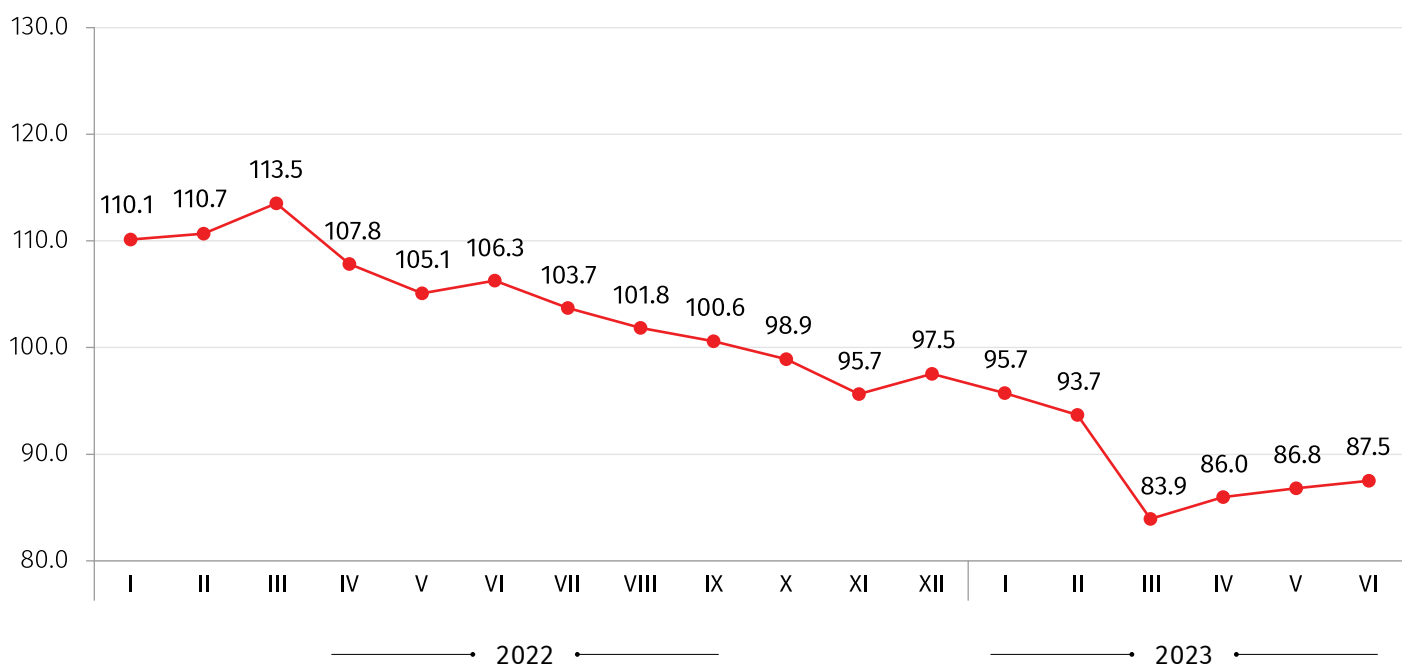
