

INBOUND TOURISM STATISTICS

(II QUARTER, 2023 YEAR)

In the II quarter of 2023, the number of arrivals of international non-resident travellers¹ in the territory of Georgia equaled 1.7 million, which is 57.4 percent higher compared to the data from the same period of previous year. Most of the incomes, 46.4 percent, were made by travellers of 31-50 age group.

DISTRIBUTION OF ARRIVALS OF INTERNATIONAL NON-RESIDENT TRAVELLERS BY THE AGE GROUPS IN II QUARTERS OF 2022-2023 YEARS

The number of visits² by international visitors³ from above-mentioned number made up 1.5 million, which is 58.7 percent higher compared to the data from the same period of 2022.

¹According to the Word Tourism Organization, a **traveller** is someone who moves between different geographic locations, for any purpose and any duration.

² Visit is a movement of visitors

³ Visitor is a traveler aged 15 or above, non-resident of Georgia, took a trip outside his/her usual environment to Georgia for less than a year (except following categories: employment, diplomatic or consular officers accredited to Georgia, Armed Forces servants and their dependants and persons who frequently cross borders).



The chart below illustrates the number of travels made by international non-resident travellers and visits made by international visitors in the II quarters of 2022-2023.

NUMBER OF THE TRAVELS MADE BY INTERNATIONAL NON-RESIDENT TRAVELLERS AND VISITS MADE BY INTERNATIONAL VISITORS IN II QUARTERS OF 2022-2023 YEARS



In the II quarter of 2023 the number of international visitors equaled to 1.2 million that is 58.1 percent higher compared to the data from the same period of previous year.

In the reporting period, international visitors have made 1.1 million tourist-type visits, which is 44.8 percent higher compared to the data from the same period of previous year. The chart below shows the distribution of visits made by international visitors by the type of visit.

73.5 percent of international visitors were only tourists⁴. The share of excursionists⁵ amounted to 22.6 percent, while 3.9 percent of visitors were both tourists and same-day visitors.



In II quarter of 2023 the largest number of visitors (290.8 thousand visitors) was from Turkey, which amounts to 24.0 percent of total number of visitors. On second place is Russian Federation with 22.1% share and on third place – Armenia with 12.4% share.

Correspondingly, the largest number of visits were made by the citizens of Turkey (366.1 thousand), Russian Federation (320.8 thousand) and Armenia (214.6 thousand).

In II quarter of 2023, the purpose of the majority of visits (51.5 percent) was holiday, leisure and recreation.



DISTRIBUTION OF THE NUMBER OF VISITS MADE BY INBOUND VISITORS BY THE VISITED REGIONS IN II QUARTER, 2023 YEAR



In II quarter of 2023 the average number of nights spent during the visits equaled to 4.8 nights, which is 22.3 percent lower than the figure indicated in II quarter of 2022 (6.2 nights). 73.9 percent of visits was repeating visit. The chart below shows the distribution of visits by the level of satisfaction in II quarter of 2023.



DISTRIBUTION OF THE NUMBER OF VISITS MADE BY INBOUND VISITORS BY THE SATISFACTION LEVEL IN II QUARTER, 2023 YEAR



The expenditures during the visits made in II quarter of 2023 equaled to 3.4 billion GEL, which is 49.1 percent higher compared to the data from the same period of previous year. Average expenditure on the visit decreased by 6.1 percent compared to II quarter of 2022 and amounted to 2 292.0 GEL.
