MAIN INDICATORS OF NON-PROFIT INSTITUTIONS 2022


(COMPARISONS ARE MADE BY ACTUAL PRICES)

The Non-profit institutions are legal entities or organizations which produce goods and services and are not focused to receive financial profit. The main part of goods and services produced by Non-profit institutions are distributed free of charge or in not significant prices. The mentioned organizations mostly are on self-financing or membership fees. The financial and nonfinancial assets can be considered as income of Non-profit institutions. They are encouraged to make an additional economic activity.

By the declared data of 2022 the turnover from auxiliary activities of Non-profit institutions has been amounted 259.6 mil. Georgian Lari, Which 22.8 percent higher compared to previous year:

The biggest share in entire structure of turnover belongs to Education (36.7 percent), Arts, entertainment and recreation (24.2 percent), Health care and social work (19.6 percent), Other services (5.7 percent), Information and communication activities (3.6 percent) and Construction (3.2 percent).

Turnover increased about 18.1 times in Agriculture, forestry and fishing, also turnover is increased in the Financial and insurance activities sector (85.7 percent), Arts, entertainment and recreation sector (78.8 percent), Transportation and storage sector(62.5 percent), Construction sector (60.0 percent), Health care and social work sector (31.7 percent), Professional, scientific and technical activities sector (16.2 percent), Accommodation and food service activities sector (8.9 percent), Education sector (1.8 percent) and in the Administrative and support service activities sector (1.5 percent).

The production value (of goods and services) of Non-profit institutions has been amounted 2 107.0 mil. Georgian Lari, Which 5.7 percent higher compared to previous year.

The biggest share in entire production value structure belongs to other services (32.7) percent), health care and social work (27.1 percent), education (13.4 percent), arts, entertainment and recreation (12.5 percent), professional, scientific and technical activities (4.3 percent).


The number of employees in non-profit organizations in 2022 was 55.2 thousand men, of which 52.9 percent were women and 47.1 percent were men. This figure is slightly higher than in 2021:

The biggest share in entire employment structure belongs to Education activities sector (26.4 percent), Arts, entertainment and recreation (23.7 percent), Health care and social work (14.5 percent), Other service activities sector (13.1 percent), Water supply, sewerage, waste management and remediation activities (11.5 percent), Professional, scientific and technical activities (5.1 percent) and the rest of share is distributed on other sectors (5.7 percent).

From the total employed persons 54.1 thousand were hired (of which 53.0 percent is female). Number of hired persons in 2021 are slightly higher than last year.
