IMPORT PRICE INDEX IN GEORGIA

SEPTEMBER 2023

The Import Price Index (MPI) increased by 1.2 percent over the **previous month**, while compared to September 2022 the index decrease amounted to 6.4 percent.

Compared to September 2022 the prices were 15.7 percent lower for products from mining and quarrying. For manufactured products a price decrease of 6.7 percent was registered, while for electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning prices increased by 38.2 percent. With regard to water supply, sewerage, waste management and remediation services, the prices were 22.1 percent higher.

The following table shows the MPI for September 2023, compared to the same month of the previous year, as well as the contributions of subgroups that had a major effect on the index:

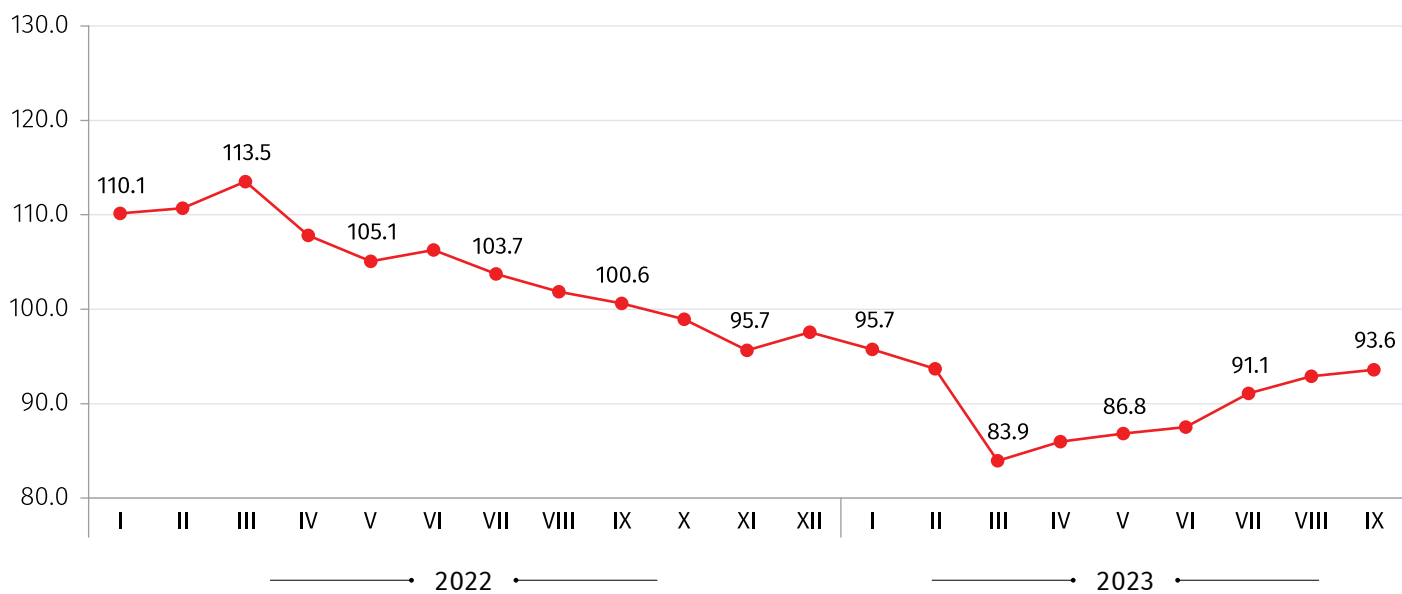
