
#### THE DOMESTIC EXPORTS IN JANUARY-OCTOBER 2023

(PRELIMINARY)

In January-October 2023 the exports of Georgia (excluding non-declared exports) equaled USD 5 102.3 million, 12.5 percent higher year-on-year. Share of the domestic exports in total export constituted 46.5 percent and amounted to USD 2 371.7 million, 23.3 percent lower to the same period of 2022.

The charts below reflect basic trends of the indicators in 2020-2023:


# TREND OF THE EXPORTS IN GEORGIA IN JANUARY-OCTOBER 2020-2023 (MILL. USD)

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In January-October 2023 the share of the top ten trading partners by domestic exports in the total domestic exports of Georgia amounted to 73.9 percent. The top partners were Russia (USD 454.9 million), Türkiye (USD 307.3 million) and China (USD 239.1 million).

In January-October 2023 copper ores and concentrates claimed the first place in the list of top export items, equaling USD 445.8 million, or 18.8 percent of total exports. The exports of wine of fresh grapes totaled USD 216.4 million and their share in the total exports amounted to 9.1 percent. The exports of ferro-alloys occupied the third place, standing at USD 143.3 million and constituting 6.0 percent of the total exports.





- 1. The discrepancy between the totals and the sum in some cases can be explained by using rounded data;
- 2. Information does not cover the data of Simplified Customs Declarations (Form Nº4);
- 3. Information does not cover non-organized trade, also occupied territories of Abkhazian Autonomous Republic and Tskhinvali region;
- 4. According to the international methodology, there are some differences in coverage of trade flows between external merchandise trade statistics and customs statistics. Diplomatic, temporary, transit and analogous goods are excluded from the database of external merchandise trade statistics.

The preliminary data will be revised according to the Geostat's revision policy (based on the regular revision principle) as a result of adjusting data by respondents/administrative sources.

Domestic exports include export of goods produced in the country, as well as imported from abroad, the value of which has significantly changed as a result of domestic processing.
