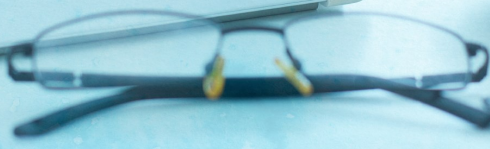




NATIONAL STATISTICS OFFICE OF GEORGIA
