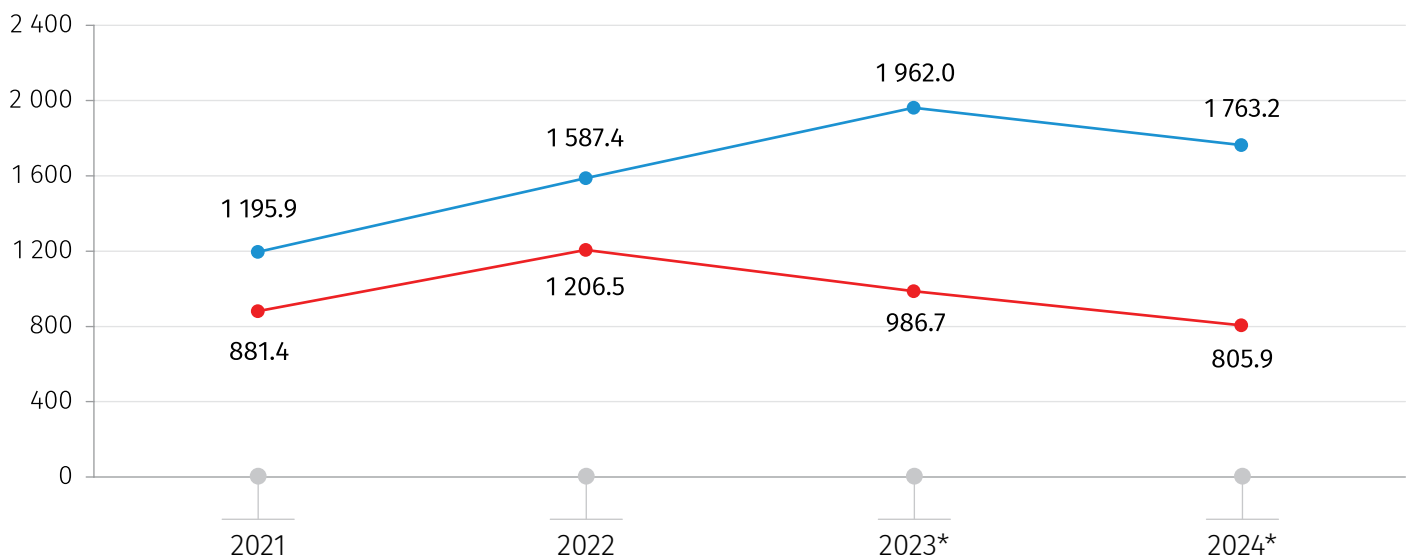

### THE DOMESTIC EXPORTS IN JANUARY-APRIL 2024 (PRELIMINARY)

In January-April 2024 the exports of Georgia (excluding non-declared exports) equaled USD 1 763.2 million, 10.1 percent lower year-on-year. Share of the domestic exports in total exports constituted 45.7 percent and amounted to USD 805.9 million, 18.3 percent lower to the same period of 2023.

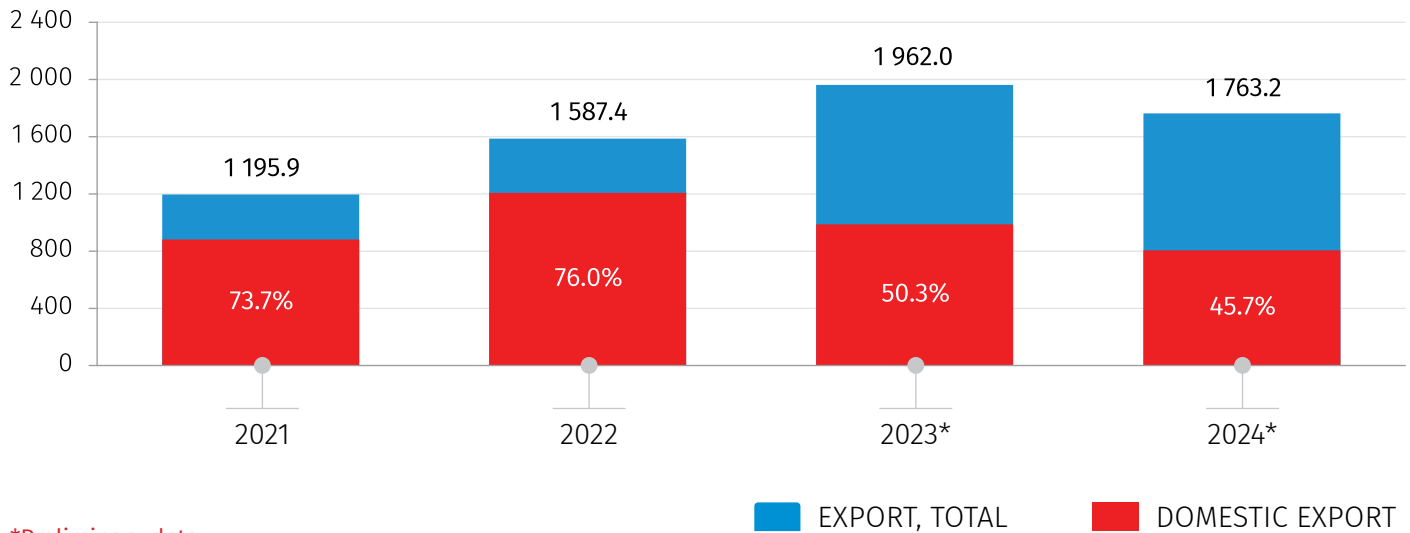

In January-April 2024 the share of the top ten trading partners by domestic exports in the total domestic exports of Georgia amounted to 71.5 percent. The top partners were Russia (USD 189.4 million), Türkiye (USD 106.3 million) and China (USD 68.2 million).

In January-April 2024 wine of fresh grapes reclaimed the first place in the list of top export items, equaling USD 126.2 million, or 15.7 percent of total exports. The exports of ferro-alloys totaled USD 82.3 million and their share in the total exports amounted to 10.2 percent. The exports of natural or artificial mineral and aerated waters, not containing sugar, occupied the third place, standing at USD 50.9 million and constituting 6.3 percent of the total exports.
