### **CONSTRUCTION COST INDEX IN GEORGIA**

MAY 2024

In May 2024 the Construction Cost Index (CCI) increased by 0.3 percent **compared to the previous month**. The change was mainly due to a 0.6 percent increase in the prices for construction materials, which contributed 0.33 percentage points to the total index change.

Compared to May 2023 the CCI increased by 8.4 percent. The latter was largely caused by the 27.3 percent increase in average monthly nominal wages of employees in the construction sector and by the 4.5 percent increase in the prices of construction materials, which contributed 4.62 and 2.7 percentage points to the total index change, respectively. Along with this, the Construction Cost Index posted a 17.3 percent increase compared to February 2022.

The following table presents the CCI in May 2024, compared to the previous month and the same month of the previous year, as well as the contributions of cost categories to the total index.
