IMPORT PRICE INDEX IN GEORGIA

JULY 2024

The Import Price Index (MPI) decreased by 0.8 percent over the **previous month**, while compared to July 2023 the index increase amounted to 1.1 percent.

Compared to July 2023 the prices were 17.1 percent lower for products from mining and quarrying. For manufactured products a price increase of 4.6 percent was registered, while for electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning prices decreased by 47.4 percent. With regard to water supply, sewerage, waste management and remediation services, the prices were 2.2 percent lower.

The following table shows the MPI for July 2024, compared to the same month of the previous year, as well as the contributions of subgroups that had a major effect on the index:

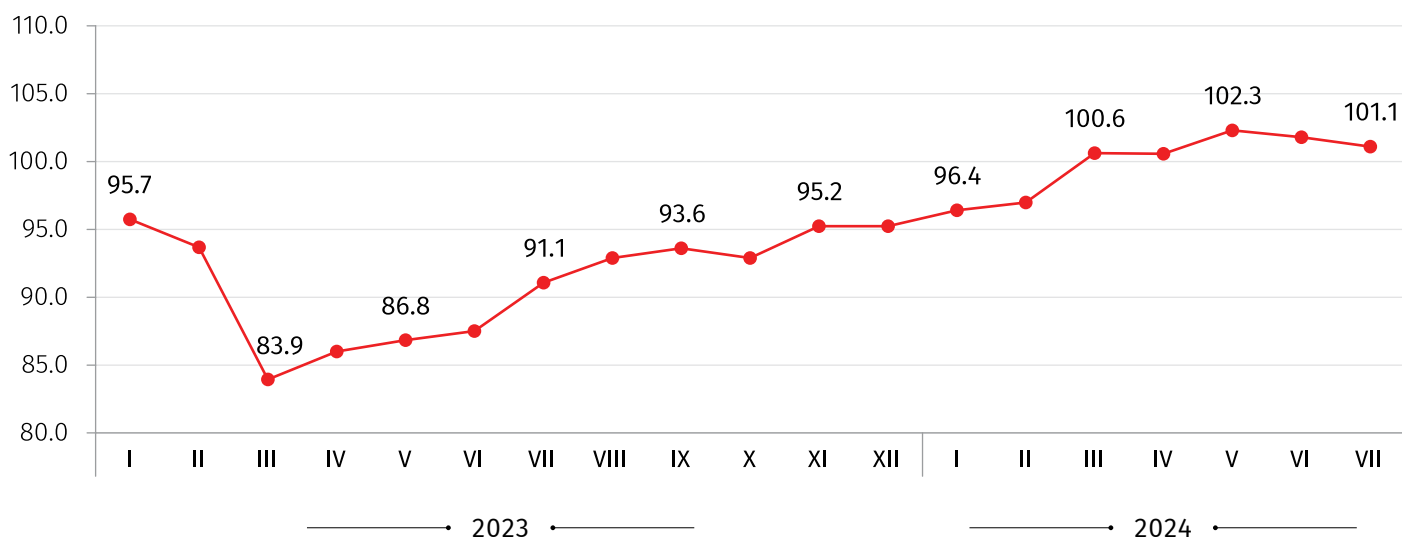
