MAIN INDICATORS OF NON-PROFIT INSTITUTIONS

2023

(COMPARISONS ARE MADE BY ACTUAL PRICES)

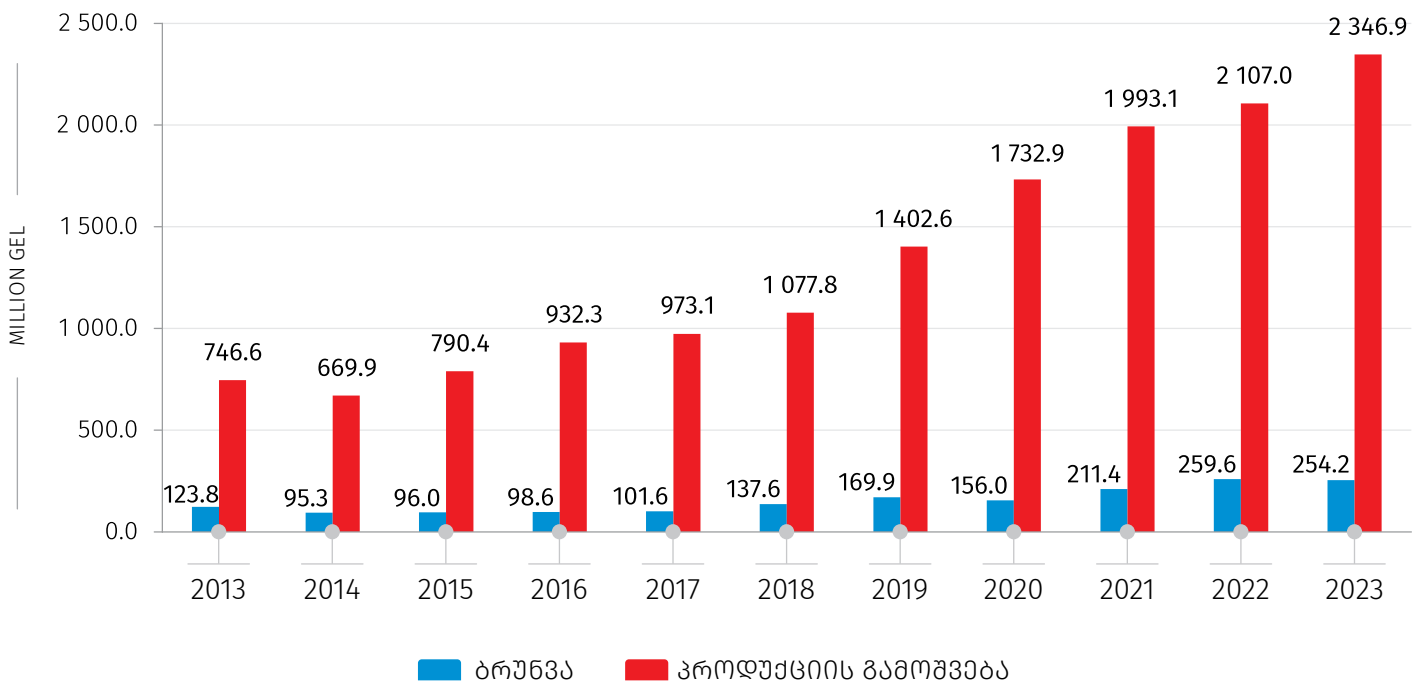
Non-profit institutions are legal entities or organizations which produce goods and services and are not focused to receive profits or financial gains.

Most of goods and services produced by non-profit institutions are sold free of charge or in economically non-significant prices. The mentioned organizations are mostly self-financed, receive donations or membership fees. Financial and non-financial assets can be also used to generate incomes for non-profit institutions and they are allowed to pursue auxiliary economic activity.

According to the declared data of 2023 the turnover from auxiliary activities of non-profit institutions amounted to 254.2 million GEL, 2 percent less compared to 2022:

The biggest shares in turnover are generated by organization in following sectors: education (38.3 percent), arts, entertainment and recreation (22.9 percent), healthcare and social work (16.2 percent), other services (7.4 percent), information and communication activities (3.8 percent), professional, scientific and technical activities (3.0 percent), and construction (2.6 percent).

Turnover increased about 5.4 times in water supply, sewerage, waste management and remediation activities. Turnover also increased in the administrative and support service activities (43.6 percent), professional, scientific and technical activities (42.1 percent), other services (27.2 percent), financial and insurance activities (24.3 percent), information and communication (3.6 percent), education (2.3 percent), and transportation and storage (0.5 percent) sectors.

The production value (of goods and services) of non-profit institutions amounted to 2 346.9 million GEL, 11.4 percent higher compared to the previous year.

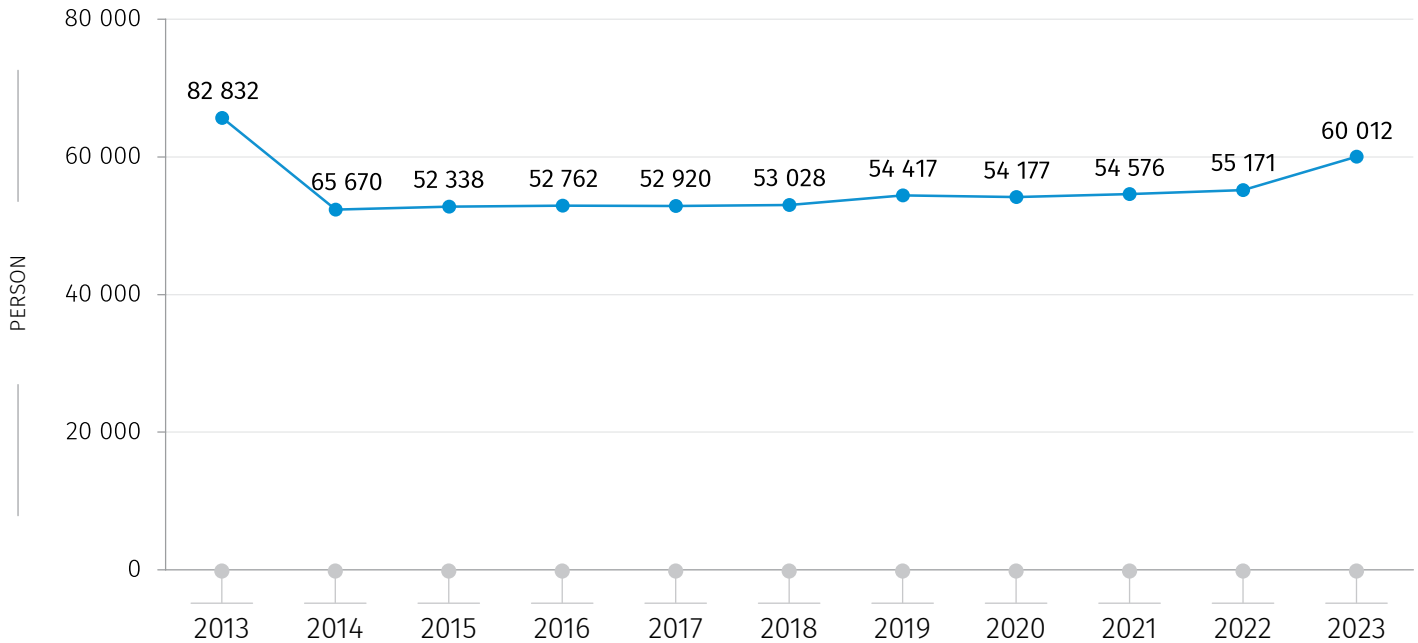
The biggest shares in production value are generated by organizations in following sectors: other services (27.7 percent), arts, entertainment and recreation (18.3 percent), healthcare and social work (14.2 percent), education (13.9 percent), professional, scientific and technical activities (11.7 percent), and water supply, sewerage, waste management and remediation activities (5.0 percent).

60.0 thousand people (52.9 percent women and 47.1 percent men) were employed in non-profit organizations in 2023. Compared to 2022, this figure has increased by 8.8 percent:

NUMBER OF EMPLOYEES OF NON-PROFIT ORGANIZATIONS



Education sector held the biggest share (27.0 percent) in employment, followed by arts, entertainment and recreation (24.3 percent), healthcare and social work (13.6 percent), water supply, sewerage, waste management and remediation activities (13.3 percent), while other sectors held the rest of 21.8 percent.

Out of all employed, 59.7 thousand were hired, which is 10.2 percent more compared to 2022.
