EXPORT PRICE INDEX IN GEORGIA

SEPTEMBER 2024

The Export Price Index (XPI) increased by 1.6 percent **compared to the previous month**. In the mentioned period the prices for manufactured products increased by 1.2 percent.

Compared to September 2023 the XPI increased by 14.8 percent. The prices for mining and quarrying products increased by 28.2 percent, for manufactured products by 13.8 percent and for water supply, sewerage, waste management and remediation services by 9.8 percent. In the same period, the prices for products from electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning decreased by 15.9 percent.

The following table shows the XPI for September 2024, compared to the same month of the previous year, as well as the contributions of subgroups that had a major effect on the index:

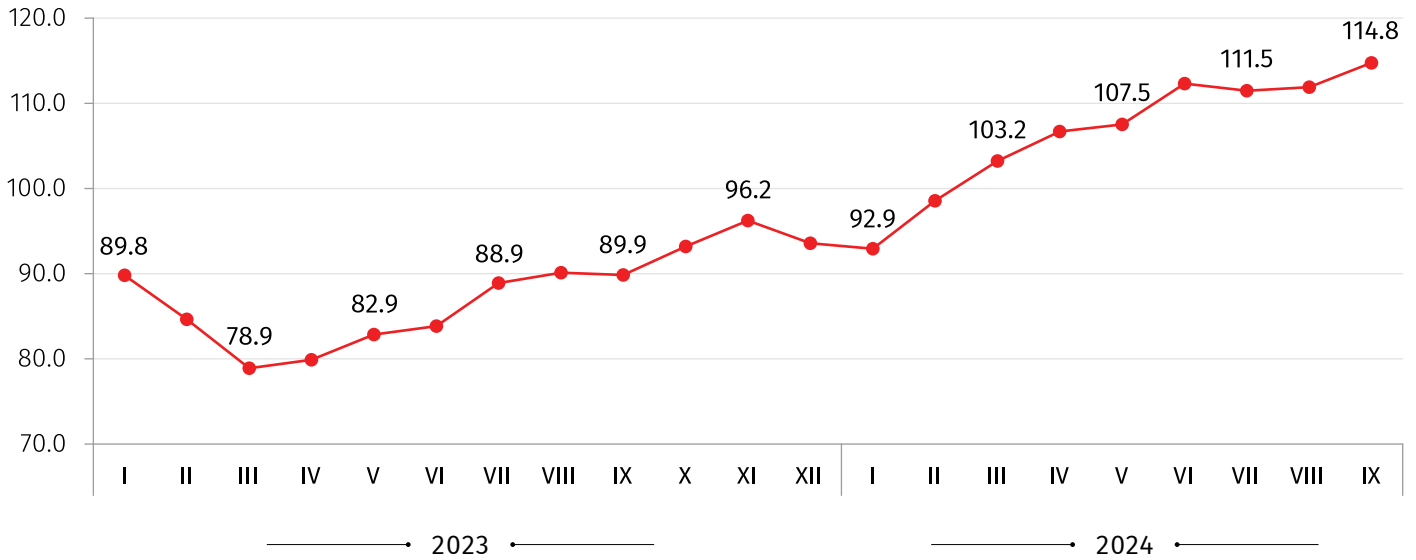
