**MAIN RESULTS OF THE SURVEY OF ENTERPRISES ENGAGED


According to the survey results, incomes of enterprises engaged in postal and courier activities<sup>1</sup> amounted to 187.4 million GEL in 2023. The largest part of the incomes (71.4 percent) was generated from international postal and courier services, while 28.6 percent was generated from local services.

73.6 percent of incomes of enterprises engaged in postal and courier activities belong to the category of parcel delivery service, of which 76.6 percent of incomes are from international services and 23.4 percent are from local.



16.1 percent of incomes of enterprises engaged in postal and courier activities is generated from written correspondence, of which 57.8 percent are international services, while 42.2 percent are local.

### STRUCTURE OF INCOMES FROM THE DELIVERY OF WRITTEN CORRESPONDENCE IN 2023



5 677.8 thousand of written correspondence and 9 471.6 thousand parcels were sent via enterprises engaged in postal and courier service during 2023.

In 2023, in the enterprises engaged in postal and courier activities the average annual number of employed was 3.7 thousand, including 1 272 couriers and postman.
