IMPORT PRICE INDEX IN GEORGIA

OCTOBER 2024

The Import Price Index (MPI) increased by 0.6 percent over the **previous month**, while compared to October 2023, the index increase amounted to 0.4 percent.

Compared to October 2023 the prices were 14.5 percent lower for mining and quarrying. For manufactured products, a price increase of 2.1 percent was recorded, while for electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning, prices decreased by 7.0 percent. With regard to water supply, sewerage, waste management and remediation services, the prices were 1.9 percent lower.

The following table shows the MPI for October 2024, compared to the same month of the previous year, as well as the contributions of subgroups that had a major effect on the index:

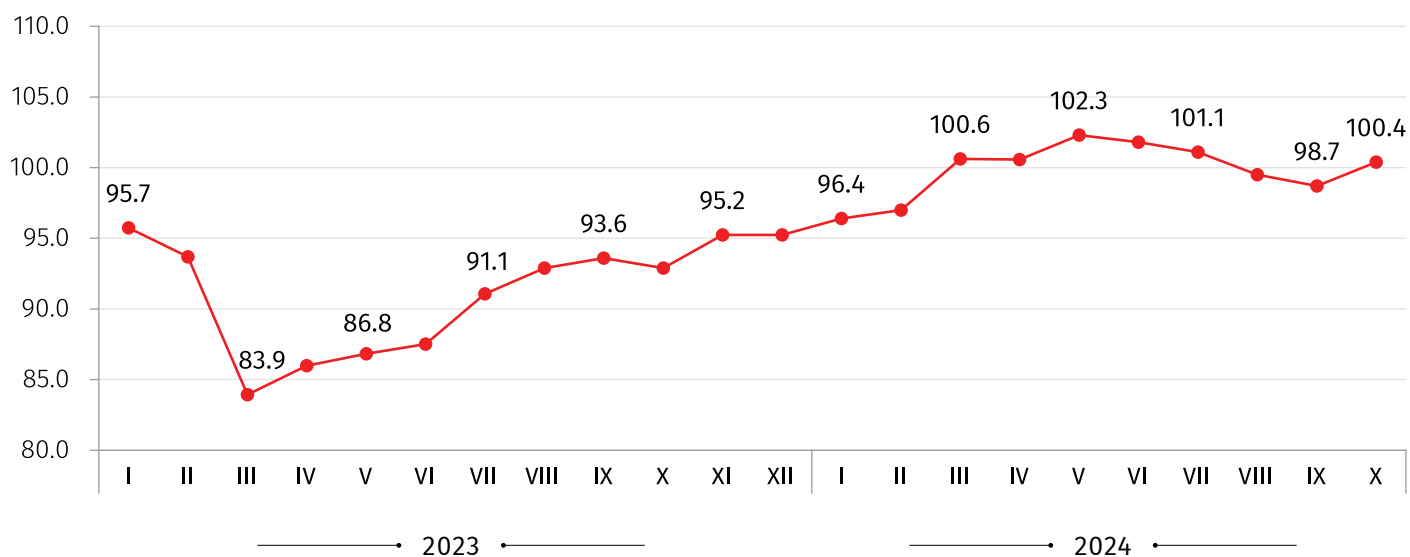
