INDICATORS OF SECONDARY GENERAL EDUCATION SCHOOLS


(2024/2025 SCHOOL YEAR)

At the beginning of the 2024/2025 school year, there were 2 294 general education institutions in Georgia, including 2 086 public and 208 private schools. Number of schools decreased by 2 unit compared to the previous school year. By region, most of schools (17.1%) are located in Imereti.

The chart below presents the number of general education institutions at the beginning of the 2020/2021-2024/2025 school years.

At the beginning of the 2024/2025 school year, 640.7 thousand pupils were studied in general education institutions, which is 1.0 percent higher compared to the same indicator of the previous school year. 89.0 percent of pupils attend public schools and 11.0 percent – private schools. Of the total number of pupils, 48.3 percent are girls, while 51.7 percent are boys.


Among the regions, most of pupils (35.8 %) study in Tbilisi.

(THOUSAND)







In 2024, 41.7 thousand pupils graduated from upper secondary school, that is 11.8 percent less compared to the same indicator of the previous year. 56.0 thousand pupil graduated from primary education, that is 1.1 percent less compared to the previous year and 46.7 thousand pupil – from basic education, that is 0.1 percent less compared to the previous year.

The chart below presents the number of pupils who received primary, basic and secondary education in 2020-2024.

NUMBER OF GRADUATES FROM PRIMARY, BASIC AND SECONDARY SCHOOL (THOUSAND)







At the beginning of the 2024/2025 school year, 66.0 thousand teacher were employed in general education institutions, which is 3.7 percent higher compared to the same indicator of the previous year. The majority of teachers are women, in particular, the share of women is 87.5 percent while the share of men - 12.5 percent.
