EXPORT PRICE INDEX IN GEORGIA

FEBRUARY 2025

The Export Price Index (XPI) increased by 0.2 percent **compared to the previous month**. In the mentioned period, the prices for mining and quarrying increased by 5.5 percent.

Compared to February 2024 the XPI increased by 9.1 percent. The prices for mining and quarrying increased by 37.4 percent, for manufactured products by 6.8 percent and for water supply, sewerage, waste management and remediation services by 15.1 percent. In the same period, the prices for products from electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning decreased by 17.0 percent.

The following table shows the XPI for February 2025, compared to the same month of the previous year, as well as the contributions of subgroups that had a major effect on the index:


