IMPORT PRICE INDEX IN GEORGIA

FEBRUARY 2025

The Import Price Index (MPI) decreased by 0.3 percent over the **previous month**, while compared to February 2024, the index increase amounted to 3.7 percent.

Compared to February 2024 the prices were 11.0 percent lower for mining and quarrying. For manufactured products, a price increase of 5.5 percent was recorded, while for electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning, prices decreased by 83.2 percent. With regard to water supply, sewerage, waste management and remediation services, the prices were 12.7 percent increase.

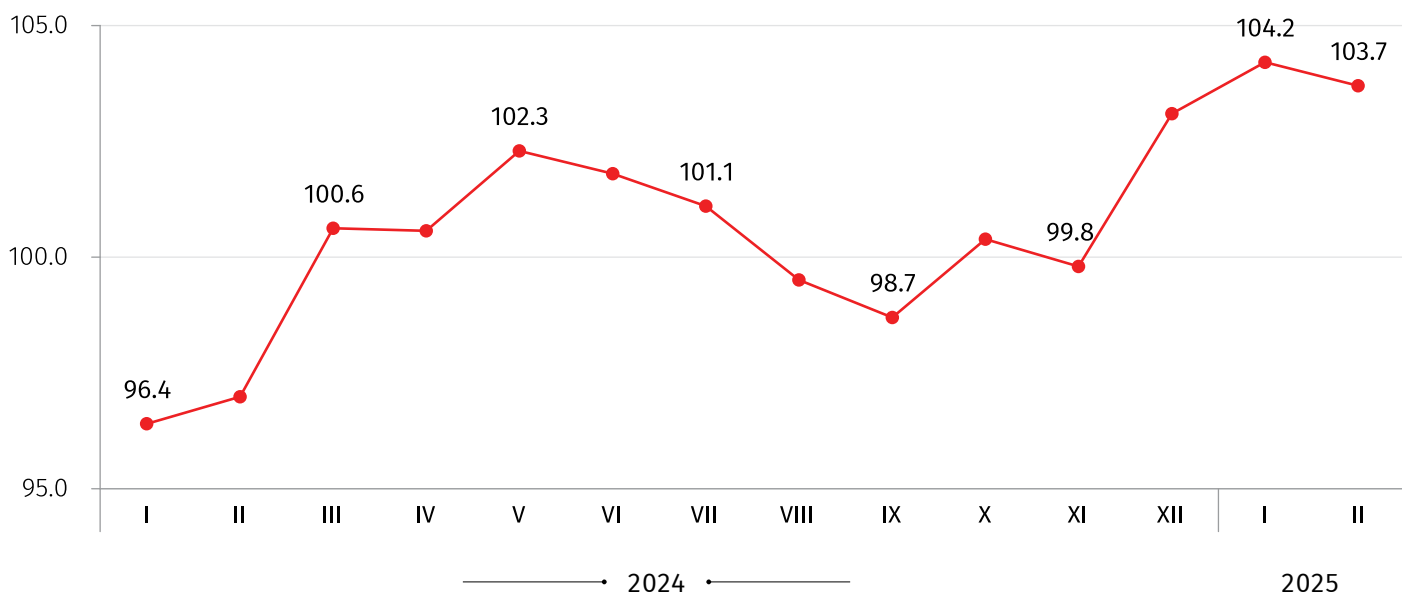
The following table shows the MPI for February 2025, compared to the same month of the previous year, as well as the contributions of subgroups that had a major effect on the index:
