THE DOMESTIC EXPORTS IN JANUARY-MARCH 2025


(PRELIMINARY)

In January-March 2025 the exports of Georgia (excluding non-declared exports) equaled USD 1 401.2 million, 5.7 percent higher year-on-year. Share of the domestic exports in total exports constituted 45.8 percent and amounted to USD 641.8 million, 0.1 percent lower to the same period of 2024.

The charts below reflect the basic trends of the indicators in 2022-2025:


TREND OF THE EXPORTS IN GEORGIA IN JANUARY-MARCH 2022-2025

In January-March 2025 the share of the top ten trading partners by domestic exports in the total domestic exports of Georgia amounted to 67.4 percent. The top partners were Russia (USD 122.0 million), Türkiye (USD 66.9 million) and China (USD 47.5 million).

In January-March 2025 Precious metal ores and concentrates reclaimed the first place in the list of top domestic export items, equaling USD 53.0 million, or 8.3 percent of total domestic exports. The domestic exports Wine of fresh grapes totaled USD 49.6 million and their share in the total domestic exports amounted to 7.7 percent. The domestic exports of Spirituous beverages occupied the third place, standing at USD 45.4 million and constituting 7.1 percent of the total domestic exports.

- 1. The discrepancy between the totals and the sum in some cases can be explained by using rounded data;
- 2. Information does not cover the data of Simplified Customs Declarations (Form Nº4);
- 3. Information does not cover non-organized trade, also occupied territories of Abkhazian Autonomous Republic and Tskhinvali region;
- 4. According to the international methodology, there are some differences in coverage of trade flows between external merchandise trade statistics and customs statistics. Diplomatic, temporary, transit and analogous goods are excluded from the database of external merchandise trade statistics.

The preliminary data will be revised according to the Geostat's revision policy (based on the regular revision principle) as a result of adjusting data by respondents/administrative sources.

Domestic exports include export of goods produced in the country, as well as imported from abroad, the value of which has significantly changed as a result of domestic processing.

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
