IMPORT PRICE INDEX IN GEORGIA

JUNE 2025

The Import Price Index (MPI) increased by 1.8 percent over the **previous month**, while compared to June 2024, the index increase also amounted to 1.8 percent.

Compared to June 2024 the prices were 1.5 percent lower for mining and quarrying. For manufactured products, a price increase of 2.2 percent was recorded, while for electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning, prices increased by 45.0 percent. With regard to water supply, sewerage, waste management and remediation services, the prices were 26.9 percent higher.

The following table shows the MPI for June 2025, compared to the same month of the previous year, as well as the contributions of subgroups that had a major effect on the index:

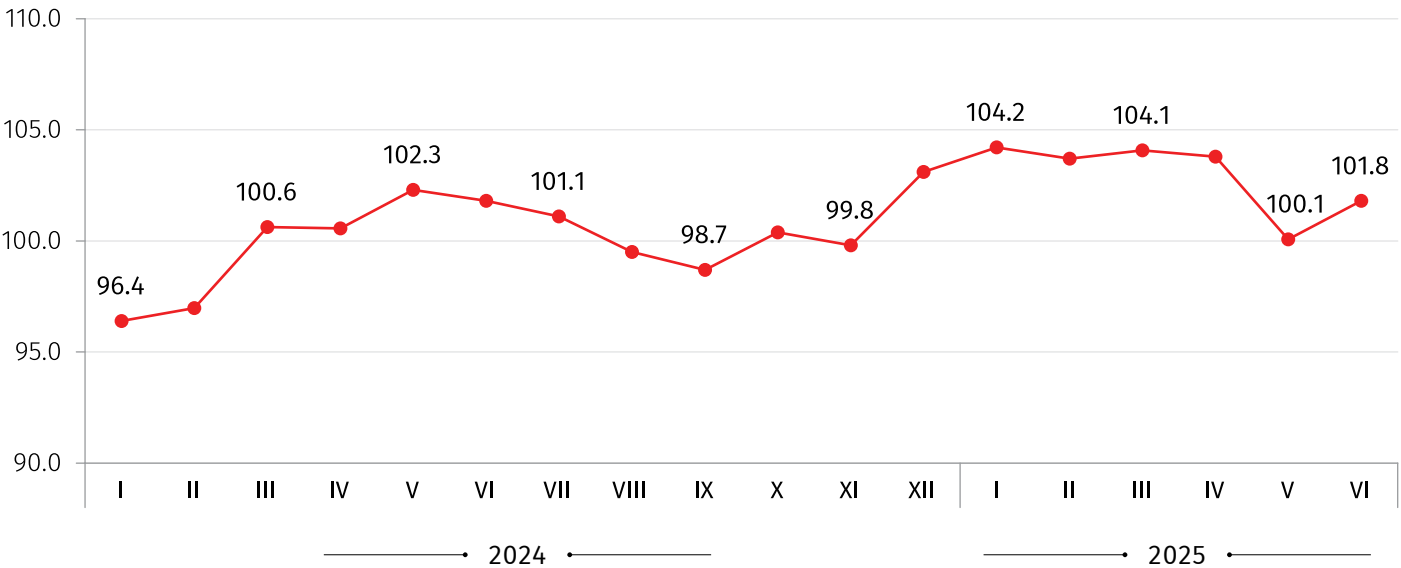
