
### INFORMATION ON HOTELS AND HOTEL TYPE ENTERPRISES 2024

According to the declared data, 2 612 economic entities<sup>1</sup> operated in hotel services in Georgia in 2024 and they owned 2 662 hotels and hotel-type enterprises (including local units and branches). This figure is 7.0 percent higher than the same indicator in 2023.

In the reporting period majority of hotels and hotel-type enterprises operated in Tbilisi (22.5 percent) and Adjara A/R (20.5 percent). The chart Nº1 shows the distribution of the number of hotels by regions.



The most widespread legal form for economic entities engaged in hotel services was the "Individual entrepreneur", which comprised 62.9 percent of the total number of hotels and hotel-type enterprises operating in 2024. The chart below shows the distribution of the number of hotels and hotel-type enterprises by legal forms.

### DISTRIBUTION OF THE NUMBER OF HOTELS AND HOTEL-TYPE ENTERPRISES BY ORGANIZATIONAL-LEGAL FORMS IN 2024



99.8 percent of hotels and hotel-type enterprises were privately owned and 0.2 percent — state-owned.

In 2024 the total area of the hotels and hotel-type enterprises operating in Georgia was 3 610.5 thousand square meters, which is 2.4 percent higher than the same indicator in 2023. The living area of all rooms in 2024 was 1 616.5 thousand square meters, which is 4.1 percent higher than the same indicator in the previous year.

In 2024 the total number of bed-places in operating hotels and hotel-type enterprises equaled 113.5 thousand, which is 5.3 percent higher than the same indicator of the previous year. The total number of bedrooms increased year-over-year by 2.1 percent in 2024 and equaled 51.2 thousand. The chart N23 shows the distribution of the number of bedrooms and bed-places in hotels and hotel type enterprises by regions.





In 2024 Georgian hotels and hotel-type enterprises served 5.8 million guests, which is 16.5 percent higher than the corresponding figure of the previous year. 63.5 percent of all guests were foreigners, most of whom (or 14.9 percent of total) were represented by 549.9 thousand (57.4 percent higher than in 2023) citizens of Israel. 8.2 percent of the foreign guests were EU citizens with German and Poland citizens representing, respectively, 30.6 and 20.8 percent of EU guests.

The majority of foreign guests staying in hotels and hotel-type enterprises with the main purpose of holiday and recreation were citizens of Israel and Russian Federation (15.4 and 14.7 percent accordingly).

29 082 people (53.3 percent of whom were women) were employed in hotels and hotel-type enterprises in Georgia in 2024.
