IMPORT PRICE INDEX IN GEORGIA
SEPTEMBER 2025

The Import Price Index (MPI) increased by 0.3 percent over the **previous month**, while compared to September 2024, the index increase amounted to 3.1 percent.

Compared to September 2024 the prices were 1.3 percent lower for mining and quarrying. For manufactured products, a price increase of 3.0 percent was recorded, while for electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning, prices decreased by 33.0 percent. With regard to water supply, sewerage, waste management and remediation services, the prices were 8.2 percent higher.

The following table shows the MPI for September 2025, compared to the same month of the previous year, as well as the contributions of subgroups that had a major effect on the index:

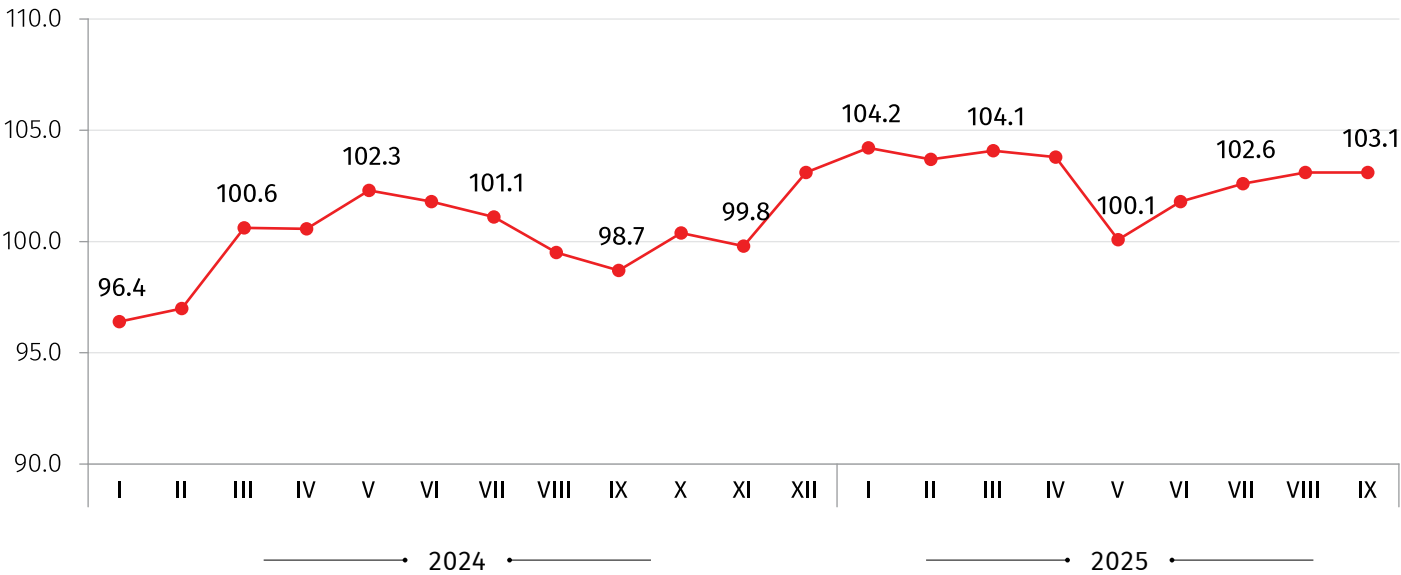
