
EXTERNAL MERCHANDISE TRADE OF GEORGIA IN JANUARY-SEPTEMBER 2025

(PRELIMINARY)

In January-September 2025 the external merchandise trade (excluding non-declared trade) of Georgia amounted to USD 18 545.0 million, 9.1 percent higher year-on-year. The exports equaled 5 151.4 million (7.7 percent higher), while the imports stood at USD 13 393.7 million (9.7 percent higher). The negative trade balance was USD 8 242.3 million in January-September 2025 and its share in external trade turnover constituted 44.4 percent.






EXPORTS AND IMPORTS DYNAMICS BY MONTHS, 2023-2025

GEORGIAN EXPORT BY COUNTRY GROUPS IN JANUARY-SEPTEMBER 2025*








TOP TRADING PARTNERS BY EXPORTS IN JANUARY-SEPTEMBER 2024-2025




TOP TRADING PARTNERS BY IMPORTS IN JANUARY-SEPTEMBER 2024-2025



In January-September 2025 motor cars claimed the first place in the list of top export items, equaling USD 2 003.9 million with 38.9 percent of total exports. The exports of precious metal ores and concentrates totaled USD 276.2 million and their share in the total exports amounted to 5.4 percent. The exports of spirituous beverages occupied the third place standing at USD 200.7 million and constituting 3.9 percent of the total exports.



The top import commodities in January-September 2025 were motor cars, whose imports equaled USD 2 805.1 million (20.9 percent of the total imports). The petroleum and petroleum oils followed in the list with USD 972.2 million (7.3 percent of imports). The Medicaments put up in measured doses were third in the top import commodity list with USD 510.7 million (3.8 percent of imports).


