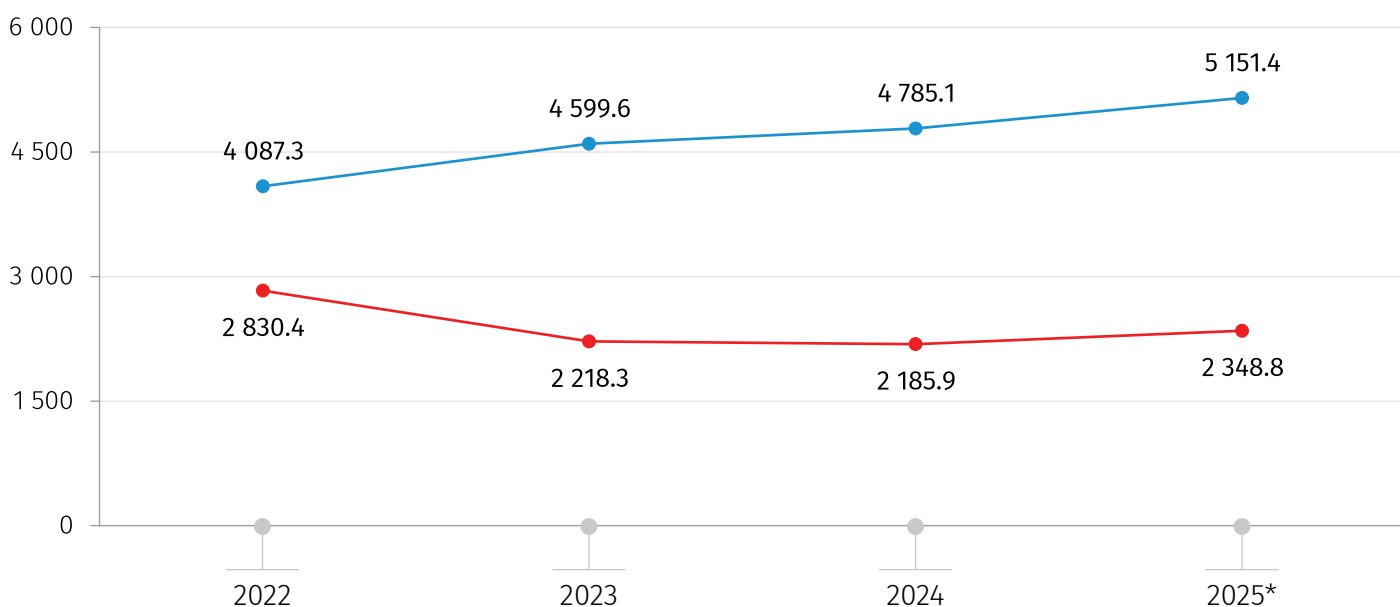

### THE DOMESTIC EXPORTS IN JANUARY-SEPTEMBER 2025 (PRELIMINARY)

In January-September 2025 the exports of Georgia (excluding non-declared exports) equaled USD 5 151.4 million, 7.7 percent higher year-on-year. Share of the domestic exports in total exports constituted 45.6 percent and amounted to USD 2 348.8 million, 7.5 percent higher to the same period of 2024.

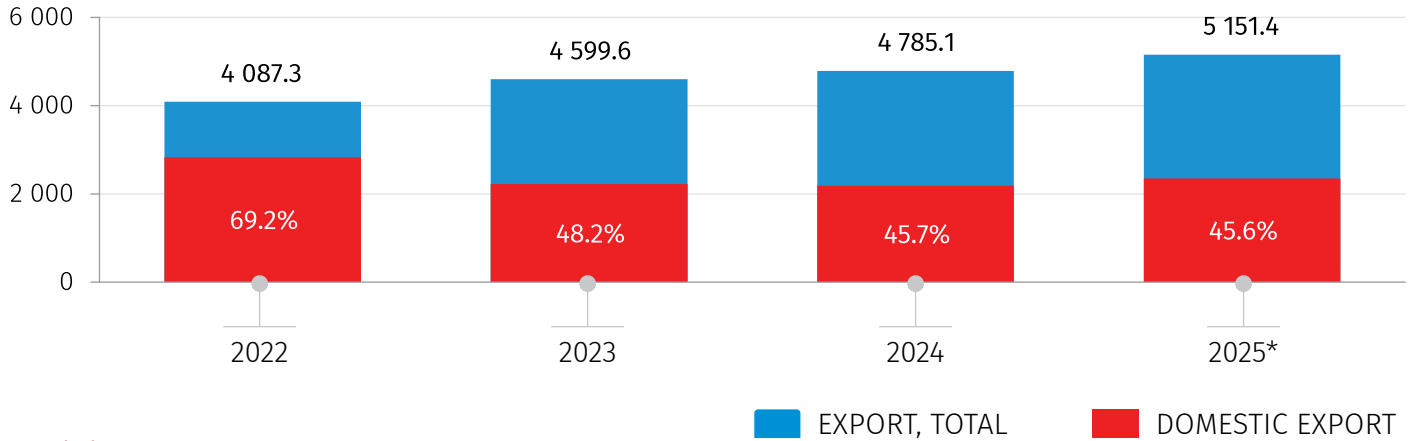

In January-September 2025 the share of the top ten trading partners by domestic exports in the total domestic exports of Georgia amounted to 70.4 percent. The top partners were Russia (USD 509.2 million), Türkiye (USD 211.0 million) and China (USD 197.1 million).

In January-September 2025 precious metal ores and concentrates claimed the first place in the list of top domestic export items, equaling USD 276.2 million, or 11.8 percent of total domestic exports. The domestic exports wine of fresh grapes totaled USD 189.1 million and their share in the total domestic exports amounted to 8.1 percent. The domestic exports of spirituous beverages occupied the third place, standing at USD 167.3 million and constituting 7.1 percent of the total domestic exports.

### NOTICE:

1. The discrepancy between the totals and the sum in some cases can be explained by using rounded data;
  2. Information does not cover the data of Simplified Customs Declarations (Form №4);
  3. Information does not cover non-organized trade, also occupied territories of Abkhazian Autonomous Republic and Tskhinvali region;
  4. According to the international methodology, there are some differences in coverage of trade flows between external merchandise trade statistics and customs statistics. Diplomatic, temporary, transit and analogous goods are excluded from the database of external merchandise trade statistics.
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**The preliminary data will be revised according to the Geostat's revision policy (based on the regular revision principle) as a result of adjusting data by respondents/administrative sources.**

**Domestic exports include export of goods produced in the country, as well as imported from abroad, the value of which has significantly changed as a result of domestic processing.**

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
