MAIN RESULTS OF THE SURVEY OF ENTERPRISES ENGAGED IN POSTAL AND COURIER ACTIVITIES (2024)

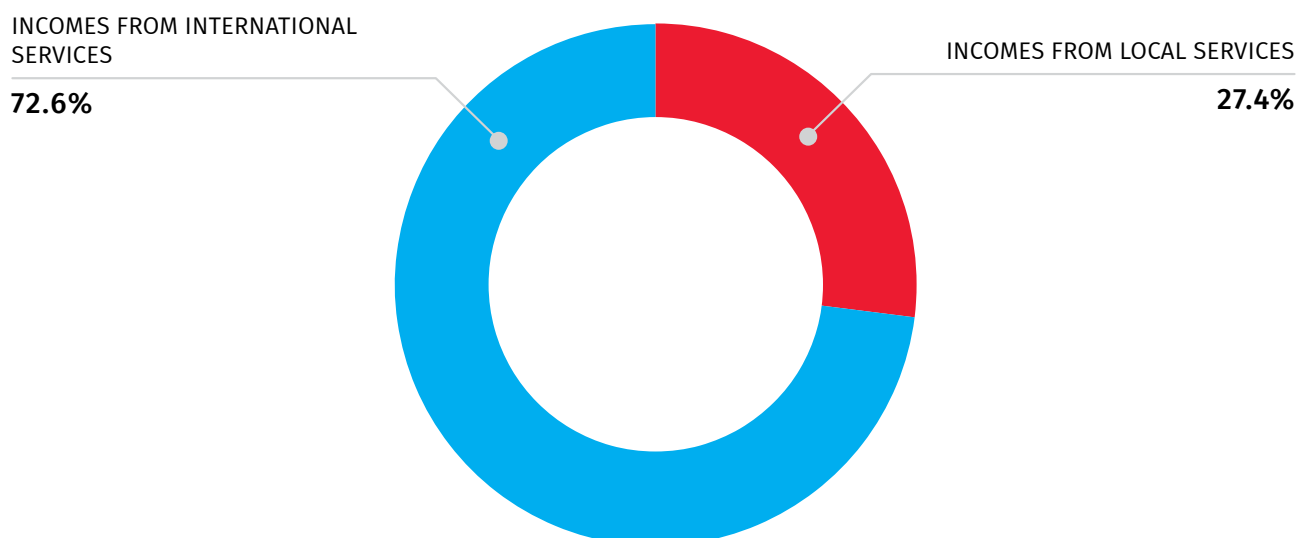
According to the survey results, incomes of enterprises engaged in postal and courier activities¹ amounted to 228.7 million GEL in 2024. The largest part of the incomes (68.0 percent) was generated from international postal and courier services, while 32.0 percent was generated from local services.

80.2 percent of incomes of enterprises engaged in postal and courier activities were generated from by parcel delivery service, of which 72.6 percent of incomes were from international services and 27.4 percent were from local.

11.7 percent of incomes of enterprises engaged in postal and courier activities were generated from written correspondence, of which 44.0 percent were international services, while 56.0 percent were local.

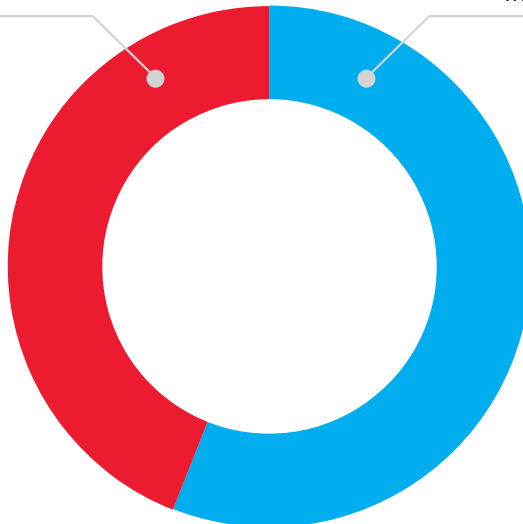
STRUCTURE OF INCOMES FROM THE DELIVERY OF WRITTEN CORRESPONDENCE IN 2024

Enterprises engaged in postal and courier activities sent 13.3 million parcels and 5.9 million of written correspondence during 2024.

In 2024, in the enterprises engaged in postal and courier activities the average annual number of employed was 4.0 thousand, including 1.5 thousand couriers and postman.
