EXPORT PRICE INDEX IN GEORGIA

OCTOBER 2025

The Export Price Index (XPI) increased by 2.1 percent **compared to the previous month**. In the mentioned period, the prices for mining and quarrying increased by 10.4 percent.

Compared to October 2024 the XPI increased by 7.1 percent. The prices for mining and quarrying increased by 29.3 percent, for manufactured products by 2.6 percent, for electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning by 40.4 percent and for products from water supply, sewerage, waste management and remediation services by 3.1 percent.

The following table shows the XPI for October 2025, compared to the same month of the previous year, as well as the contributions of subgroups that had a major effect on the index:
