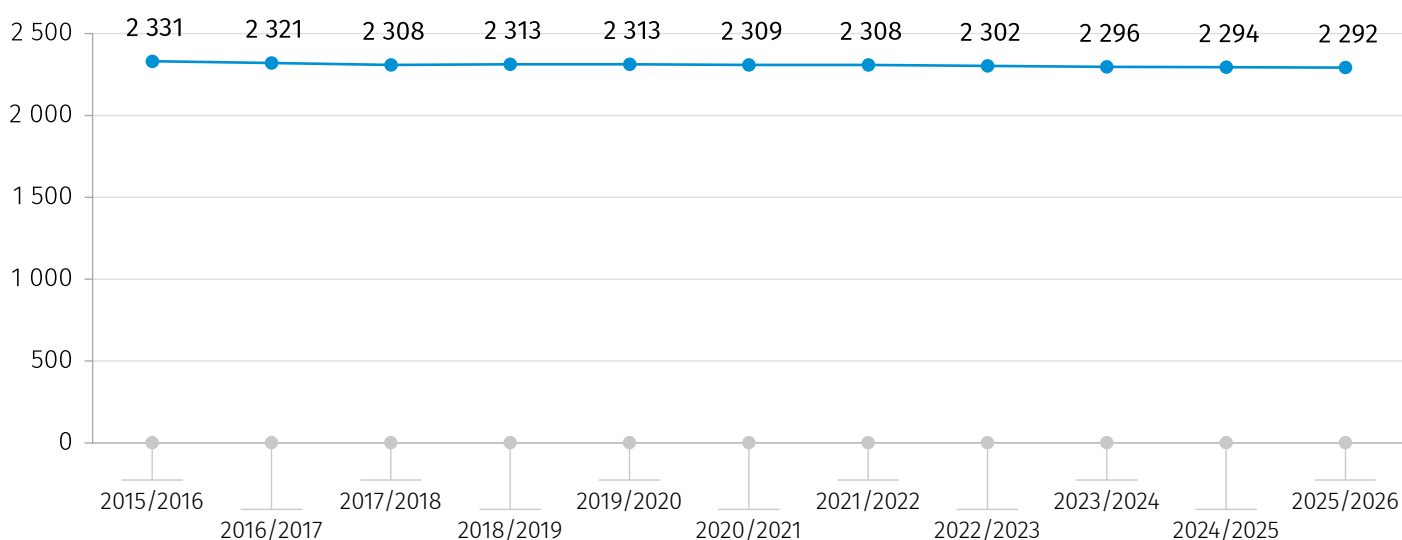
INDICATORS OF SECONDARY GENERAL EDUCATION SCHOOLS (2025/2026 SCHOOL YEAR)

At the beginning of the 2025/2026 school year, there were 2 294 general education institutions in Georgia, including 2 086 public and 206 private schools. Number of schools decreased by 2 unit compared to the previous school year. By region, most of schools (17.1%) are located in Imereti.

The chart below presents the number of general education institutions at the beginning of the 2015/2016-2025/2026 school years.

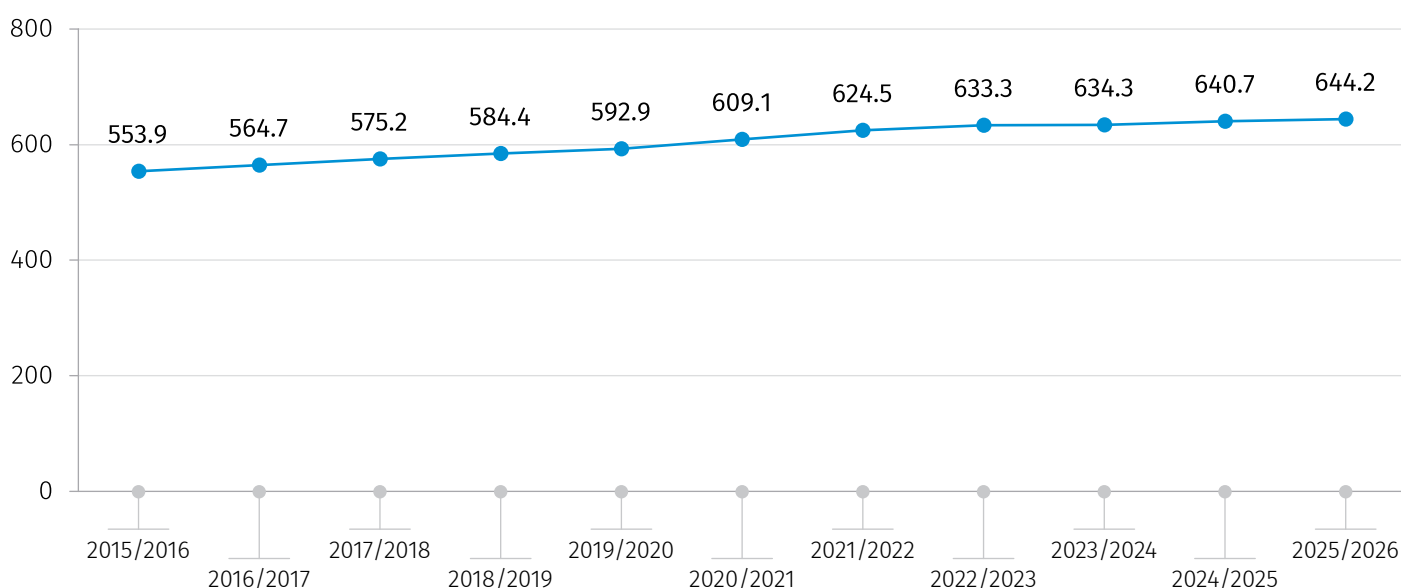
At the beginning of the 2025/2026 school year, 644.2 thousand pupils were studying in general education institutions, which is 0.6 percent higher compared to the same indicator of the previous school year. 88.8 percent of pupils attend public schools and 11.2 percent – private schools. Of the total number of pupils, 48.4 percent are girls, while 51.6 percent are boys.

Among the regions, most of pupils (36.0 %) study in Tbilisi.

The chart below presents the number of pupils in general education institutions for the beginning of the 2015/2016-2025/2026 school years.

(THOUSAND)



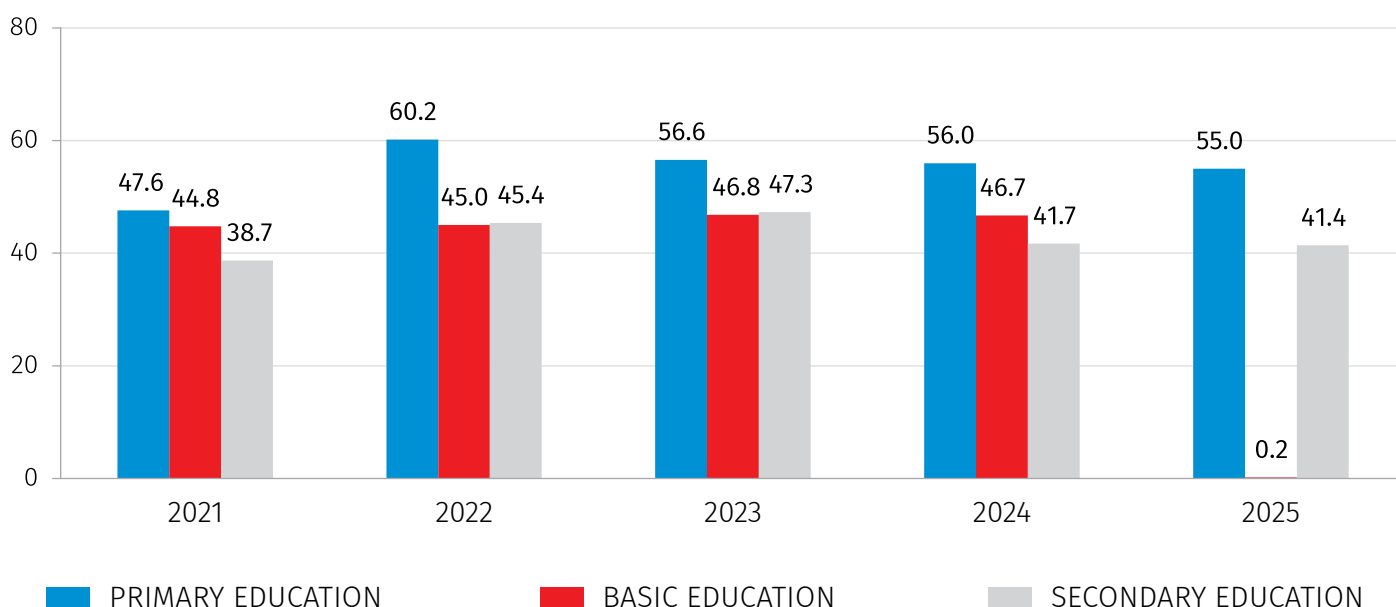
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In 2025, 41.4 thousand pupils graduated from upper secondary school, which is 0.8 percent less compared to the same indicator of the previous year. 55.0 thousand pupils graduated from primary education, that is 1.8 percent less compared to the previous year.

The chart below presents the number of pupils who received primary, basic and secondary education in 2021-2025.

¹⁾ From July 1, 2025, the Basic Level became 4 years, while the Secondary Level became 2 years. After the end of the 2024-2025 academic year, 9th graders continued their studies in the 10th grade without completing the Basic Level.

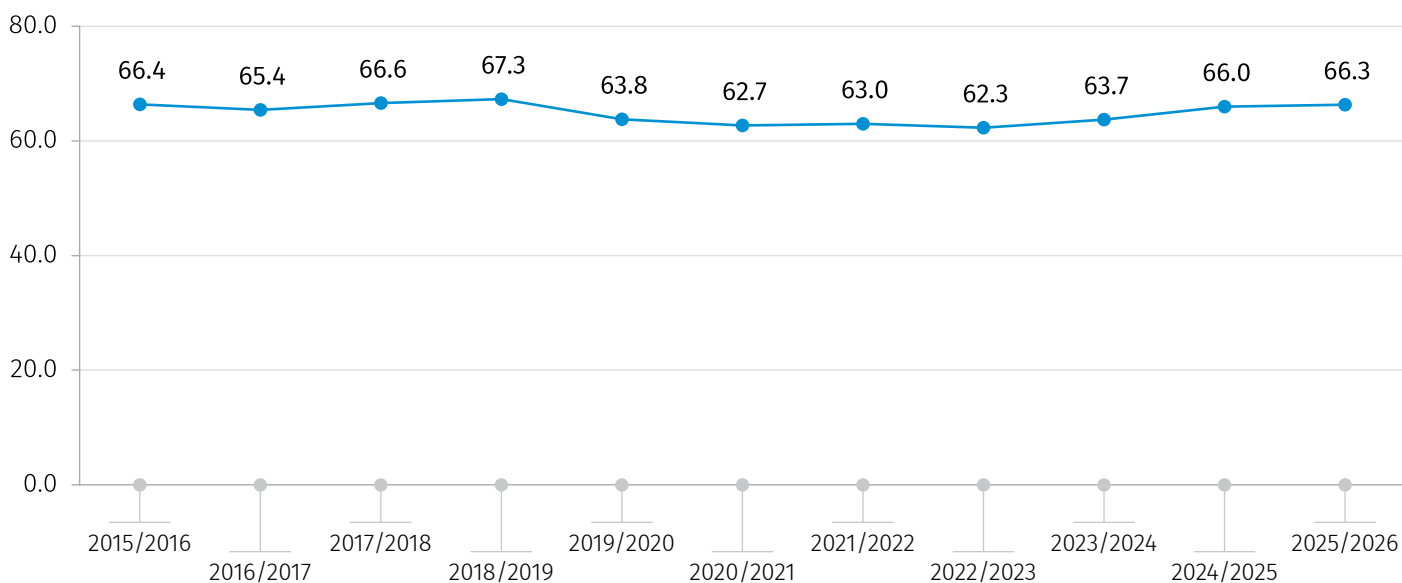

At the beginning of the 2025/2026 school year, 66.3 thousand teachers were employed in general education institutions, which is 0.5 percent higher compared to the same indicator of the previous year. The majority of teachers are women; in particular, the share of women is 87.6 percent, while the share of men - 12.4 percent.
