The need for production of energy balance is linked to such important issues of global policy, as climate change and energy security. The publication includes statistical data for 2024 year.

A wide range of growing interest of users leads to the development of the energy balance, as it is the best way to represent the local or global policy planning.

2024 Energy Balance, like the previous years' balances, is based on the recommendations drawn up by the International Energy Agency (IEA) and Eurostat and fully complies with international standards.

The publication is based on the declared data of various surveys conducted by the National Statistics Office during 2025. Different types of administrative data as well as expert assessments have been used in order to create the energy balance.

By signing the Community treaty, National Statistics Office of Georgia is implementing requirements regulations and directives of European Parliament and of the council, related energy statistics.

Business remarks and proposals on format and contents of this publication will be perceived by the authors group with gratitude.

Survey Program

In order to collect data from the energy sector, producers, suppliers, distributors and traders of energy forms (coal, natural gas, electricity, oil and oil products) were surveyed at full coverage as a result of specially organized statistical surveys.

In 2024 the survey covered non-financial corporations and households. Among non-financial corporations, enterprises in agriculture, industry, construction, and the transport sector were surveyed. Residential data were collected using a computer-assisted personal interviewing (CAPI) method, while in other sectors data collection was primarily carried out by means of online questionnaire.

Various types of administrative data were used to complete energy balance in addition to the above-mentioned surveys. In certain cases expert assessments were carried out as well.

The information derived from the survey allows to determine the energy production, supply and consumption structure by sectors, which is the basis for calculation of energy efficiency in the country.

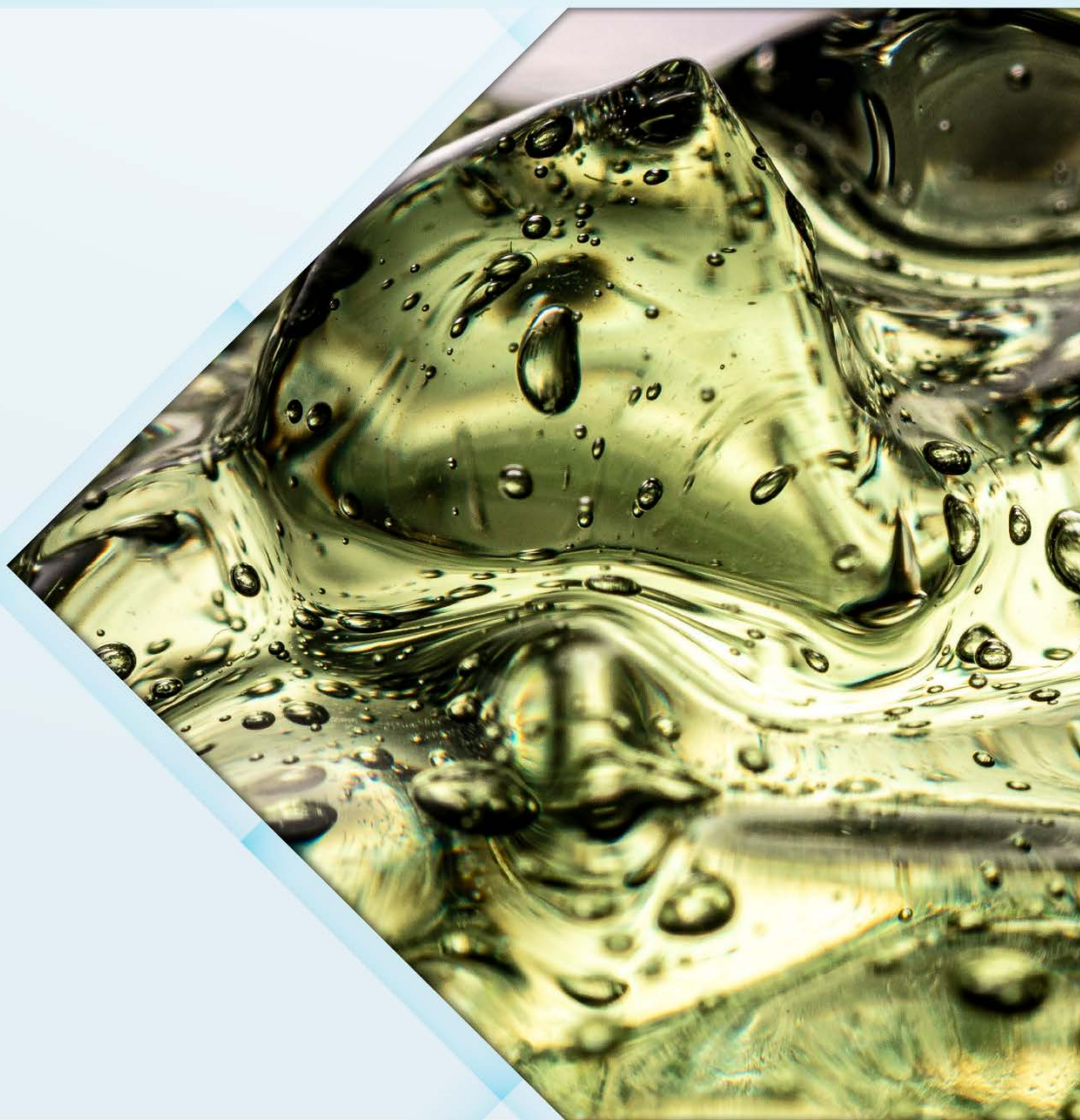
