EXPORT PRICE INDEX IN GEORGIA

NOVEMBER 2025

The Export Price Index (XPI) increased by 1.1 percent **compared to the previous month**. In the mentioned period, the prices for manufactured products increased by 1.7 percent.

Compared to November 2024 the XPI increased by 8.0 percent. The prices for mining and quarrying increased by 32.6 percent, for manufactured products by 3.7 percent, for electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning by 22.2 percent and for products from water supply, sewerage, waste management and remediation services by 13.3 percent.

The following table shows the XPI for November 2025, compared to the same month of the previous year, as well as the contributions of subgroups that had a major effect on the index:

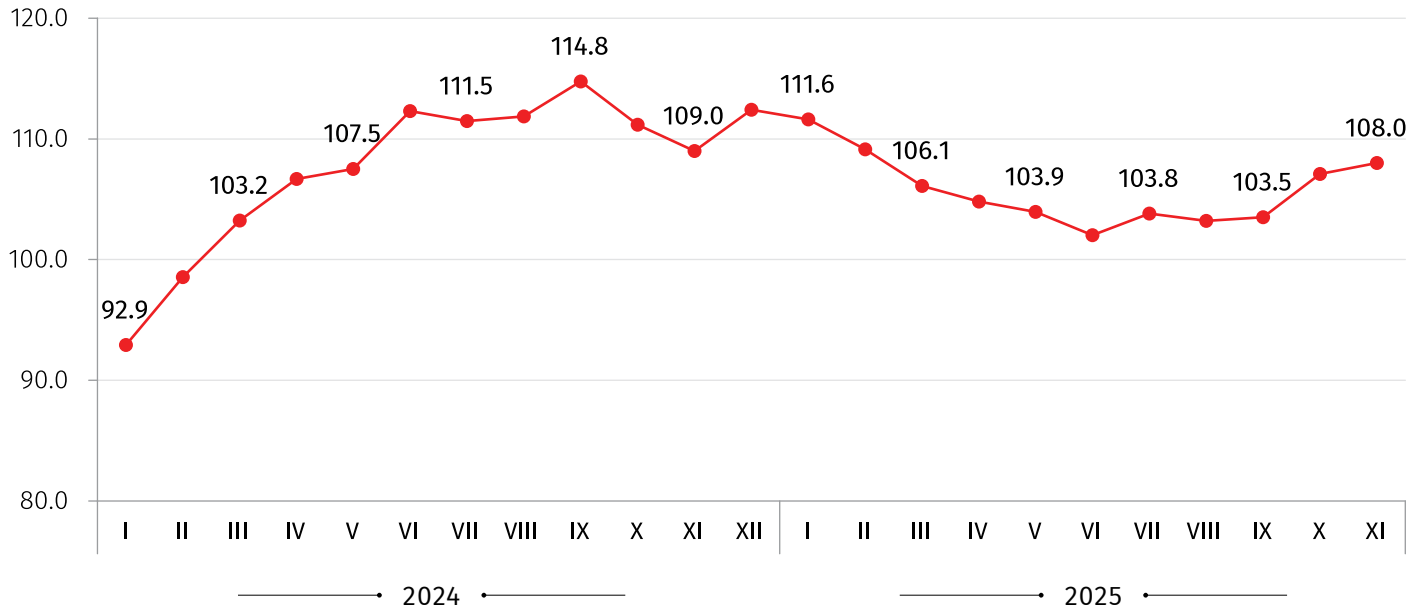
