IMPORT PRICE INDEX IN GEORGIA DECEMBER 2025

The Import Price Index (MPI) increased by 0.3 percent over the **previous month**, while compared to December 2024, the index decrease amounted to 0.1 percent.

Compared to December 2024 the prices were 2.6 percent higher for mining and quarrying. For manufactured products, a price decrease of 0.2 percent was recorded, while for electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning, prices increased by 166.6 percent. With regard to water supply, sewerage, waste management and remediation services, the prices were 4.3 percent higher.

The following table shows the MPI for December 2025, compared to the same month of the previous year, as well as the contributions of subgroups that had a major effect on the index:


