

THE DOMESTIC EXPORTS IN JANUARY-FEBRUARY 2026
(PRELIMINARY)

In January-February 2026 the exports of Georgia (excluding non-declared exports) equaled USD 1 026.7 million, 22.9 percent higher year-on-year. Share of the domestic exports in total exports constituted 64.3 percent and amounted to USD 659.7 million, 70.0 percent higher year-on-year.


● EXPORT, TOTAL

In January-February 2026 the share of the top ten trading partners by domestic exports in the total domestic exports of Georgia amounted to 68.1 percent. The top partners were China (USD 143.9 million), Russia (USD 84.9 million) and Türkiye (USD 76.1 million).

In January-February 2026 precious metal ores and concentrates claimed the first place in the list of top domestic export items, equaling USD 125.6 million, or 19.0 percent of total domestic exports. The domestic exports petroleum and petroleum oils totaled USD 88.1 million and their share in the total domestic exports amounted to 13.3 percent. The domestic exports of hazelnuts and other nuts occupied the third place, standing at USD 34.2 million and constituting 5.2 percent of the total domestic exports.
