DOMESTIC PRODUCER PRICE INDEX FOR INDUSTRIAL PRODUCTS IN GEORGIA FEBRUARY 2026

In February 2026, the Domestic Producer Price Index for Industrial Products (DPPI) decreased by 0.6 percent compared to the **previous month**. In the mentioned period, the prices for manufactured products decreased by 0.5 percent.

Compared to February 2025, the DPPI increased by 4.0 percent. The prices for mining and quarrying decreased by 3.3 percent, for manufactured products prices increased by 4.9 percent, for electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning by 0.3 percent and the prices for water supply, sewerage, waste management and remediation services by 3.1 percent.

The following table shows the DPPI for February 2026, compared to the same month of the previous year, as well as the contributions of subgroups that had a major effect on the index:


