EXPORT PRICE INDEX IN GEORGIA FEBRUARY 2026

The Export Price Index (XPI) decreased by 0.1 percent **compared to the previous month**. In the mentioned period, the prices for manufactured products decreased by 0.5 percent.

Compared to February 2025 the XPI increased by 8.7 percent. The prices for mining and quarrying increased by 49.9 percent, for manufactured products by 2.6 percent, for electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning by 7.5 percent and for products from water supply, sewerage, waste management and remediation services by 18.7 percent.

The following table shows the XPI for February 2026, compared to the same month of the previous year, as well as the contributions of subgroups that had a major effect on the index:


