IMPORT PRICE INDEX IN GEORGIA FEBRUARY 2026

The Import Price Index (MPI) increased by 0.2 percent over the **previous month**, while compared to February 2025, the index increase amounted to 1.2 percent.

Compared to February 2025 the prices were 1.4 percent higher for mining and quarrying. For manufactured products, a price increase of 1.1 percent was recorded, while for electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning, prices increased by 709.6 percent. With regard to water supply, sewerage, waste management and remediation services, the prices were 9.1 percent higher.

The following table shows the MPI for February 2026, compared to the same month of the previous year, as well as the contributions of subgroups that had a major effect on the index:


