EXPORT PRICE INDEX IN GEORGIA MARCH 2026

The Export Price Index (XPI) increased by 3.0 percent **compared to the previous month**. In the mentioned period, the prices for manufactured products increased by 3.8 percent.

Compared to March 2025 the XPI increased by 11.7 percent. The prices for mining and quarrying increased by 45.1 percent, for manufactured products by 6.4 percent, for electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning by 11.2 percent and for products from water supply, sewerage, waste management and remediation services by 21.9 percent.

The following table shows the XPI for March 2026, compared to the same month of the previous year, as well as the contributions of subgroups that had a major effect on the index:

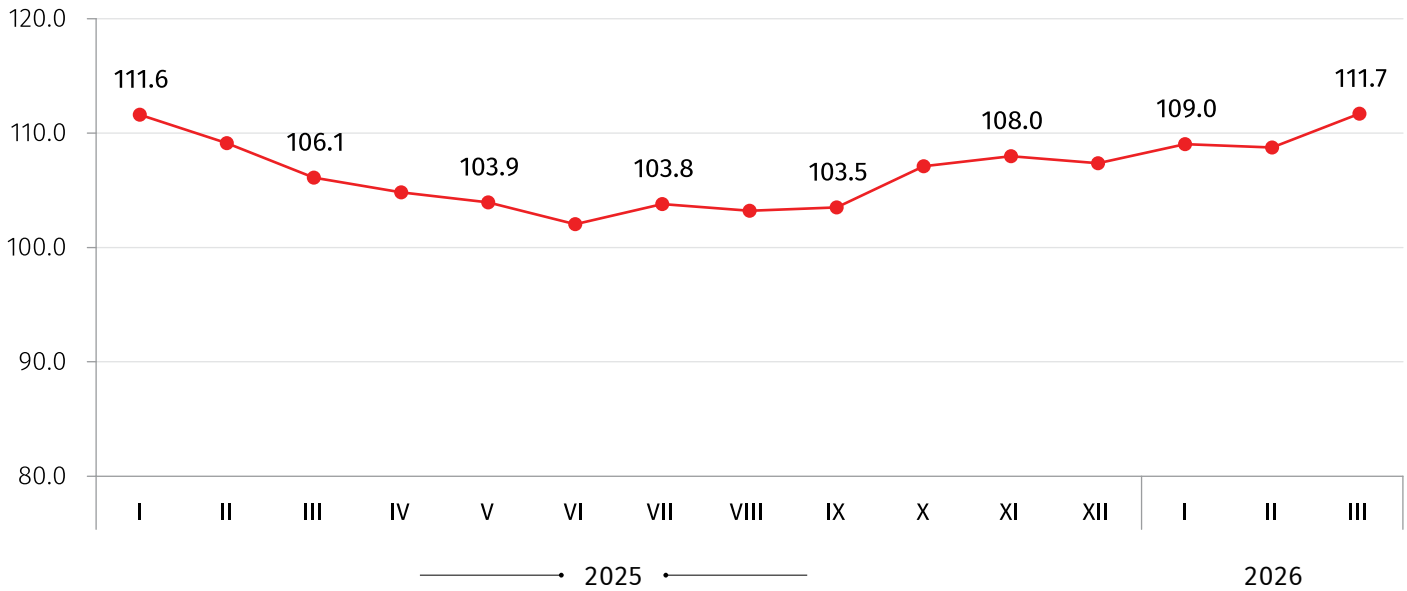
