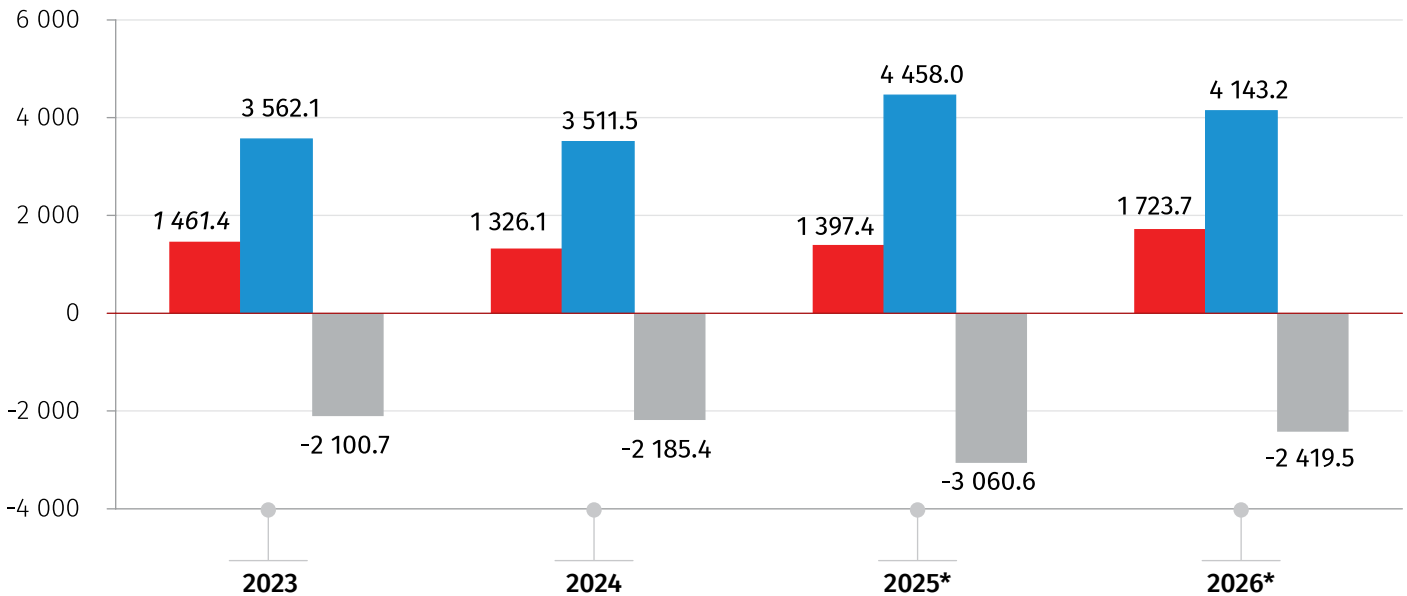

**EXTERNAL MERCHANDISE TRADE OF GEORGIA  
IN JANUARY-MARCH 2026  
(PRELIMINARY)**

In January-March 2026 the external merchandise trade (excluding non-declared trade) of Georgia amounted to USD 5 867.0 million, 0.2 percent higher year-on-year. The exports equaled 1 723.7 million (23.4 percent higher), while the imports stood at USD 4 143.2 million (7.1 percent lower). The negative trade balance was USD 2 419.5 million in January-March 2026 and its share in external trade turnover constituted 41.2 percent.

(MILLION US DOLLARS)**



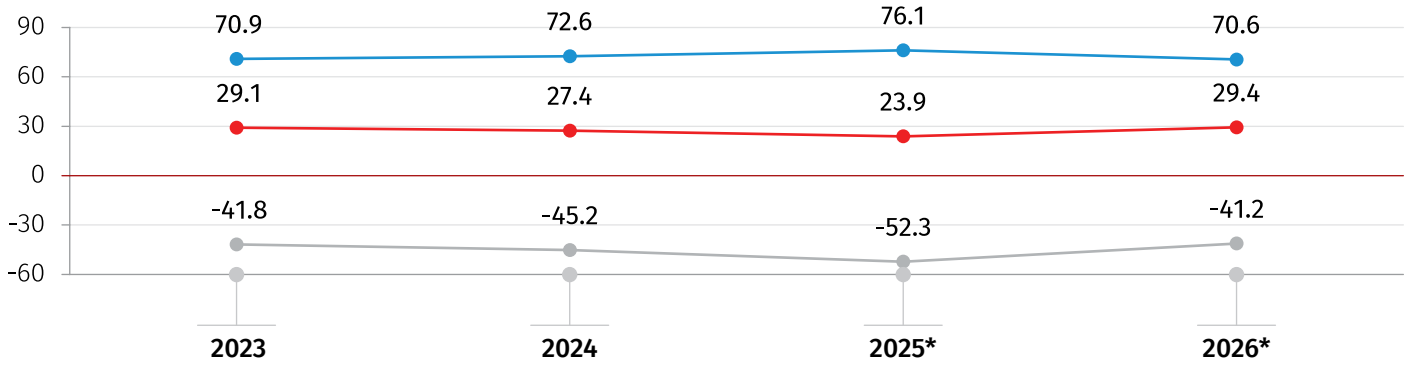

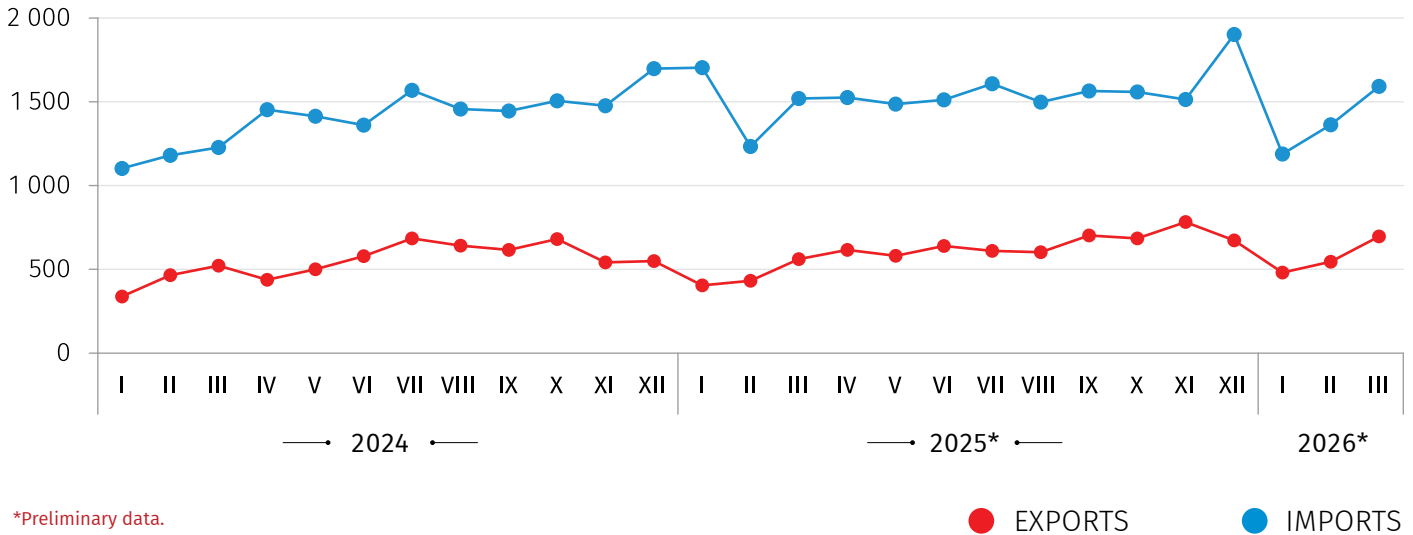

(MILLION US DOLLARS)

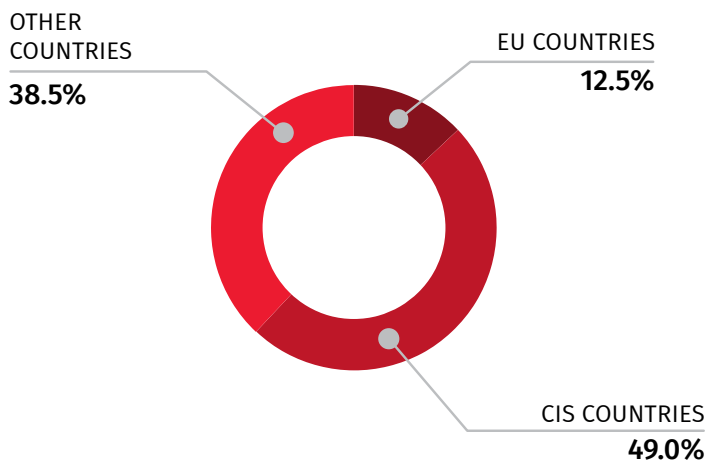

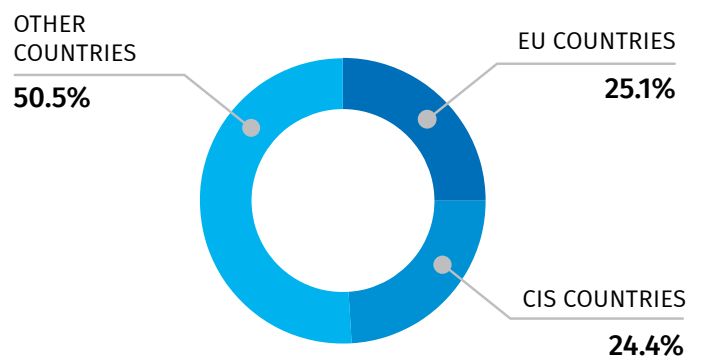

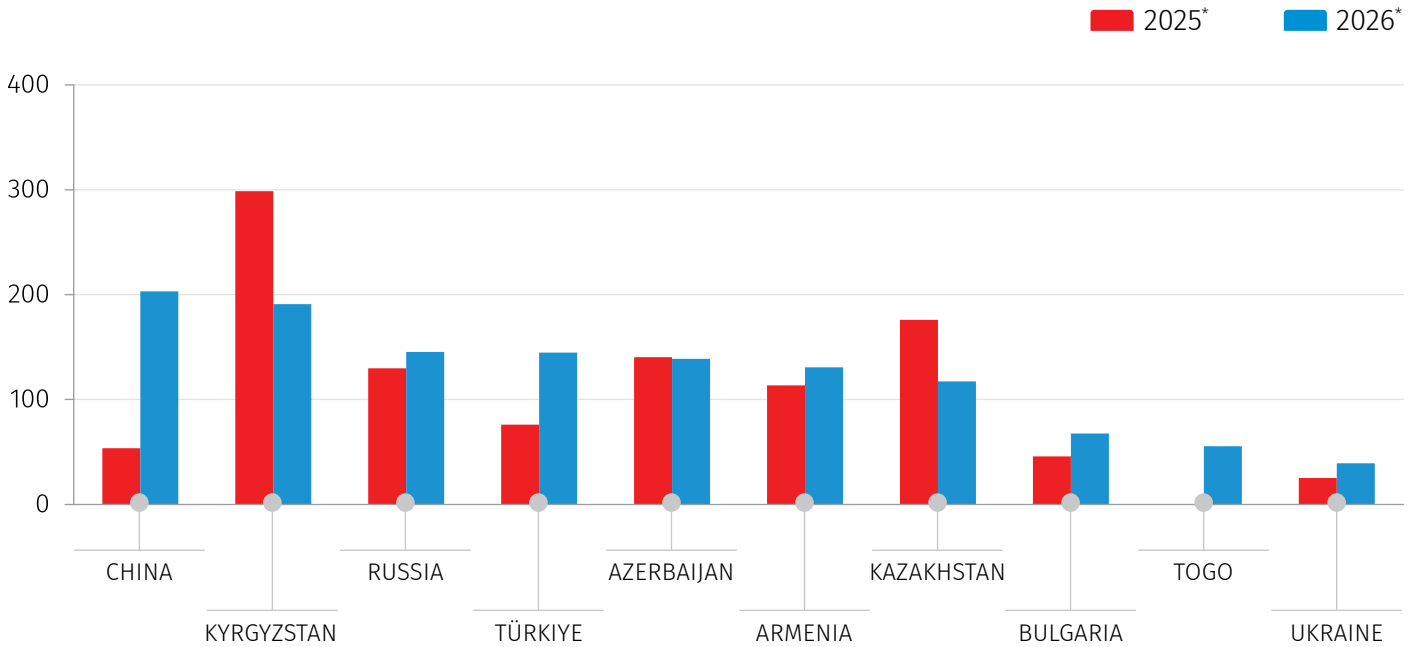

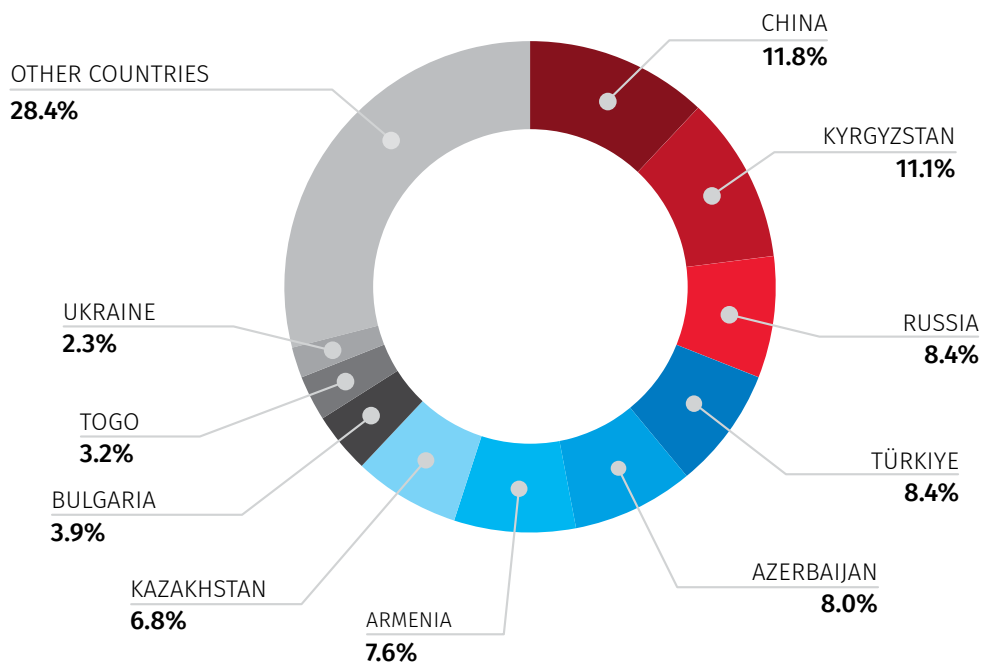

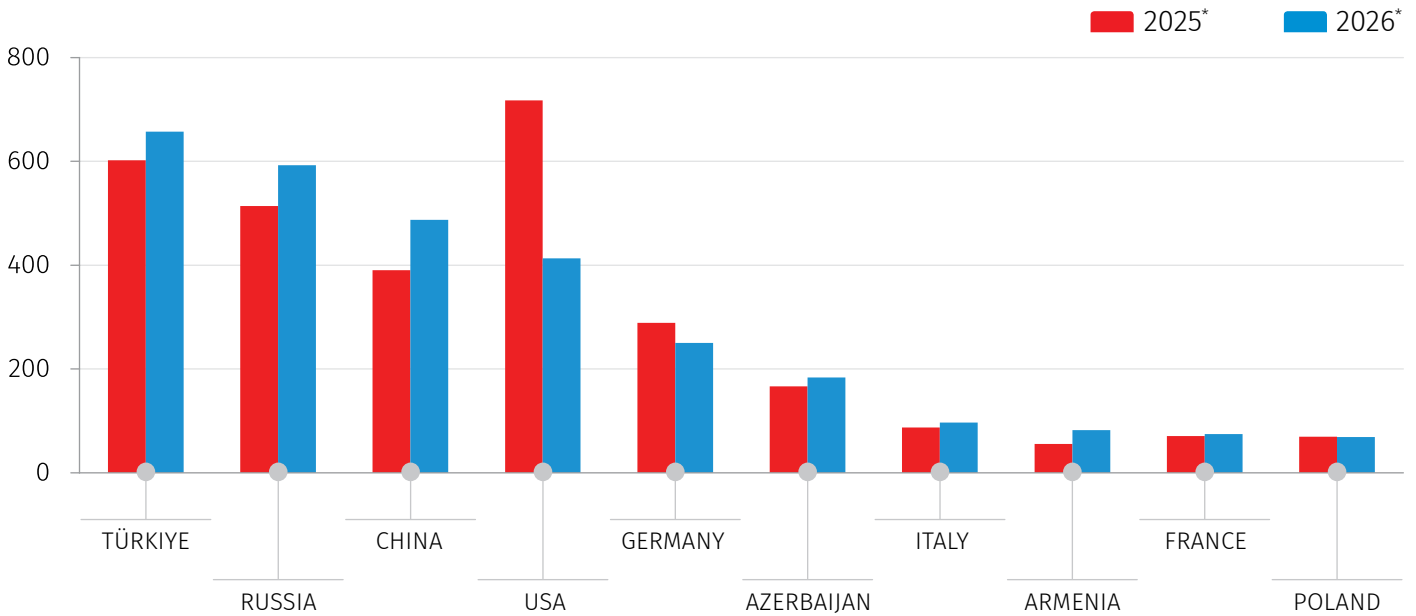

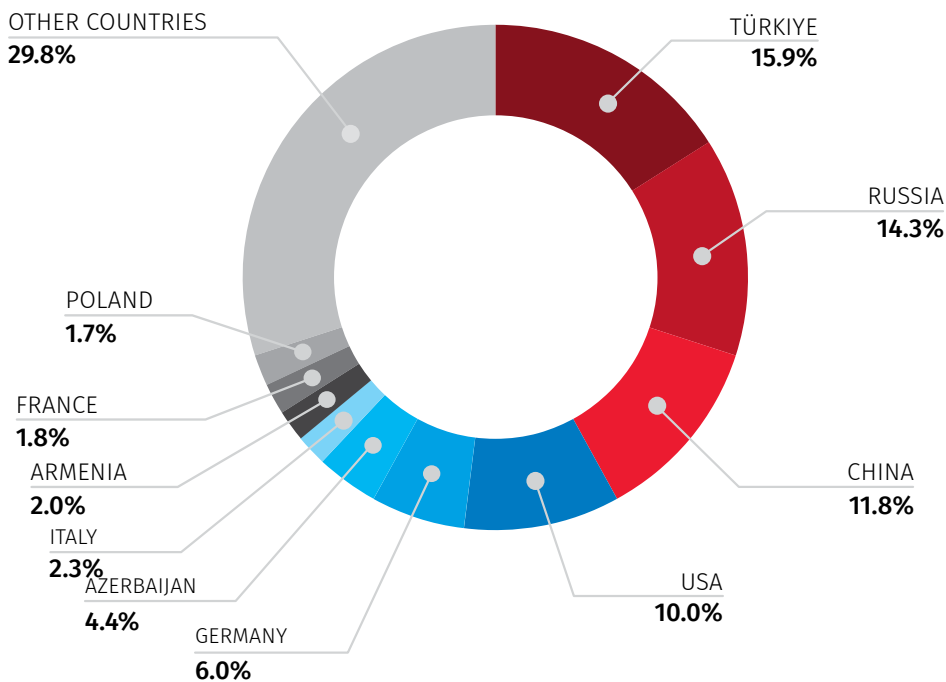

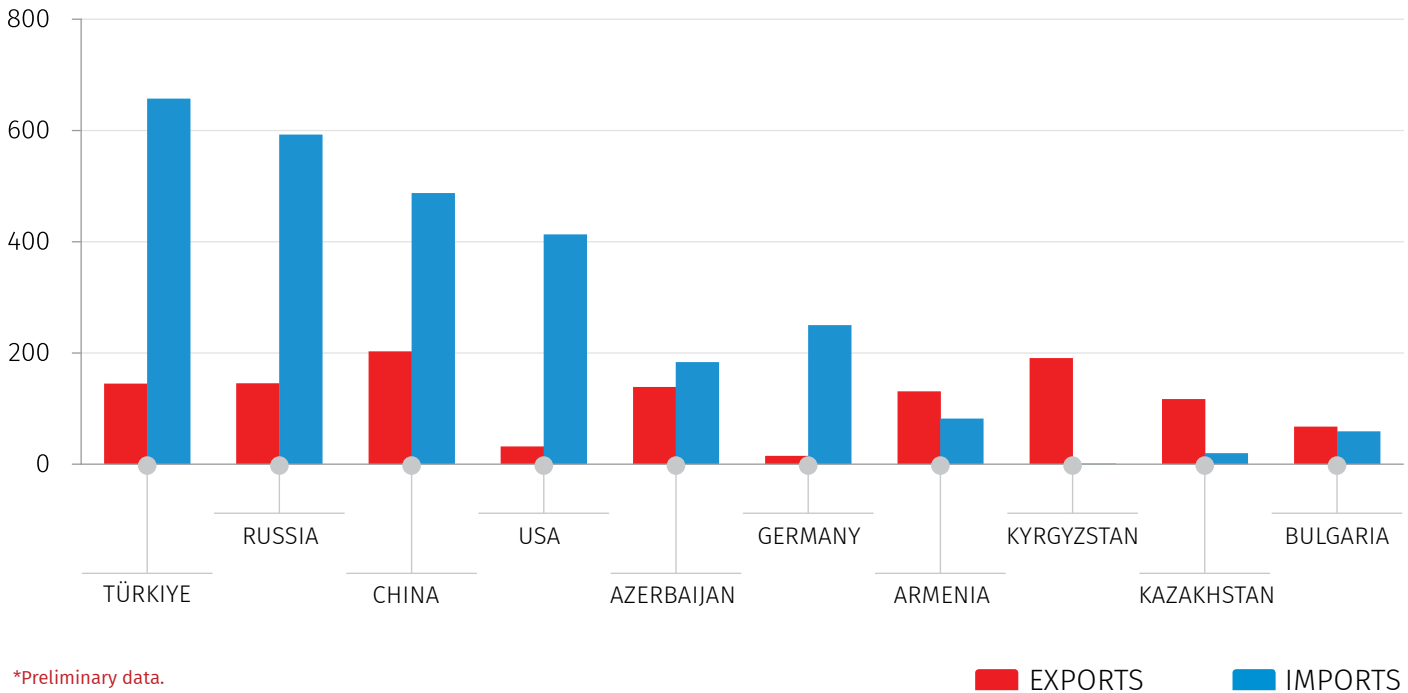

In January-March 2026 motor cars claimed the first place in the list of top export items, equaling USD 364.5 million with 21.1 percent of total exports. The exports of petroleum and petroleum oils totaled USD 208.1 million and their share in the total exports amounted to 12.1 percent. The exports of precious metal ores and concentrates occupied the third place standing at USD 169.9 million and constituting 9.9 percent of the total exports.

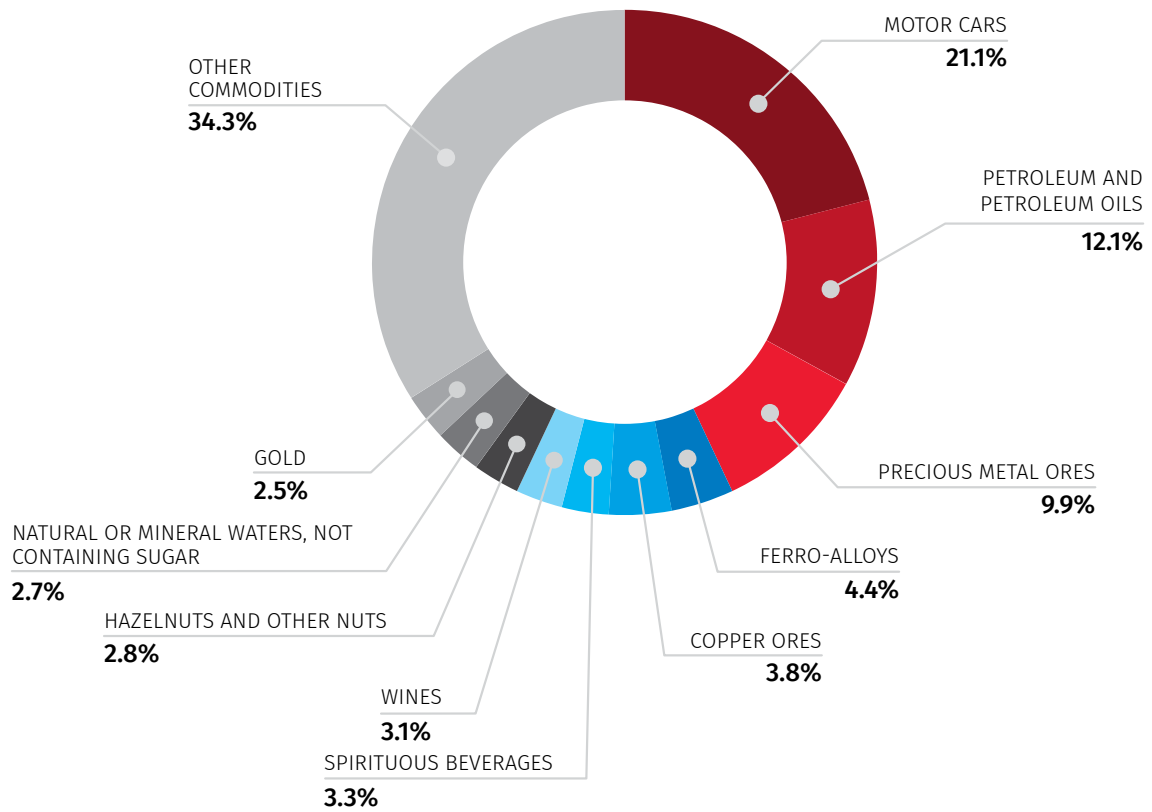

The top import commodities in January-March 2026 were motor cars, whose imports equaled USD 632.2 million (15.3 percent of the total imports). The petroleum and petroleum oils followed in the list with USD 338.6 million (8.2 percent of imports). The petroleum gases and other gaseous hydrocarbons were third in the top import commodity list with USD 204.1 million (4.9 percent of imports).

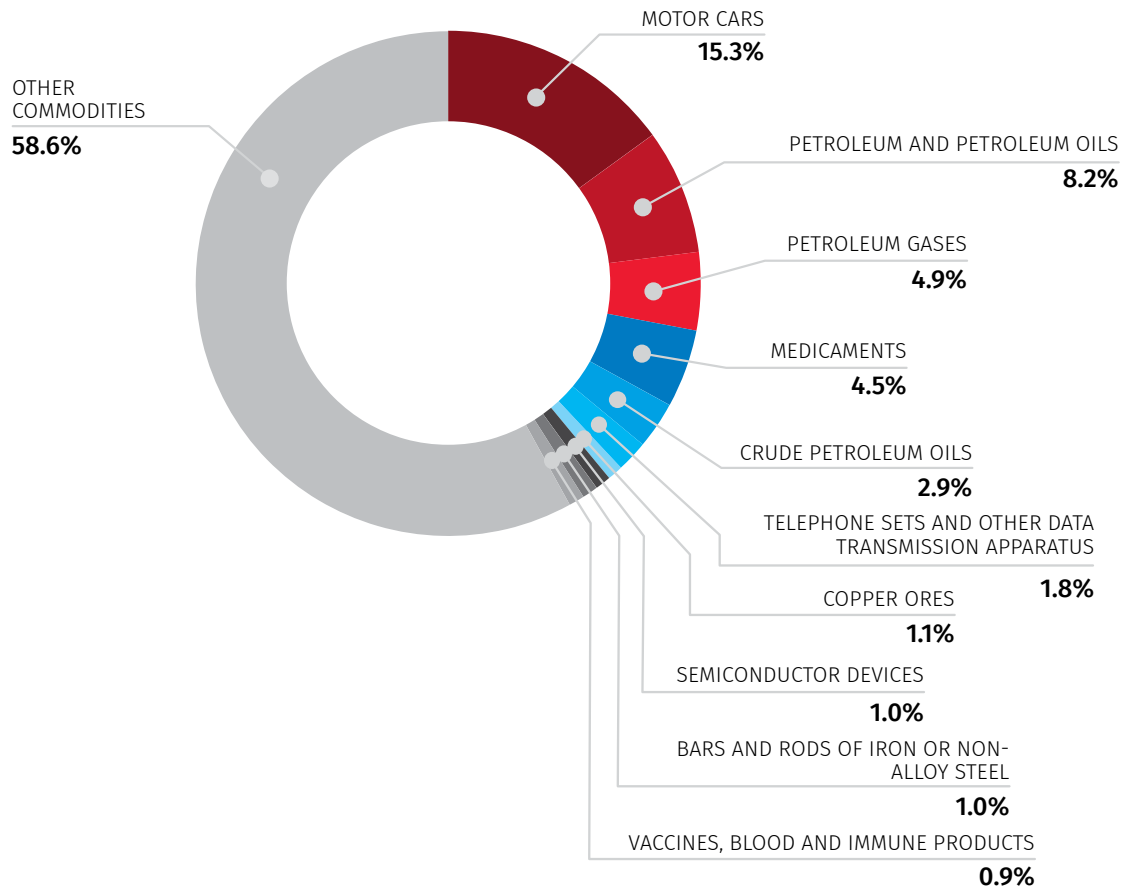
