INDICATORS OF POVERTY AND GINI COEFFICIENTS 2025 YEAR

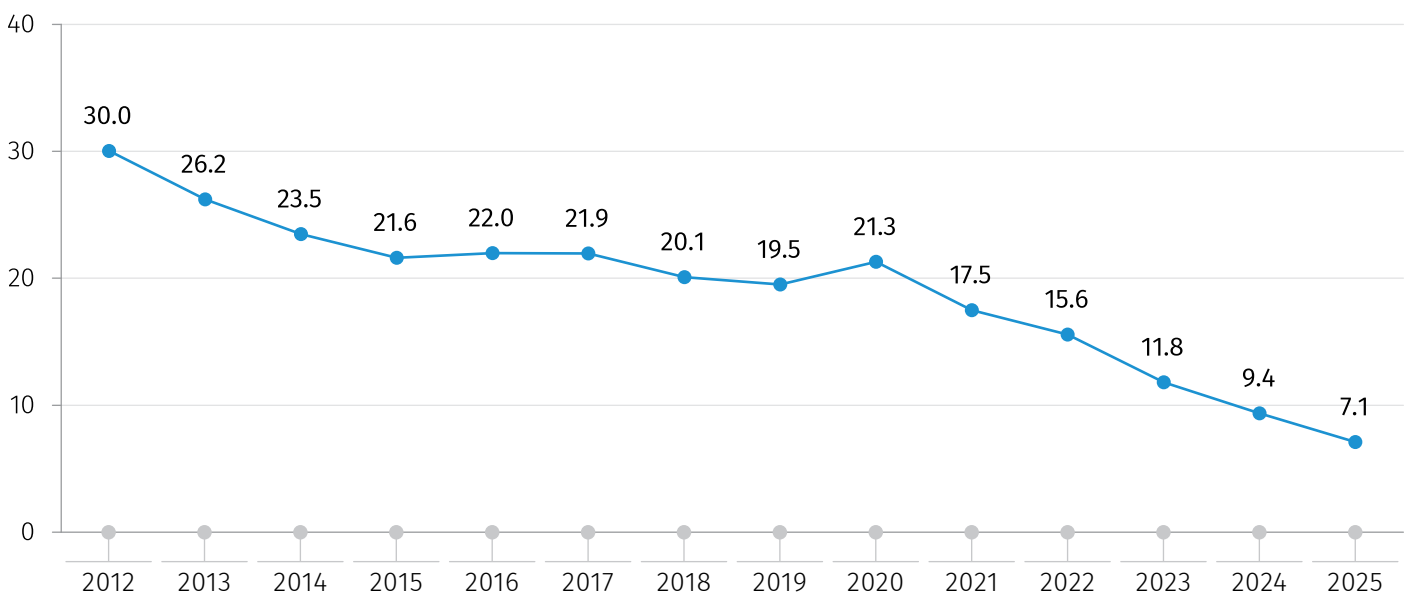
ABSOLUTE POVERTY

In 2025, the share of the population under the absolute poverty line (absolute poverty rate) in Georgia decreased by 2.3 percentage points compared to the previous year, amounting to 7.1 percent.

The chart below presents the share of the population under the absolute poverty line for 2012-2025 years.

SHARE OF POPULATION UNDER ABSOLUTE POVERTY LINE (%)



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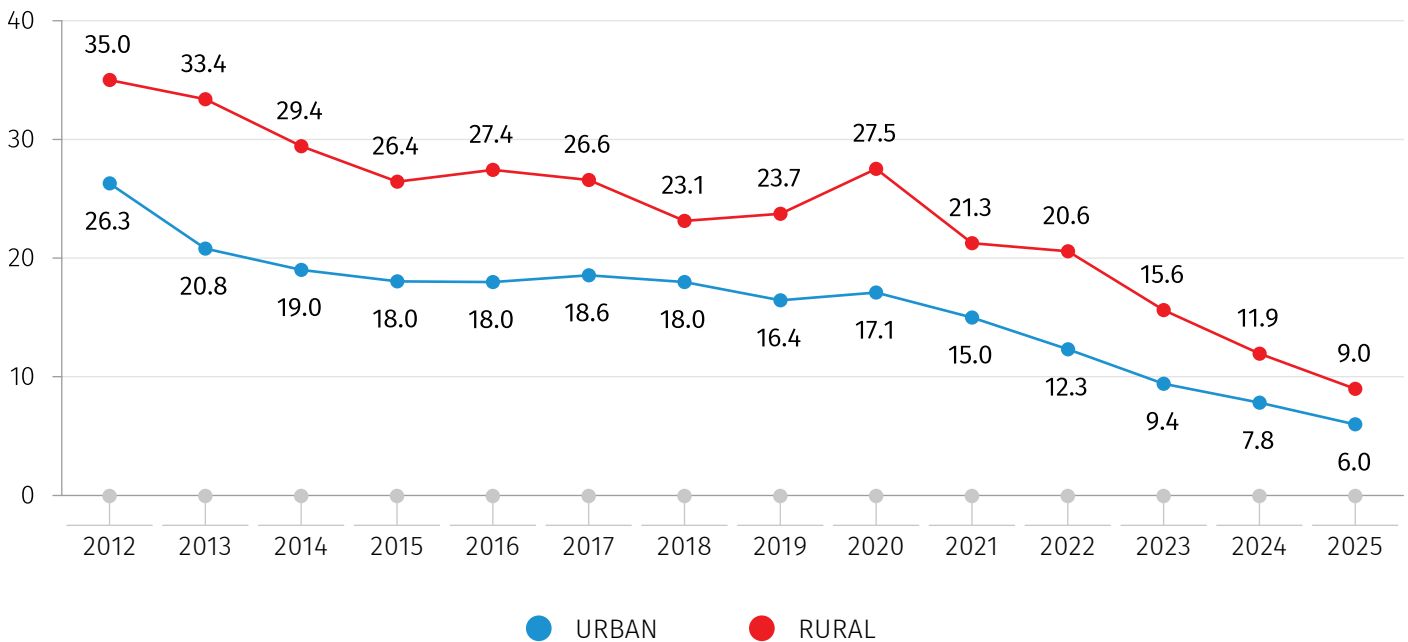
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In 2025, the absolute poverty rate in urban areas decreased by 1.8 percentage points, amounting to 6.0 percent, while in rural areas it decreased by 3.0 percentage points, amounting to 9.0 percent.

The chart below presents the share of the population under the absolute poverty line by urban and rural areas for 2012-2025 years.

In 2025, the absolute poverty rate decreased compared to the previous year across all age groups of the population. Specifically, the indicator was 9.2 percent in the age group under 18 years (-2.9 percentage points), in the 18-64 age group – 7.0 percent (-2.3 percentage points), and in the population aged 65 and older – 5.2 percent (-1.5 percentage points).

The absolute poverty rate for women decreased by 2.0 percentage points, while for men it decreased by 2.6 percentage points and amounted to 7.1 percent and 7.2 percent, respectively.

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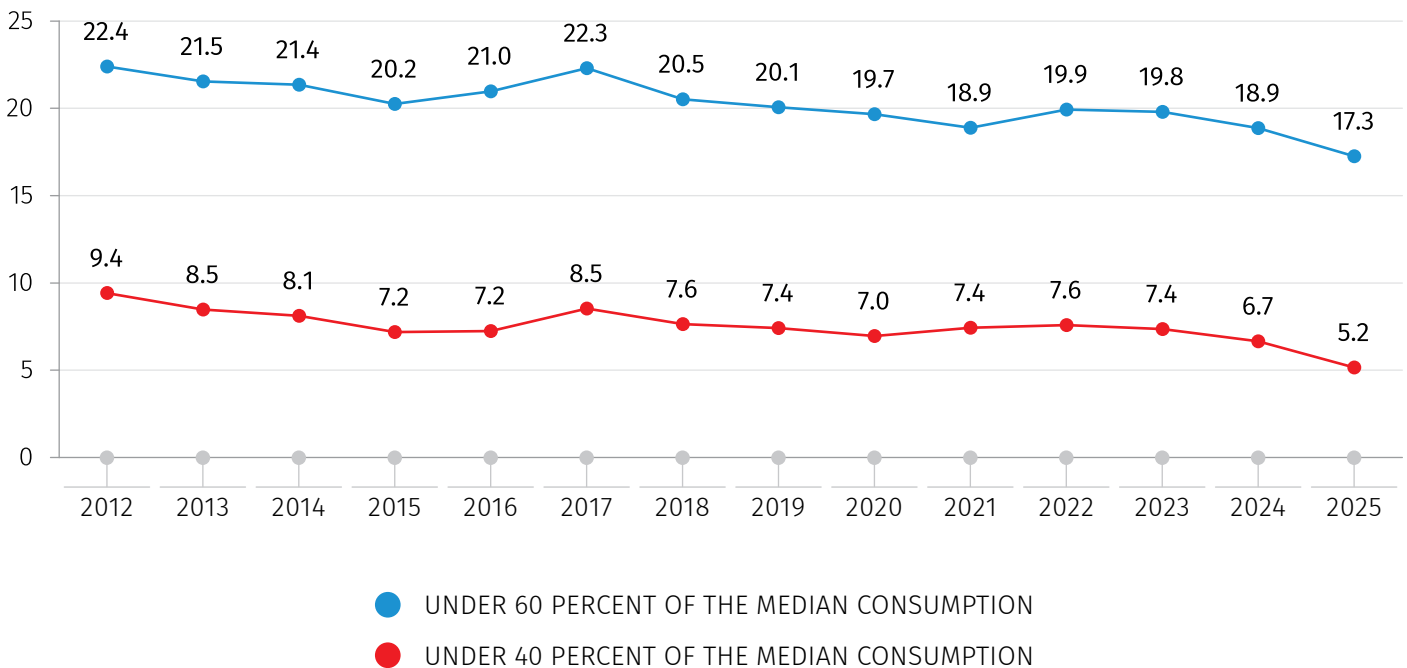
RELATIVE POVERTY

In 2025, the share of the population under 60 percent of the median consumption decreased by 1.6 percentage points, amounting to 17.3 percent, while the share of the population under 40 percent of the median consumption decreased by 1.5 percentage points, amounting to 5.2 percent.

The chart below presents the share of the population under the 60 percent of the median consumption and under the 40 percent of the median consumption for 2012-2025 years.

(%)



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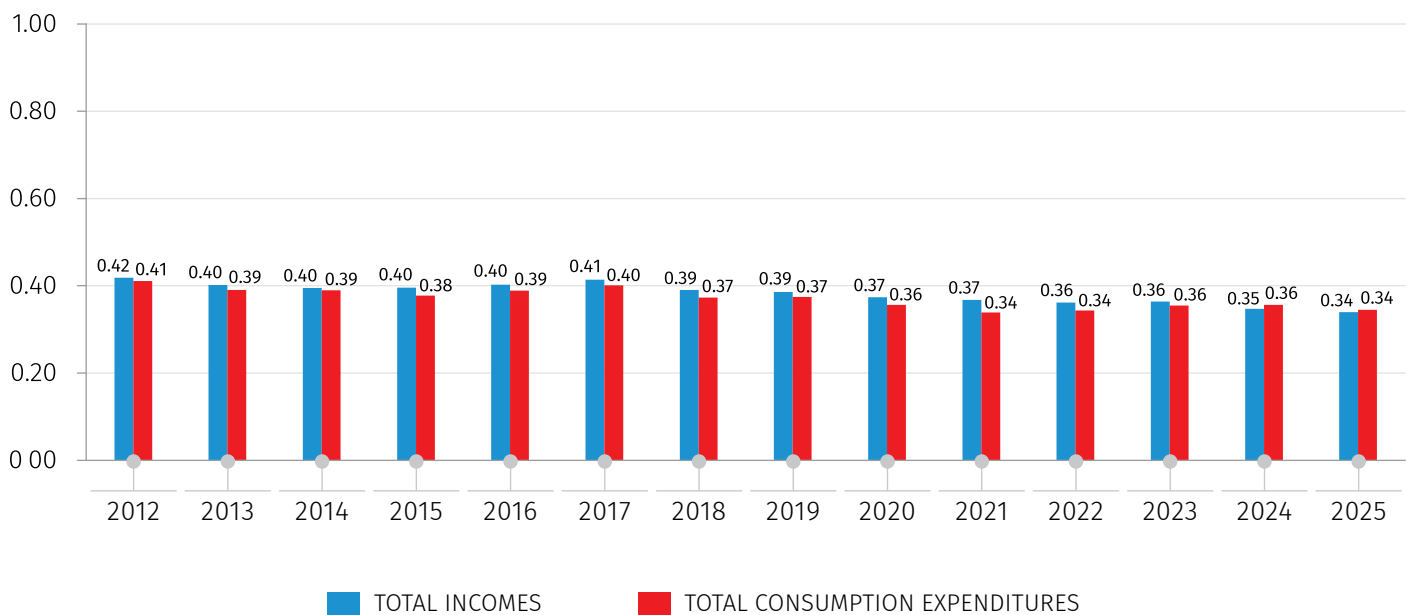
GINI COEFFICIENTS

In 2025, compared to the previous year, the value of the Gini coefficient decreased by 0.01 based on both total incomes and total consumption expenditures, amounting to 0.34.

The chart below presents the Gini coefficient by total incomes and total consumption expenditures for 2012-2025 years.
