EXPORT PRICE INDEX IN GEORGIA JUNE 2026

The Export Price Index (XPI) decreased by 2.4 percent **compared to the previous month**. In the mentioned period, the prices for manufactured products decreased by 1.8 percent.

Compared to June 2025 the XPI increased by 7.3 percent. The prices for mining and quarrying increased by 18.1 percent, for manufactured products by 4.9 percent, for products from water supply, sewerage, waste management and remediation services by 31.5 percent. The prices for electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning decreased by 40.9 percent.

The following table shows the XPI for June 2026, compared to the same month of the previous year, as well as the contributions of subgroups that had a major effect on the index:

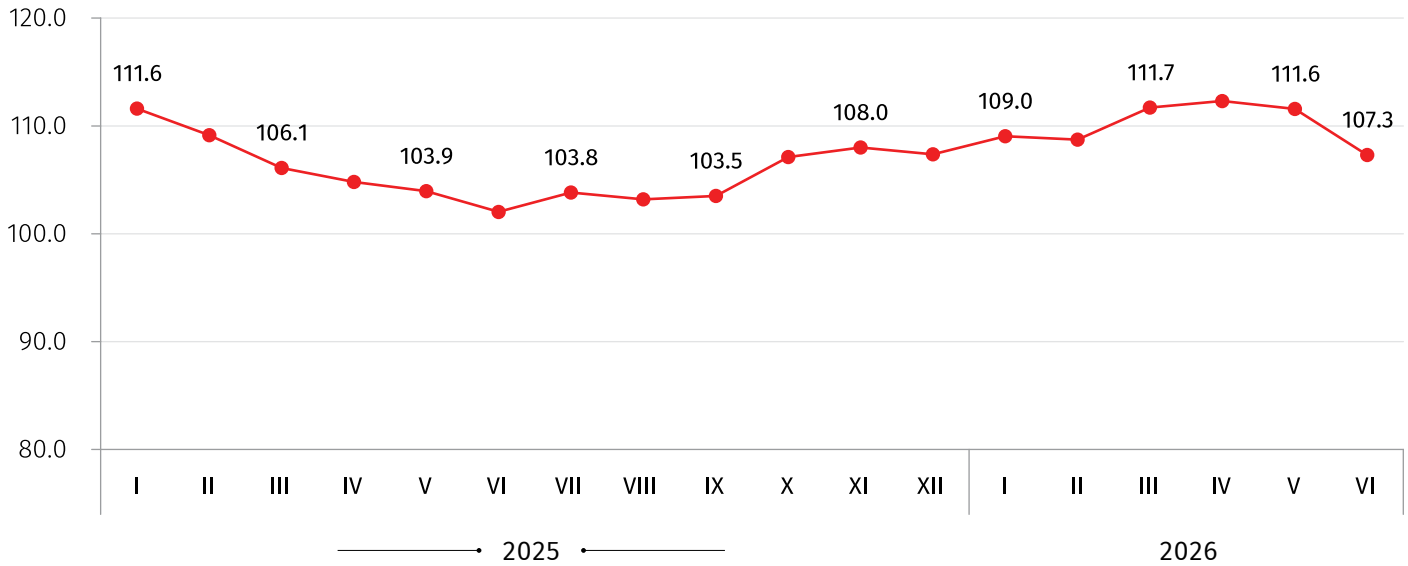
